INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your G Keni CD Cassette Player Radio, Model 9225. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Key Features

- Multi-function playback: Supports CD, CD-R, CD-RW, cassette tapes, USB, SD/MMC/TF cards, and AUX input.
- AM/FM Stereo Radio: Features a high-sensitivity tuner with an extendable antenna and a backlit LCD display for clear frequency indication.
- High-Quality Stereo Speakers: Integrated dual speakers provide clear audio output.
- Headphone Jack: A 3.5mm headphone jack allows for private listening.
- Dual Power Options: Operates via AC power cord or 8 D-size batteries (not included) for portable use.
- Compact Design: Lightweight and portable.

- Recording Function: Record FM radio broadcasts directly to a blank cassette tape.

- **Function Switch:** Selects between CD, Radio, Tape, USB/SD, and AUX modes.
- **Volume Knob:** Adjusts the audio output level.
- **Tuning Knob:** Used to tune into radio stations.
- **LCD Display:** Shows current mode, radio frequency, and track information.
- **CD Compartment:** Top-loading tray for CDs.
- **Cassette Deck:** Front-loading slot for cassette tapes.
- **Playback Controls:** Play, Pause, Stop, Fast Forward, Rewind, Skip Track (for CD/USB/SD).
- **AM/FM Band Switch:** Selects between AM and FM radio bands.

SETUP

Power Supply

The unit can be powered by either AC power or batteries.

AC Power Operation:

1. Ensure the unit is turned off.
2. Connect the supplied AC power cord to the AC IN jack on the back of the unit.
3. Plug the other end of the power cord into a standard AC wall outlet (AC 100V, 50/60Hz).

Battery Operation:

1. Ensure the unit is turned off and disconnected from AC power.

2. Open the battery compartment cover located on the bottom of the unit.
3. Insert 8 D-size (UM-1) batteries (not included) according to the polarity markings (+/-) inside the compartment.
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Note: Remove batteries if the unit will not be used for an extended period to prevent leakage and damage.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Radio Operation (AM/FM)

1. Set the **Function Switch** to [RADIO]. The power lamp will illuminate.
2. Use the **AM/FM Band Switch** to select either [FM STEREO] or [AM].
3. Extend the telescopic antenna for FM reception. For AM reception, rotate the unit for best signal.
4. Turn the **Tuning Knob** to select your desired radio station. The frequency will be displayed on the LCD.

5. Adjust the **Volume Knob** to your preferred listening level.

Tip: If reception is poor, adjust the position of the antenna or the unit itself to minimize static.

CD Playback

1. Set the **Function Switch** to [CD].
2. Open the CD compartment cover.
3. Place a CD (CD, CD-R, CD-RW) onto the spindle with the label side facing up.
4. Close the CD compartment cover.
5. Press the **Play/Pause** button to start playback.
6. Use the **Skip Forward/Backward** buttons to navigate between tracks.
7. Press the **Stop** button to end playback.

Cassette Tape Playback and Recording

Playback:

1. Set the **Function Switch** to [TAPE].
2. Open the cassette deck door.
3. Insert a cassette tape with the open edge facing upwards.
4. Close the cassette deck door.
5. Press the **Play** button to start playback.
6. Use the **Fast Forward** and **Rewind** buttons to quickly navigate the tape.
7. Press the **Stop/Eject** button to stop playback and eject the tape.

Recording from FM Radio to Cassette:

1. Insert a blank cassette tape into the cassette deck.
2. Set the **Function Switch** to [RADIO] and tune to your desired FM station.
3. Press the **Record** button (usually red) on the cassette deck. The Play button will also engage.

4. To stop recording, press the **Stop/Eject** button.

USB/SD/AUX Playback

USB/SD/MMC/TF Playback:

1. Set the **Function Switch** to [USB/SD].
2. Insert a USB flash drive into the USB port or an SD/MMC/TF card into the card slot.
3. The unit will automatically detect and begin playing compatible audio files (e.g., MP3).
4. Use the playback controls (Play/Pause, Skip Forward/Backward) to manage your music.

AUX Input:

1. Set the **Function Switch** to [AUX].
2. Connect an external audio device (e.g., smartphone, MP3 player) to the 3.5mm AUX IN jack using an audio cable (not included).
3. Start playback on your external device. The audio will be routed through the G Keni unit's speakers.
4. Adjust the volume using the unit's **Volume Knob** and/or the external device's volume control.

Headphone Use

For private listening, connect 3.5mm headphones (not included) to the headphone jack. The speakers will automatically mute when headphones are connected.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **CD Lens Care:** If CD playback issues occur, use a commercially available CD lens cleaner.
- **Cassette Head Cleaning:** Regularly clean the cassette heads with a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol to ensure optimal sound quality.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the unit in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Remove batteries if storing for a long time.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not securely connected. Batteries are depleted or incorrectly inserted.	Check AC power cord connection. Replace batteries or ensure correct polarity.
No sound	Volume is too low. Headphones are connected. Incorrect function mode selected.	Increase volume. Disconnect headphones. Select the correct function mode (CD, Radio, Tape, AUX, USB/SD).
Poor radio reception	Antenna not extended or positioned correctly. Interference from other electronic devices.	Extend and adjust the telescopic antenna (FM). Rotate the unit for better AM reception. Move the unit away from other electronics.
CD skipping or not playing	CD is dirty or scratched. CD is inserted incorrectly. Unit is on an unstable surface.	Clean or replace the CD. Ensure CD is placed correctly, label side up. Place the unit on a stable, flat surface.
Cassette tape issues	Tape is tangled or damaged. Cassette heads are dirty.	Inspect tape for damage; try another tape. Clean cassette heads as described in Maintenance.


