SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety during assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Two-Person Assembly:** Assembly requires at least two adults. Do not attempt to assemble alone.
- **Anchoring:** Securely anchor the gazebo to the ground using the provided ground stakes or appropriate hardware for your surface (e.g., concrete anchors for patios).
- **Weather Conditions:** While designed for all-weather use, extreme weather conditions (heavy snow, strong winds, hurricanes) may require additional precautions or temporary disassembly of roof panels. Clear snow accumulation promptly.
- **Clearance:** Ensure adequate clearance around the gazebo from trees, power lines, and other structures.
- **Tools:** Use appropriate tools as specified in the assembly steps. Wear protective gloves and eyewear.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Base Frame Assembly:

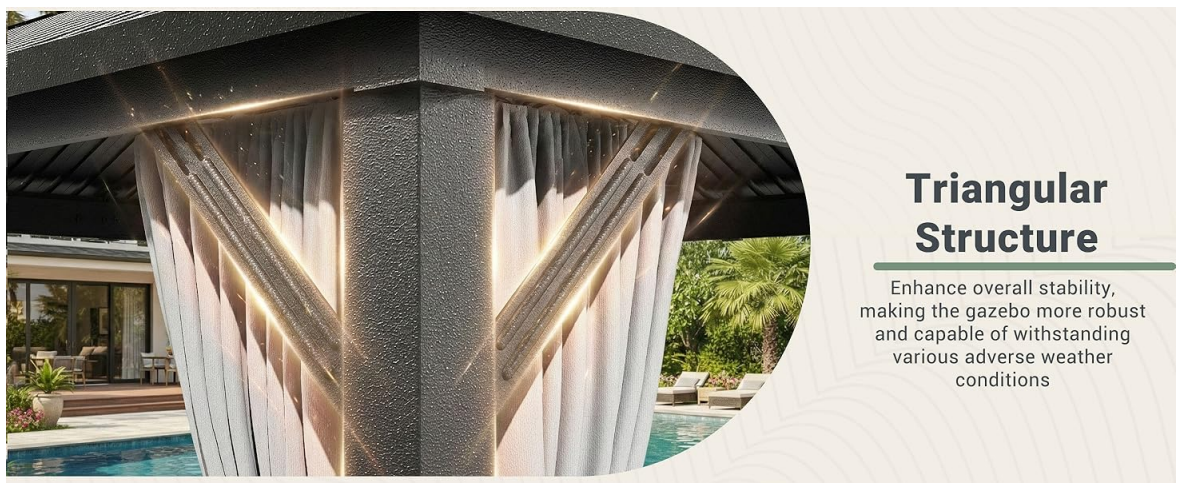
Connect the main horizontal beams to the vertical support legs using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are secure but do not fully tighten bolts until the entire frame is assembled and squared.

2. Roof Structure Assembly:

Attach the upper roof support beams and central hub to the main frame. This creates the skeleton for the galvanized steel roof panels. Pay attention to the orientation of each beam for proper fit.

3. Roof Panel Installation:

Carefully install the galvanized steel roof panels onto the assembled roof structure. Start with the lower tier panels, ensuring they interlock correctly and are securely fastened. Then, install the upper tier panels, which provide ventilation.

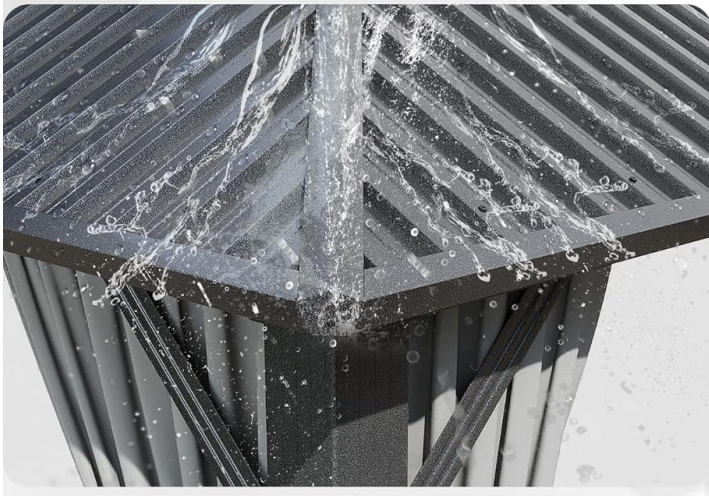
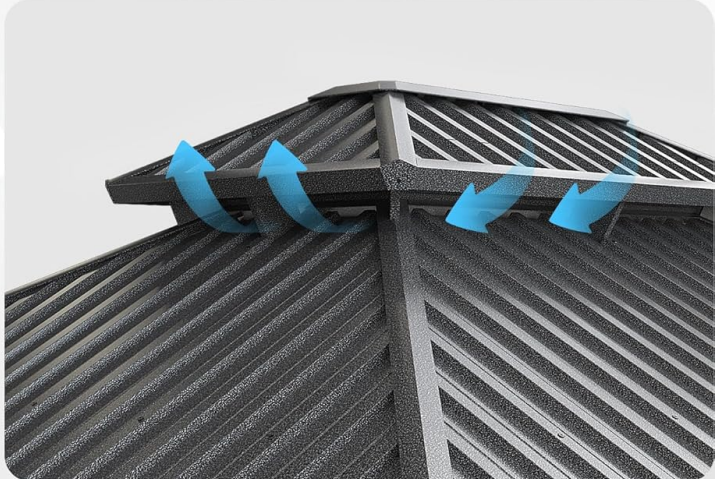

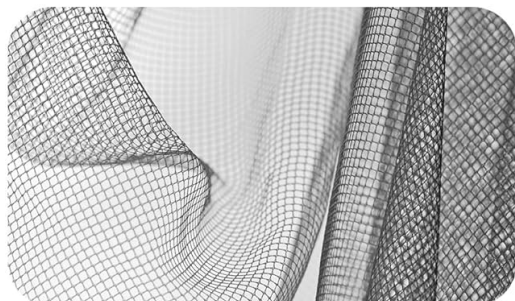

Image: The double-tier roof design with integrated water gutter for efficient drainage.

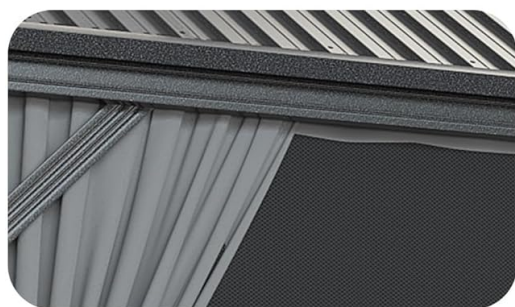
4. Curtain and Netting Attachment:

Hang the dual-track curtains and netting onto the designated tracks. The netting provides insect protection, while the curtains offer privacy and shade. Ensure they glide smoothly along the tracks.

5. Final Tightening and Anchoring:

Once all components are in place and aligned, fully tighten all bolts and screws. Finally, anchor the gazebo securely to your chosen surface using the provided ground stakes or appropriate anchoring hardware.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your AirWire gazebo is designed for versatile outdoor living.

- **Curtains and Netting:** The dual-track system allows you to independently open or close the mesh netting and privacy curtains. Use the zippers on the netting for full enclosure against insects. Tie back the curtains and netting when not in use or during windy conditions.
- **Ventilation:** The double-tiered roof design promotes airflow, reducing heat buildup and enhancing stability in windy conditions.
- **Hanging Accessories:** The roof center includes sturdy hooks for hanging electric lights or fans (not included), enhancing your outdoor experience.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will prolong the life and appearance of your gazebo.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the frame and roof panels with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly. Clean curtains and netting according to fabric care instructions.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically inspect all bolts and screws to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary.
- **Snow Removal:** In snowy regions, regularly remove snow accumulation from the roof to prevent structural stress.
- **Seasonal Care:** While designed for permanent outdoor use, consider storing curtains and netting during prolonged periods of harsh weather to extend their lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Gazebo feels unstable:** Ensure all bolts are fully tightened. Verify proper anchoring to the ground. Check that the ground surface is level.
- **Water leakage from roof:** Ensure all roof panels are correctly installed and overlapping as per instructions. Check that all screws on the roof panels are tight.
- **Curtains/Netting not gliding smoothly:** Check tracks for obstructions or debris. Ensure hooks are properly attached to the curtains/netting and tracks.
