1. INTRODUCTION

This bunk bed is designed to provide a space-saving sleeping solution with a unique house-shaped structure. It features a sturdy metal frame and an integrated ladder for access to the upper bunk. The design is suitable for various room aesthetics.

2. SAFETY GUIDELINES

Adherence to these safety guidelines is crucial to prevent injury and ensure the longevity of your bunk bed.

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the recommended weight limits for each bunk. Consult the specifications section for details.
- **Upper Bunk Age Restriction:** The upper bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- **Guardrails:** Always use the guardrails on the upper bunk. Ensure they are properly installed and secured before use.
- **Ladder Safety:** Use the ladder for entering and exiting the upper bunk. Do not use the bed as a climbing frame. Ensure the ladder is securely attached.
- **Mattress Thickness:** Use only mattresses that comply with the recommended thickness to ensure adequate guardrail

height.

- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit jumping on the bed or engaging in rough play on or under the bunk bed.
- **Anchoring:** Consider anchoring the bed frame to the wall for added stability, especially if the bed is frequently moved or used by active individuals.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure proper ventilation for mattresses, especially the lower one, to prevent moisture buildup.

3. PARTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components are present and undamaged. Refer to the included installation manual for a detailed list and diagrams of all parts and hardware. Typically, the package includes:

- Bed frame components (side rails, end panels, support beams)
- Ladder sections

- Slat system for mattress support
- Assembly hardware (screws, bolts, washers, nuts)

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

4. **Install Slat System (Lower Bunk):** Place and secure the mattress support slats onto the lower bunk frame.
5. **Assemble Upper Bunk:** Repeat steps 2 and 3 for the upper bunk frame.
6. **Attach Ladder:** Securely attach the ladder to the designated side of the bunk bed frame.
7. **Install Guardrails:** Mount the guardrails to the upper bunk frame, ensuring they are firmly in place.
8. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place and aligned, systematically tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.
9. **Inspection:** Perform a final check to ensure all connections are secure and the bed is stable before use.

5. OPERATION

The LIKIMIO bunk bed is designed for sleeping. Follow these guidelines for proper operation:

- **Mattress Placement:** Place a twin-sized mattress on each bunk. Ensure the mattress fits snugly within the frame.
- **Upper Bunk Access:** Always use the provided ladder to access the upper bunk. Face the ladder when climbing up or

down.

- **Guardrail Functionality:** The guardrails on the upper bunk are essential for safety. Do not remove them or attempt to use the upper bunk without them.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly on both bunks. Avoid concentrating heavy loads in one area.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the condition and safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame with a dry cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all bolts and screws to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary, but do not overtighten.
- **Structural Inspection:** Inspect the bed frame for any signs of damage, bending, or wear. If any damage is found, discontinue use and contact customer support.
- **Mattress Care:** Rotate and flip mattresses regularly according to their manufacturer's recommendations to ensure even wear and ventilation.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed is wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware connections.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
Squeaking noises.	Loose connections or friction between metal parts.	Tighten all hardware. Apply a small amount of lubricant (e.g., silicone spray) to connection points if necessary.
Ladder feels loose.	Ladder attachment bolts are not fully tightened.	Ensure the ladder is correctly positioned and all attachment bolts are securely tightened.
Missing parts during assembly.	Packaging error or lost during unpacking.	Review the parts list in the manual. Contact LIKIMIO customer support or your retailer for replacement parts.
