INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HOMCOM Portable Wardrobe. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new wardrobe. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This portable wardrobe is designed for easy assembly. It is recommended to assemble the unit on a clean, flat surface. Ensure all components are present before beginning.

Package Contents:

- Steel Tubes (various lengths)
- PP Plastic Connectors
- Non-Woven Fabric Shelves
- Non-Woven Fabric Cover with Hinged Door
- Hanging Rod

Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and verify against the parts list.
2. **Assemble Base Frame:** Connect the shortest steel tubes with PP connectors to form the base rectangle. Ensure all tubes are fully inserted into the connectors.

3. **Build Vertical Supports:** Attach longer steel tubes to the base connectors, building upwards.
4. **Install Fabric Shelves:** Slide the fabric shelves onto the designated steel tube sections as you build the frame. Ensure they are taut and properly supported.
5. **Install Hanging Rod:** Insert the hanging rod into its designated connectors at the top section of the wardrobe.
6. **Complete Top Frame:** Finish the top frame using the remaining steel tubes and connectors.
7. **Attach Fabric Cover:** Drape the non-woven fabric cover over the assembled frame. Ensure the zippered door aligns correctly.
8. **Secure Cover:** Fasten the cover to the frame using any integrated ties or fasteners to ensure a snug fit.

OPERATION AND USE

The HOMCOM Portable Wardrobe offers versatile storage solutions for various items.

Using the Hanging Rod:

- Use the integrated hanging rod for coats, dresses, shirts, and other garments that require hanging.
- Distribute weight evenly along the rod to prevent strain on the frame.

Utilizing the Shelves:

- The six open shelves are ideal for folded clothes, bags, shoes, and other accessories.
- Place heavier items on lower shelves for better stability.

Managing the Hinged Door:

- The non-woven fabric cover features a hinged door with a zipper to protect contents from dust.
- For easy access, the door panel can be rolled up and secured with the integrated hook-and-loop fasteners.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your portable wardrobe.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the non-woven fabric surfaces with a damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Frame Inspection:** Periodically check all steel tube connections and PP connectors to ensure they are secure. Tighten if necessary.
- **Weight Distribution:** Do not overload the hanging rod or shelves beyond their specified weight capacities to prevent damage to the frame or fabric.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Keep the wardrobe in a dry environment. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight or excessive moisture, which can degrade the fabric.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your HOMCOM Portable Wardrobe, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Wardrobe feels unstable:**
Ensure all steel tubes are fully inserted into the PP connectors. Check that the frame is assembled squarely

and placed on a level surface.

- **Fabric shelves or cover tearing:**

Avoid exceeding the maximum weight capacity for each shelf and the hanging rod. Handle the fabric components gently during assembly and daily use. Ensure no sharp objects are stored that could snag the fabric.

- **Zipper or door panel not functioning smoothly:**

Check for any fabric obstructions in the zipper path. Ensure the wardrobe frame is not warped, which could misalign the door. If rolling up the door, ensure the hook-and-loop fasteners are properly aligned.
