INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Comfort Direct RH787T / TR29 DC Ceiling Fan Remote Control. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper function and longevity of your device.

SETUP AND PROGRAMMING

Follow these steps to set up and program your remote control with your DC ceiling fan.

1. Install Battery

The remote control requires one 23A/12V battery (not included). Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote and insert the battery, observing the correct polarity.

2. Programming Your Remote

1. **Turn power off to the fan:** Ensure the power supply to your ceiling fan is off. This can be done using an on/off switch on the wall or by switching off the circuit breaker for the fan.

2. **Set the dip switches:** Locate the dip switches inside the battery compartment of your remote control. Set these switches to your desired code. Ensure the dip switches on the remote match the dip switches on your fan's receiver unit.

3. **Restore power and sync:** Restore power to your fan. Within 1 minute of restoring power, press and hold the **[SET]** button located in the battery compartment for approximately 5 seconds.

4. **Confirmation:** The red indicator light on the remote will blink twice, confirming that your fan is now synced to your remote control.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The RH787T / TR29 remote control provides intuitive control over your DC ceiling fan's functions.

- **Fan Speed Control:** Buttons labeled **I** through **VI** control the fan speed, with **I** being the lowest and **VI** being the highest setting.
- **Fan On/Off:** The central button within the fan speed cluster typically controls the fan's power (on/off).
- **Light Control:** The lower set of buttons controls the fan's light. One button is for turning the light on/off, and the other is for dimming or brightening the light.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Replacement

When the remote control's range decreases or the indicator light becomes dim, it is time to replace the battery. Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote and replace the old 23A/12V battery with a new one, ensuring correct polarity. Dispose of used batteries responsibly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the following guide for common issues and their solutions regarding your remote control's indicator light.

Troubleshooting Your Remote Control

Bad Remote Control Symptoms

1. Red indicator light does not illuminate when buttons are pressed.
 2. Red indicator light illuminates when no buttons are pressed.
 3. Red indicator light stays illuminated at all times.
- Replace remote control if you experience any of these symptoms.

Good Remote Control Symptoms

1. Red indicator light only illuminates when buttons are pressed.
 2. Red indicator light stays illuminated when you PRESS and HOLD buttons.
- DO NOT Replace remote control if you experience these symptoms. You have a different problem with your fan.

Red Indicator Light

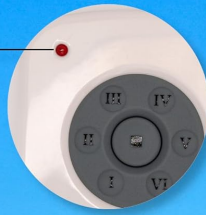


Image: A graphic illustrating troubleshooting steps based on the behavior of the remote control's red indicator light.

Bad Remote Control Symptoms	Good Remote Control Symptoms / Action
1. Red indicator light does not illuminate when buttons are pressed.	1. Red indicator light only illuminates when buttons are pressed.
2. Red indicator light illuminates when no buttons are pressed.	2. Red indicator light stays illuminated when you press and hold buttons.
3. Red indicator light stays illuminated at all times.	DO NOT replace the remote control if you experience the symptoms in the right column. You may have a different problem with your fan.
Replace remote control if you experience any of the symptoms in the left column.
