1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Dell OptiPlex 7020 Micro Form Factor (MFF) is a compact business desktop computer designed for efficiency and space-saving. It features a 14th Gen Intel Core i7-14700T processor, 32GB DDR5 RAM, and a 1TB PCIe SSD, providing robust performance for daily tasks. The integrated Intel UHD Graphics 770 supports up to two 4K displays via HDMI and DisplayPort. This system is pre-installed with Windows 11 Professional and includes Wi-Fi 6 and Bluetooth connectivity.



3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Dell OptiPlex 7020 MFF:

1. **Connect the Power Adapter:** Plug the power adapter into the power connector on the rear of the computer, then plug the power cable into an electrical outlet.
2. **Connect Display(s):** Connect your monitor(s) to the DisplayPort 1.4a and/or HDMI 1.4b ports on the rear of the computer. The system supports up to two simultaneous displays.
3. **Connect Peripherals:** Connect the wired keyboard and mouse to the available USB ports. You can use the USB 3.2 Gen 1 Type-A ports on the front or rear, or the USB 2.0 Type-A ports on the rear.
4. **Connect to Network:** For a wired connection, connect an Ethernet cable to the RJ-45 port on the rear. For wireless, the system supports Wi-Fi 6.
5. **Power On:** Press the power button located on the front of the computer.
6. **Initial Windows Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 Professional setup, including language, region, network, and user account creation.



4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Dell OptiPlex 7020 MFF is designed for straightforward operation.

- **Power On/Off:** Press the power button on the front panel to turn the computer on or off. For a controlled shutdown, use the Windows Start menu.
- **Connecting Multiple Displays:** The system supports up to two displays. Connect one monitor to the HDMI port and another to the DisplayPort. Windows 11 will automatically detect the displays, and you can configure their arrangement and resolution in Display Settings.
- **USB Connectivity:** Utilize the various USB ports for connecting external devices such as storage drives, printers, or other peripherals. The USB 3.2 Gen 2x2 Type-C port offers high-speed data transfer.
- **Audio:** Use the Universal Audio Port on the front for headphones or a headset.
- **Network Access:** Connect to the internet via the Ethernet port for a stable wired connection or use the integrated Wi-Fi 6 for wireless access.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Dell OptiPlex 7020 MFF, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the computer and a working electrical outlet. Check if the power button light illuminates.
- **No Display:** Verify that your monitor cables (HDMI/DisplayPort) are firmly connected to both the computer and the monitor. Ensure the monitor is powered on and set to the correct input source.
- **Peripheral Not Working:** Try connecting the peripheral (mouse, keyboard, USB drive) to a different USB port. Ensure drivers are up to date if necessary.
- **Network Connectivity Issues:** For wired connections, check the Ethernet cable and router status. For Wi-Fi, ensure the Wi-Fi adapter is enabled and you are connected to the correct network with the correct password.
- **System Unresponsive:** Perform a hard shutdown by pressing and holding the power button for 10-15 seconds, then restart the computer.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Dell OptiPlex 7020 MFF:

- **Keep it Clean:** Regularly clean dust from the vents and exterior surfaces using a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using liquid cleaners directly on the computer.
- **Software Updates:** Keep your Windows operating system and drivers updated to the latest versions. This improves security, stability, and performance.
- **Data Backup:** Periodically back up important data to an external drive or cloud storage to prevent data loss.
- **Proper Ventilation:** Ensure the computer has adequate airflow around its vents to prevent overheating. Avoid placing it in enclosed spaces.
