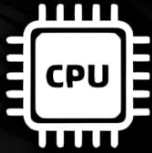

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

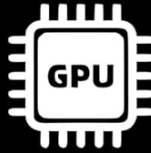
The Dell OptiPlex 7020 MFF is a Micro Form Factor Mini Business Desktop Computer designed for efficient performance in compact spaces. 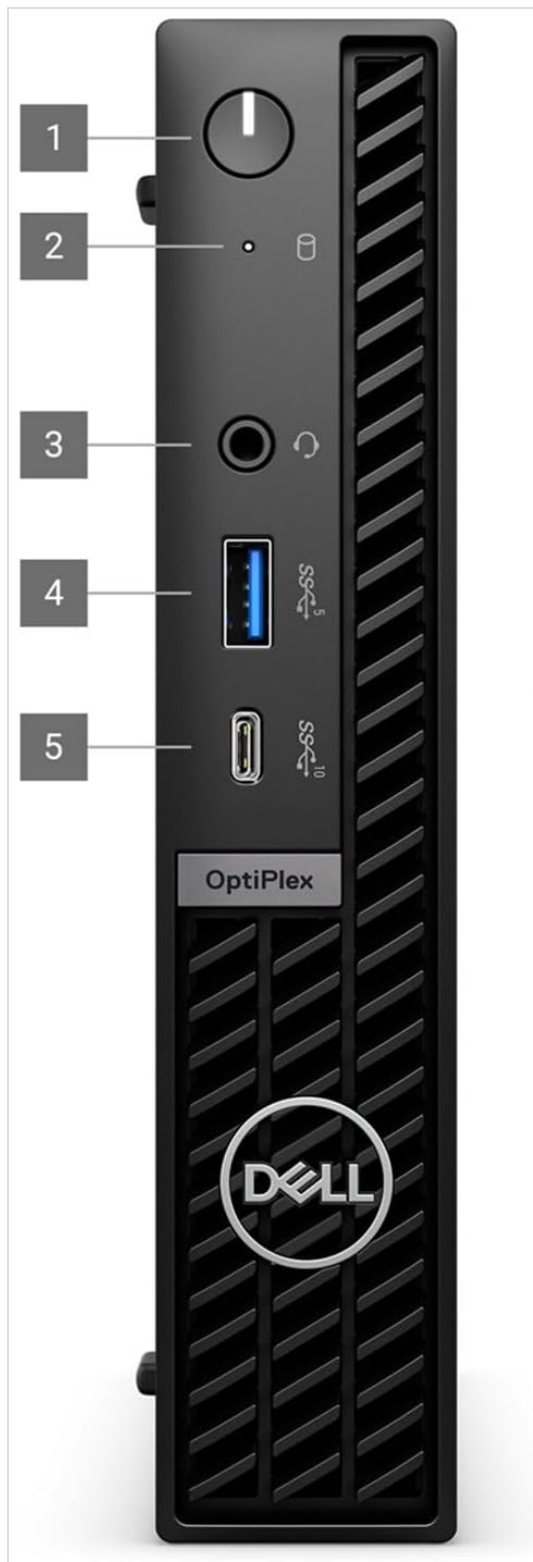

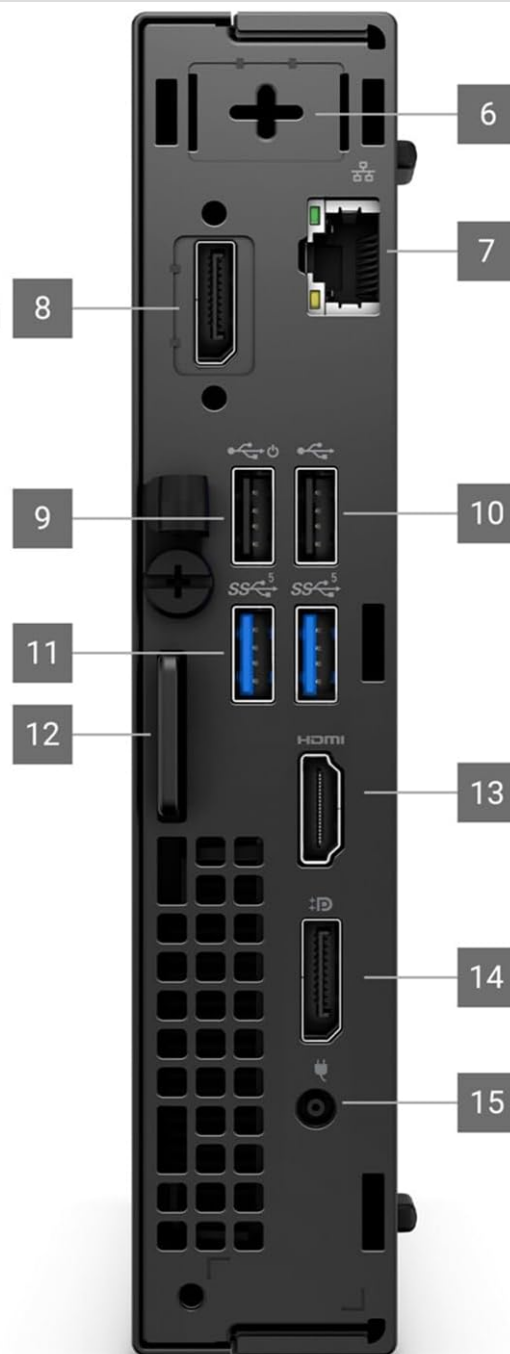


Image: Detailed view of the rear panel ports and their labels.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Unpacking and Placement

Carefully remove the computer and all accessories from the packaging. Place the computer on a stable, flat surface. The compact design allows for versatile placement, including mounting behind a compatible monitor.

4.2 Connecting Peripherals

1. **Connect Display:** Connect your monitor(s) to the DisplayPort or HDMI ports on the rear panel. The system supports up to three displays simultaneously.
2. **Connect Keyboard and Mouse:** Plug the included keyboard and mouse into any available USB ports on the front or rear panel.
3. **Connect Network:** For a wired connection, connect an Ethernet cable to the RJ-45 port. For wireless, ensure your Wi-Fi network is available.
4. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into the power adapter port on the rear panel, then connect the power cable to an electrical outlet.

4.3 Initial Power On

Press the power button on the front panel to turn on the computer. Follow the on-screen instructions for the initial setup of Windows 11 Professional.

5. OPERATING SYSTEM

The Dell OptiPlex 7020 MFF comes pre-installed with **Windows 11 Professional**. This operating system provides a secure and productive environment for business applications. For detailed information on using Windows 11, refer to the official Microsoft documentation or support resources.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning the Computer

- Always power off the computer and disconnect it from the power outlet before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe exterior surfaces.
- Do not spray liquids directly onto the computer.
- Use compressed air to clear dust from vents and ports.

7.2 Software Updates

Regularly update your operating system, drivers, and applications to ensure optimal performance and security. Windows Update can be configured to automatically download and install updates.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

8.1 No Power

- Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the computer and the electrical outlet.
- Verify the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.
- Check the power adapter for any damage.

8.2 No Display

- Confirm that the monitor is powered on and connected correctly to the computer's DisplayPort or HDMI port.
- Try connecting the monitor to a different port or using a different cable.
- Ensure the correct input source is selected on your monitor.

8.3 Peripheral Not Responding

- Ensure the peripheral (keyboard, mouse, etc.) is securely plugged into a USB port.
- Try connecting the peripheral to a different USB port.
- Restart the computer.
