Key features include a 3-speed adjustment LCD touchscreen and a versatile 6-in-1 nozzle.

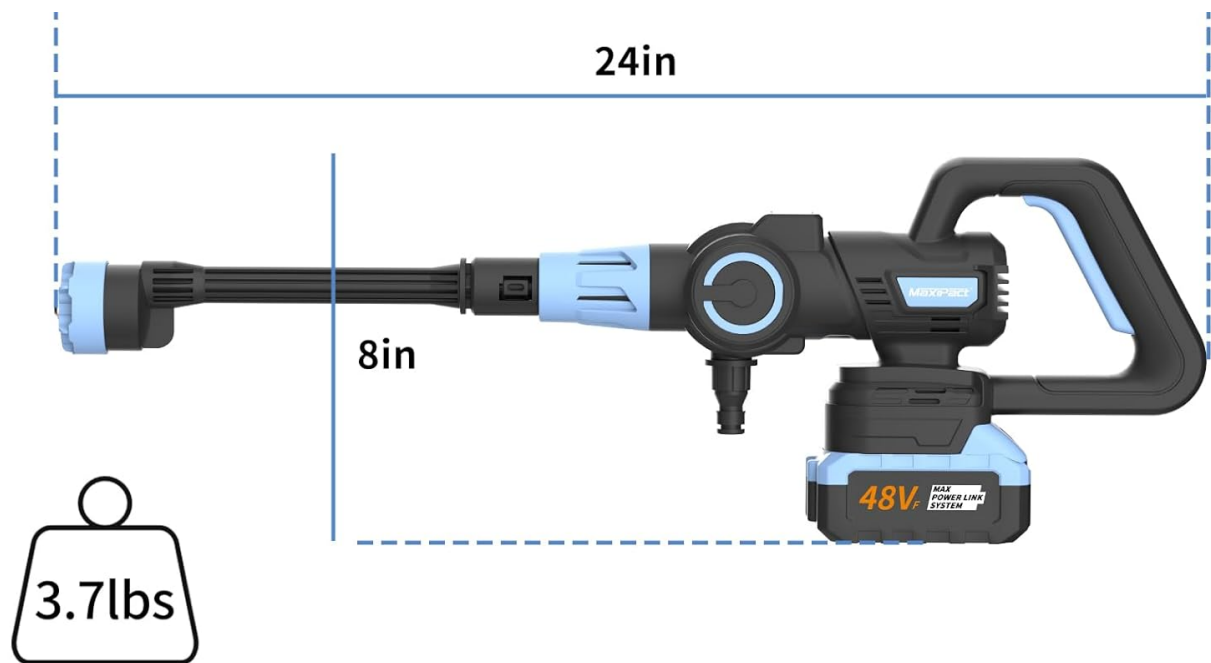



4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble and prepare your pressure washer for use.

1. Install Nozzle/Accessories:

Attach the desired accessory (e.g., 6-in-1 nozzle or foam bottle) to the front of the pressure washer unit by aligning and twisting until secure.

2. Connect Water Hose and Filter:

Attach the water filter to one end of the hose. Connect the water stop adapter to the other end of the hose, then connect the water stop adapter to the pressure washer's water inlet. Ensure all connections are tight

to prevent leaks.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

onto the surface, allow it to dwell, then rinse with clean water using the appropriate nozzle setting.

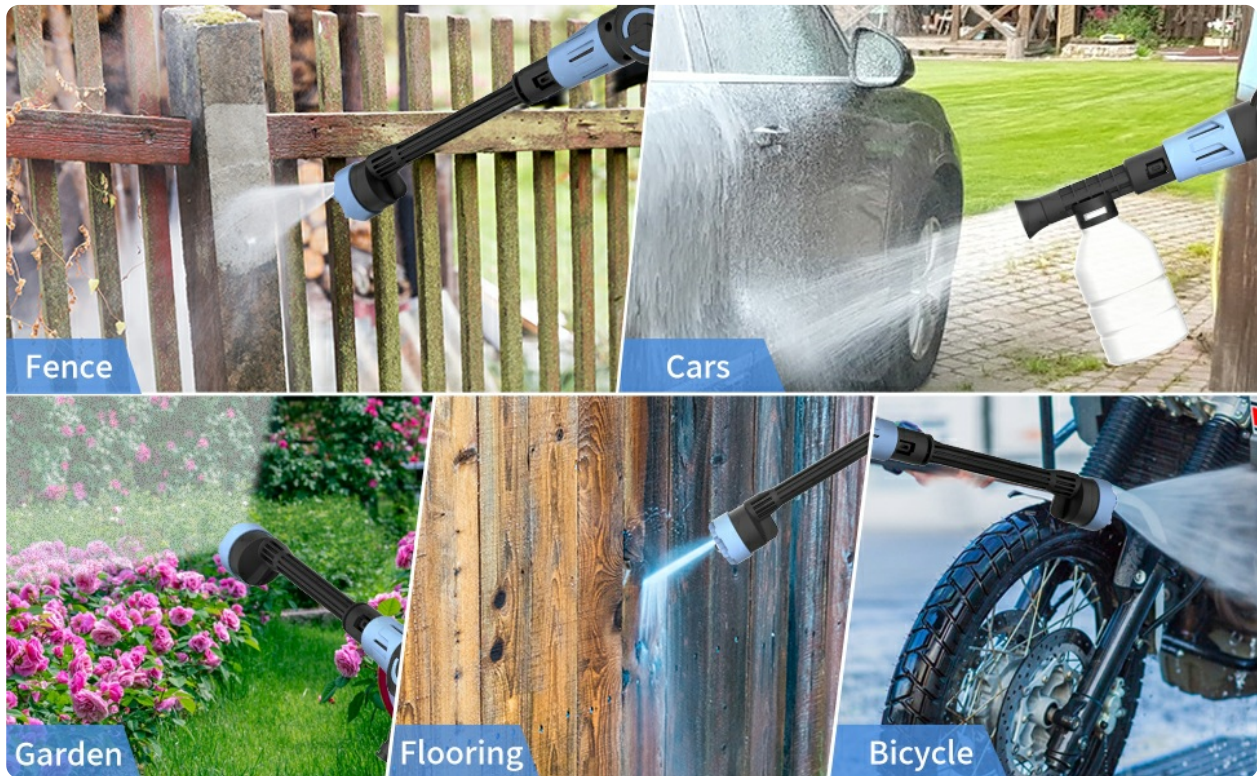

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your pressure washer.

- **After Each Use:**

- Flush the system with clean water to remove any detergent residue.
- Remove and clean the water filter.
- Wipe down the exterior of the unit with a damp cloth.

- **Storage:**

- Store the pressure washer and accessories in a dry, frost-free environment.
- Ensure batteries are fully charged before long-term storage and recharge them periodically.

- **Battery Care:**

- Do not expose batteries to extreme temperatures.
- Use only the provided charger for recharging.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power/Unit not starting	Battery not charged or improperly installed.	Ensure battery is fully charged and correctly inserted.
Low pressure	Insufficient water supply, clogged filter, or incorrect nozzle setting.	Check water source, clean water filter, adjust nozzle.
Water leaks	Loose connections or damaged O-rings.	Tighten all connections, inspect and replace O-rings if necessary.
Unit stops during operation	Battery depleted or motor overheating.	Recharge battery. Allow unit to cool down if overheated.
