## SETUP GUIDE

- Prepare the Clip:** Loosen the thumbscrew slightly to allow the adjustable arm to move freely.
- Position on Instrument:** Carefully place the clip onto the edge of your instrument (e.g., violin, viola, banjo, mandolin). Ensure the rubber end pieces are in contact with the instrument's surface to prevent scratches.
- Secure the Clip:** Tighten the thumbscrew until the clip is firmly secured to the instrument. Do not overtighten, as this may damage the instrument. The clip should be stable and not wobble.

5. **Attach Microphone:** Insert your instrument microphone into the designated holder on the clip's arm. Ensure the microphone is securely seated.
6. **Adjust Microphone Position:** Adjust the flexible arm of the microphone (if applicable) to achieve the desired proximity and angle for optimal sound capture.

- **Inspection:** Periodically check the thumbscrew and rubber pads for any signs of wear or damage. Ensure the thumbscrew operates smoothly.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Clip is Loose:** Ensure the thumbscrew is tightened sufficiently. The clip should feel secure without excessive force.
- **Microphone Not Stable:** Verify that the microphone is fully inserted into the clip's holder. If the microphone's arm is flexible, ensure it is bent into a stable position.
- **Instrument Scratches:** Double-check that the black rubber end pieces are properly positioned and making contact with the instrument. These pads are designed to protect the surface.
