1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Greenvelly 72" Locking Metal Storage Cabinet. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new storage cabinet. Please read these instructions thoroughly before beginning assembly and retain them for future reference.

This cabinet is constructed from high-quality cold-rolled steel, featuring a waterproof and rust-resistant coating for enhanced durability. It includes four adjustable shelves and a secure 3-point locking system, making it suitable for various environments such as home offices, garages, shops, and schools.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Anti-Tip Feature:** The cabinet is equipped with an anti-tip feature and mounting holes on the back for wall fixation. It is crucial to secure the cabinet to a wall to prevent tipping, especially in households with children or in areas prone to seismic activity.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute items evenly across shelves. Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity per shelf or for the entire cabinet.
- **Hazardous Materials:** Use the locking mechanism to secure potentially hazardous objects, chemicals, or sharp tools away from unauthorized access, particularly children.
- **Assembly Safety:** Assembly requires at least two people due to the size and weight of components. Wear appropriate safety gear, such as gloves, to prevent cuts or pinches.
- **Stable Surface:** Ensure the cabinet is placed on a flat, stable, and level surface to prevent instability.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all parts are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact Greenvelly customer support.

- Cabinet Panels (Top, Bottom, Sides, Back, Doors)
- Adjustable Shelves (4 included)
- Locking Mechanism and Handles

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Greenvelly storage cabinet typically requires 1-2 people and approximately 40 minutes. Follow the detailed assembly instructions provided in the package. A video tutorial is also available to guide you through the process.

4.1 Assembly Steps Overview

1. Unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
2. Assemble the main frame of the cabinet (top, bottom, and side panels).
3. Install the back panel.
4. Attach the door hinges and doors.
5. Install the locking mechanism and handles. Ensure the locking bars are correctly aligned.
6. Insert the adjustable shelves at your desired heights.
7. Secure the cabinet to the wall using the provided anti-tip hardware.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Opening and Closing the Doors

To open the cabinet doors, turn the key in the lock counter-clockwise to unlock, then pull the handles. To close, push the doors firmly until they latch, then turn the key clockwise to lock.

5.2 Using the Locking Mechanism

The cabinet features a 3-point locking system for enhanced security. Insert one of the two provided keys into the lock on the right door. Turn the key clockwise to engage the locking bars at the top, middle, and bottom of the door. Turn counter-clockwise to disengage. Always ensure both doors are fully closed before locking.

5.3 Adjusting Shelves

The cabinet includes four adjustable shelves. To adjust a shelf, remove all items from it. Locate the shelf clips on the vertical support rails inside the cabinet. Remove the clips, reposition them to the desired height, and then place the shelf back onto the clips. Ensure all four clips are securely in place before loading the shelf.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** The cabinet's surface is coated with a waterproof and rust-resistant finish, making it easy to clean. Use a soft, damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Tighten any loose fasteners to maintain stability and safety.
- **Lubrication:** If the door hinges or locking mechanism become stiff, apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to ensure smooth operation.
- **Environmental Conditions:** While designed for durability, avoid exposing the cabinet to extreme temperatures or prolonged direct sunlight, which could affect the finish over time.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Greenvelly storage cabinet, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Doors do not close properly or are misaligned.	Loose hinges or uneven assembly.	Check and tighten all hinge screws. Ensure the cabinet is on a level surface. Re-adjust door alignment if necessary.
Locking mechanism is stiff or not engaging.	Lack of lubrication or misalignment of locking bars.	Apply silicone lubricant to the lock and locking bars. Ensure the doors are fully closed and aligned before attempting to lock.
Shelves are unstable or sag.	Incorrectly installed shelf clips or overloaded shelf.	Ensure all four shelf clips are fully inserted and supporting the shelf. Reduce the weight on the shelf if it exceeds the 180-pound limit.
Cabinet wobbles.	Uneven floor or loose connections.	Adjust the cabinet's position on a level surface. Tighten all assembly bolts and screws. Ensure the anti-tip mechanism is properly installed.
Minor dents or bent corners from shipping.	Transit damage.	Small bends can often be carefully hammered or bent back into place with pliers. If damage is significant, contact customer support.
