# MIDO Ocean Star 39 Automatic Watch User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

The MIDO Ocean Star 39 is a Swiss automatic watch designed for both men and women, featuring a 39mm stainless steel case with a champagne dial. This manual provides essential information for the proper use, care, and maintenance of your timepiece.

MIDO, founded in 1918 by Georges Schaeren, is renowned for combining watchmaking expertise, innovation, functionality, and aesthetics. This watch embodies MIDO's commitment to cutting-edge technology, precise movements, superior quality materials, and timeless design. It is fitted with a latest-generation automatic movement, offering an impressive power reserve and excellent resistance.

Key features include a relief dial evoking ocean currents, a Swiss Automatic Mido Caliber with a 72-hour power reserve, a stainless steel case with a yellow gold color PVD coating, a screw-down crown, and a sapphire crystal with double-sided anti-reflection treatment.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

## SETUP

### Initial Winding and Time Setting

1. **Unscrew the Crown:** Gently unscrew the crown counter-clockwise until it springs out to position 1. This watch features a screw-down crown for enhanced water resistance.
2. **Manual Winding (Position 1):** In position 1, turn the crown clockwise approximately 30-40 times to manually wind the mainspring. This provides an initial power reserve to start the movement.
3. **Setting the Date (Position 2):** Pull the crown out to position 2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement. If the current time falls within this period, set the date to the previous day, then proceed to set the time.
4. **Setting the Time (Position 3):** Pull the crown out further to position 3. The seconds hand will stop. Turn the crown to set the hour and minute hands. To ensure accurate time, set the time a few minutes ahead, then push the crown back to position 0 when a time signal (e.g., from a radio or phone) reaches the desired time.
5. **Secure the Crown:** Once time and date are set, push the crown back into position 0 and screw it down clockwise firmly against the case to ensure water resistance.

## OPERATING YOUR WATCH

### Automatic Movement

Your MIDO Ocean Star 39 is powered by an automatic mechanical movement. This means it is wound by the natural motion of your wrist. When worn regularly (approximately 8-10 hours a day), the watch will maintain its power reserve. If the watch is not worn for an extended period, it may stop. In this case, manually wind it as described in the "Setup" section before wearing.

### Power Reserve

The Mido Caliber offers an impressive power reserve of up to 72 hours when fully wound. This allows the watch to continue running for up to three days even when not worn.

### Water Resistance (200m / 660ft)

The Ocean Star 39 is water-resistant to 20 bar (200 meters / 660 feet). This makes it suitable for swimming, snorkeling, and recreational diving. Always ensure the screw-down crown is fully secured before exposing the watch to water. Do not operate the crown or pushers (if any) while the watch is submerged or wet.

## Unidirectional Rotating Bezel

The watch features a unidirectional rotating bezel, which can be used to measure elapsed time, typically for diving or other timed activities. Rotate the bezel counter-clockwise to align the zero marker with the minute hand. The minute hand's position on the bezel will then indicate the elapsed time.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

- Regularly clean your watch with a soft, damp cloth. For the stainless steel bracelet, a soft brush and mild soapy water can be used, ensuring the crown is fully screwed down. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water and dry with a soft cloth.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaning materials, as these can damage the case, crystal, or PVD coating.

### Service Intervals

Like any precision instrument, your automatic watch requires periodic servicing to ensure optimal performance and longevity. It is recommended to have your MIDO watch serviced by an authorized MIDO service center every 3-5 years. This service typically includes cleaning, lubrication, and adjustment of the movement, as well as replacement of seals to maintain water resistance.

### Storage

When not wearing your watch, store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and strong magnetic fields. A watch box or a soft pouch is ideal for protection.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch has stopped or is losing time.	Insufficient power reserve (not worn enough or not wound).	Manually wind the watch by turning the crown 30-40 times. Wear the watch regularly for at least 8 hours a day.
Date changes at noon instead of midnight.	Time is set incorrectly (AM/PM).	Advance the hour hand by 12 hours.
Condensation under the crystal.	Temperature change or water ingress.	Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center. Do not attempt to dry it yourself.
Crown does not screw down.	Cross-threaded or debris in threads.	Do not force it. Gently push in and rotate counter-clockwise until you feel it drop into the thread, then screw clockwise. If still an issue, contact service.
