## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This instruction manual provides important information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your MiHunnor Twin Over Full Bunk Bed with Trundle and Lateral Storage Ladder. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use, and retain it for future reference.

The MiHunnor Bunk Bed features a versatile design with a twin-sized upper bunk and a full-sized lower bunk, making it suitable for various living spaces. It includes a lateral storage ladder, an integrated wardrobe with a hanging rod, and wire shelving on the upper bunk for additional storage.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Adherence to these safety guidelines is crucial to prevent injury and ensure the longevity of your bunk bed.

- **Weight Capacity:** The upper bunk supports up to 250 lbs. The lower bunk supports up to 350 lbs. The trundle bed supports up to 350 lbs. Do not exceed these limits.
- **Mattress Thickness:** Recommended mattress thickness for the twin bunk is 4-6 inches. For the full bunk, it is 6-8 inches.
- **Upper Bunk Use:** The upper bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- **Guardrails:** Always use the guardrails on the upper bunk. Ensure they are properly installed and secured.
- **No Jumping:** Do not allow jumping on the bed.
- **Ladder Safety:** Always use the ladder for access to the upper bunk. Ensure the ladder is stable before climbing.
- **Assembly:** Assembly should be performed by at least two adults. Ensure all hardware is securely tightened before use.

- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all connections and hardware to ensure they remain tight.

### 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

- Upper Bunk Bed Frame Components
- Lower Bunk Bed Frame Components
- Trundle Bed Frame Components
- Lateral Storage Ladder Components
- Wardrobe Components (including hanging rod)
- Bed Slats for Upper, Lower, and Trundle Beds
- Hardware Pack (screws, bolts, nuts, washers, etc.)
- Assembly Tools (e.g., Allen wrench)
- Installation Manual

### 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Assembly of this bunk bed requires two adults. Please follow the detailed step-by-step instructions provided in the separate Installation Manual included with your package. Ensure you have sufficient space for assembly and keep all small parts out of reach of children.

#### **General Assembly Steps:**

1. Unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
2. Identify all parts against the parts list in the Installation Manual.
3. Assemble the lower bunk frame first, ensuring all connections are secure but not fully tightened until the frame is complete.
4. Attach the upper bunk frame to the lower bunk frame according to the manual.
5. Assemble and attach the lateral storage ladder and integrated wardrobe.
6. Install the bed slats for all three beds (upper, lower, trundle).
7. Insert the trundle bed frame into its designated position.
8. Once all components are assembled, fully tighten all hardware.
9. Place recommended mattresses on each bed.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1 Using the Trundle Bed

The trundle bed is designed to slide out from beneath the lower bunk, providing an additional sleeping surface. To use, gently pull the trundle frame outwards until it is fully extended. To store, push the trundle back under the lower bunk until it is fully recessed.

## 5.2 Utilizing the Storage Ladder

The lateral ladder features integrated storage compartments within each step. These compartments can be used to store books, toys, or other small items, helping to keep the room tidy.

### 5.3 Using the Integrated Wardrobe

A compact wardrobe is built into the structure, located adjacent to the storage ladder. It includes a hanging rod for clothes and shelves for folded items, optimizing bedroom organization.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe metal surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish. For wooden parts, use a dry or slightly damp cloth.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain stability and safety.
- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not exceed the specified weight capacities for each bunk and the trundle.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure good air circulation around mattresses to prevent moisture buildup.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter any issues with your bunk bed, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Squeaking Noises:** Squeaking often indicates loose hardware. Re-tighten all bolts and screws,

especially those connecting the main frame components.

- **Instability/Wobbling:** Ensure the bed is on a level surface. Check all frame connections and re-tighten any loose hardware. Verify that all parts are correctly assembled according to the manual.
- **Trundle Not Sliding Smoothly:** Check for any obstructions beneath the bed. Ensure the trundle wheels are clean and free of debris. If the trundle frame is bent or damaged, contact support.
- **Damaged or Missing Parts:** If you discover any damage or missing parts upon receiving the package or during assembly, please contact customer service immediately for replacement parts.
