#### 1. Introduction

#### 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The boAt Bassheads 900 Pro headphones are designed for clear audio and communication, featuring a lightweight, foldable design and a unidirectional retractable microphone. Key components are detailed below.

# 3.1 Key Features

- 40mm Dynamic Drivers: Delivers crisp and clear audio for an immersive listening experience.
- Lightweight Build (150g): Designed for extended comfort during long usage sessions.
- Foldable Design: Allows for easy storage and portability, occupying minimal space.
- Adjustable Headband: Ensures a secure and comfortable fit for various head sizes.
- **Unidirectional Retractable Microphone:** Picks up sound primarily from one direction, reducing background noise, and can be retracted when not in use.
- Inline Remote Control: Features volume adjustment and a microphone mute/unmute switch for convenient control.
- USB Type-A Connectivity: Provides a stable wired connection to compatible devices.




Figure 3.3: A user wearing the headphones, illustrating the adjustable headband and overall comfortable fit.

#### 4. SETUP

#### 4.1 Connecting the Headphones

- 1. Locate an available USB Type-A port on your computer, laptop, or other compatible device.
- 2. Insert the USB Type-A connector of the headphones firmly into the port.
- 3. Your operating system should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This may take a few moments.
- 4. Once connected, the headphones should be ready for use as an audio output and input device. You may need to select them as the default audio device in your device's sound settings.

### 4.2 Adjusting for Comfort

- 1. **Headband Adjustment:** Gently slide the earcups up or down along the headband to achieve a comfortable fit over your ears.
- 2. **Microphone Positioning:** The microphone is retractable. Pull it out from the left earcup and bend the flexible arm to position the microphone approximately 2-3 cm from your mouth for optimal voice clarity.

# 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The boAt Bassheads 900 Pro headphones feature an inline remote control for easy management of audio and microphone functions.

#### **5.1 Inline Remote Control**

- Volume Control: Use the scroll wheel or buttons on the inline remote to adjust the audio volume. Scroll up to increase volume, scroll down to decrease.
- Microphone Mute/Unmute: A dedicated switch on the inline remote allows you to quickly mute or unmute your microphone. Slide the switch to the "OFF" position to mute and "ON" to unmute.

# 5.2 Audio Playback

Once connected and selected as the default audio device, your headphones will play audio from your connected device. Adjust volume using the inline remote or your device's system volume controls.

### 5.3 Using the Microphone

For voice communication (e.g., online calls, gaming), ensure the microphone is extended and positioned correctly. Confirm the microphone is unmuted via the inline switch and selected as the input device in your application or system settings.

#### 6. MAINTENANCE

#### 6.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the earcups and headband with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, cleaning solvents, or strong detergents.
- Avoid getting moisture into any openings.

#### 6.2 Storage

- When not in use, fold the headphones to save space and store them in a clean, dry place away from extreme temperatures.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the headphones.

#### 6.3 General Care

- Do not expose the headphones to water or excessive humidity as they are not water-resistant.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the headphones to strong impacts.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the headphones, as this will void the warranty.

# 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your boAt Bassheads 900 Pro headphones, refer to the following common solutions:

No sound from headphones	<ul> <li>Headphones not properly connected.</li> <li>Volume too low or muted.</li> <li>Incorrect audio output device selected.</li> <li>Faulty USB port.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Ensure USB Type-A connector is fully inserted.</li> <li>Increase volume using inline remote or device controls. Check if muted.</li> <li>In your device's sound settings, select "boAt Bassheads 900 Pro" as the default output device.</li> <li>Try connecting to a different USB port.</li> </ul>
Microphone not working	<ul> <li>Microphone muted.</li> <li>Incorrect audio input device selected.</li> <li>Microphone not positioned correctly.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Check the microphone mute switch on the inline remote and ensure it is in the "ON" position.</li> <li>In your device's sound settings, select "boAt Bassheads 900 Pro" as the default input device.</li> <li>Extend and position the microphone arm close to your mouth.</li> </ul>
Sound distortion or poor quality	<ul><li>Volume too high.</li><li>Poor audio source quality.</li><li>Loose connection.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Reduce the volume.</li> <li>Test with a different audio source or file.</li> <li>Ensure the USB connector is secure.</li> </ul>


