# Ankilo Bluetooth Transmitter Receiver User Manual

Model: CP322

## INTRODUCTION

The Ankilo 2-in-1 Bluetooth Transmitter Receiver is a versatile audio adapter designed to enhance your audio experience. It allows you to wirelessly transmit audio from non-Bluetooth devices (like TVs, PCs, or airplane entertainment systems) to Bluetooth headphones or speakers (TX mode), or receive audio from Bluetooth-enabled devices (like smartphones or tablets) and play it through wired speakers or car stereos (RX mode). Featuring Bluetooth 5.3 technology, it offers stable connections, low latency, and clear audio.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

Familiarize yourself with the components and controls of your Ankilo Bluetooth Transmitter Receiver.

1. **AUX Connector:** 3.5mm audio jack for connecting to audio sources or output devices.
2. **'+' Button:** Click for Next Song (RX mode), Long press for Increase Volume.
3. **'-' Button:** Click for Previous Song (RX mode), Long press for Decrease Volume.
4. **'M' Button:** Multi-function button for mode selection and pairing.
5. **Indicator Light:** Displays device status (pairing, connected, charging).
6. **TX/RX Switch Button:** Toggles between Transmitter (TX) and Receiver (RX) modes.
7. **Charging Port:** USB-C port for charging the device.

## SETUP AND OPERATION

---

### Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the device. Connect the provided USB-C cable to the charging port on the adapter and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter). The indicator light will show charging status and turn off when fully charged.

## Long Battery Time

### Transmitter (TX) Mode

In TX mode, the device transmits audio from a non-Bluetooth source to your Bluetooth headphones or speakers.

1. **Switch to TX Mode:** Slide the TX/RX switch button to the 'TX' position.
2. **Connect to Audio Source:** Plug the 3.5mm AUX connector of the adapter into the audio output port of your non-Bluetooth device (e.g., TV, PC, airplane entertainment system).
3. **Power On:** Long-press the 'M' button for 3 seconds to turn on the adapter. The indicator light will blink red, indicating it's in pairing mode.
4. **Pair with Bluetooth Headphones/Speakers:** Put your Bluetooth headphones or speakers into pairing mode. Place them close to the Ankilo adapter. The adapter will automatically search and connect.
5. **Connection Successful:** Once connected, the red indicator light will blink slowly. Audio from your source device will now be transmitted to your Bluetooth headphones/speakers.

**Note:** For the first pairing, it may take 1-3 minutes. Subsequent pairings will be faster. Ensure other Bluetooth devices are turned off to avoid interference during pairing.

## Receiver (RX) Mode

In RX mode, the device receives audio from a Bluetooth-enabled source (like your smartphone) and plays it through wired speakers or car stereos.

1. **Switch to RX Mode:** Slide the TX/RX switch button to the 'RX' position.
2. **Connect to Audio Output Device:** Plug the 3.5mm AUX connector of the adapter into the audio input port of your wired speaker, car stereo, or home sound system.
3. **Power On:** Long-press the 'M' button for 3 seconds to turn on the adapter. The indicator light will blink blue, indicating it's in pairing mode.
4. **Pair with Bluetooth Device:** On your smartphone or tablet, enable Bluetooth and search for "BT-13" (or similar device name). Select it to connect.
5. **Connection Successful:** Once connected, the blue indicator light will blink slowly. Audio from your Bluetooth

device will now play through your wired speakers.

## MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Ankilo Bluetooth Transmitter Receiver, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the device. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Avoid Physical Damage:** Do not drop, bend, or expose the device to strong impacts.
- **Charging:** Use only the provided USB-C cable or a certified equivalent for charging.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the device fully using the USB-C cable.
Cannot pair with Bluetooth headphones/speakers (TX mode).	Headphones/speakers not in pairing mode; adapter not in TX mode; interference from other Bluetooth devices.	Ensure headphones/speakers are in pairing mode. Verify the adapter is switched to TX. Turn off other nearby Bluetooth devices. Try restarting both devices.
Cannot connect to smartphone/tablet (RX mode).	Adapter not in RX mode; Bluetooth not enabled on phone; incorrect device selected.	Verify the adapter is switched to RX. Enable Bluetooth on your phone and search for "BT-13". Ensure no other device is connected to the adapter.
No audio or low audio.	Volume too low on source/receiving device or adapter; incorrect cable connection; device not fully paired.	Adjust volume on all connected devices. Ensure 3.5mm cable is fully inserted. Re-pair the devices.
Audio quality is poor or muffled.	Interference; distance from paired device; low battery.	Reduce distance between devices. Ensure no strong interference sources nearby. Charge the device.
