## INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the K-FEE Twins II Single Serve Coffee & Espresso Machine and Lattaero 4-in-1 Milk Frother Bundle. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and keep them for future reference.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.

- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Scalding may occur if the lid is removed during the brewing cycle.

### Lattaero 4-in-1 Milk Frother

- Frother Jug
- Lid

- Whisk (for frothing)
- Stirrer (for warming milk)
- Base with Control Buttons (Warm Thick Foam, Warm Creamy Foam, Warm Milk, Cold Foam)

## SETUP

### Initial Setup for K-FEE Twins II Machine

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future transport or storage.
2. **Placement:** Place the machine on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface, away from water sources and heat.
3. **Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the water tank, drip tray, and capsule holder with warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
4. **Fill Water Tank:** Fill the water tank with fresh, cold drinking water up to the MAX level. Place it back onto the machine.
5. **Power On:** Plug the machine into a grounded electrical outlet. Press the power button. The buttons will flash as the machine heats up.
6. **First Rinse Cycle:** Place a large cup under the brew head. Press the "Coffee" button (larger cup icon) to run a rinse cycle without a capsule. Repeat this process 2-3 times to prime the system and clean internal components.

### Initial Setup for Lattaero Milk Frother

1. **Unpacking:** Remove the frother and its accessories from the packaging.
2. **Cleaning:** Wash the frother jug and whisk/stirrer with warm soapy water. Rinse and dry thoroughly. The base should only be wiped with a damp cloth.
3. **Assembly:** Insert the desired whisk (frothing or stirring) onto the spindle at the bottom of the jug.
4. **Placement:** Place the frother jug onto its power base.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Brewing Coffee or Espresso with K-FEE Twins II

1. **Ensure Water:** Make sure the water tank is filled with fresh water.
2. **Power On:** Press the power button if the machine is off. Wait for the buttons to stop flashing, indicating it's ready.
3. **Insert Capsule:** Lift the lever to open the brew head. Insert a K-FEE compatible capsule into the capsule holder. Close the lever firmly.
4. **Place Cup:** Place your desired cup on the drip tray.
5. **Select Brew Size:**
  - For Espresso: Press the "Espresso" button (smaller cup icon).
  - For Coffee: Press the "Coffee" button (larger cup icon).

The machine will begin brewing. The selected button will flash during brewing and remain illuminated when complete.

6. **Eject Capsule:** After brewing, lift the lever to eject the used capsule into the internal collection bin. Close the lever.
7. **Hot Water Function:** To dispense hot water, ensure no capsule is inserted, and press the "Hot Water" button (steam icon).

**Programming Brew Volume:** You can customize the brew volume for each button.

- a. Ensure the machine is ready (buttons solid).
- b. Insert a capsule (or no capsule for hot water).
- c. Press and hold the desired brew button (Espresso, Coffee, or Hot Water).
- d. Release the button when your cup reaches the desired fill level. The machine will remember this setting for future brews.

### Using the Lattaero 4-in-1 Milk Frother

1. **Prepare Jug:** Ensure the frother jug is clean and the correct whisk/stirrer is inserted.
2. **Add Milk:** Pour cold milk into the jug. Do not exceed the MAX fill lines indicated inside the jug (lower line for frothing, upper line for warming).
3. **Select Function:** Place the lid on the jug and place the jug on the power base. Press the desired button on the base:

- **Warm Thick Foam:** For dense, rich foam.
- **Warm Creamy Foam:** For lighter, smoother foam.
- **Warm Milk:** For heated milk without foam (use stirrer).
- **Cold Foam:** For cold, frothed milk.

The selected button will illuminate and the frother will start.

4. **Completion:** The frother will automatically stop when the cycle is complete. Carefully remove the jug from the base and pour the frothed or warmed milk.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### Daily Cleaning (K-FEE Twins II)

- **Drip Tray & Capsule Bin:** Empty and rinse the drip tray and used capsule collection bin daily. Wash with warm soapy water, rinse, and dry.

- **Water Tank:** Rinse the water tank daily and refill with fresh water. Clean with warm soapy water weekly.
- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the machine with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the machine in water.

## Daily Cleaning (Lattaero Milk Frother)

- **Frother Jug & Whisk:** Immediately after each use, rinse the frother jug and whisk with water. For thorough cleaning, wash with warm soapy water, rinse, and dry. The jug is not dishwasher safe.
- **Base:** Wipe the frother base with a soft, damp cloth. Never immerse the base in water.

## Descaling (K-FEE Twins II)

Descaling is essential to maintain machine performance and extend its lifespan. The frequency depends on water hardness and usage. It is recommended every 3-6 months.

1. **Prepare Solution:** Use a K-FEE approved descaling solution mixed with water according to the descaler's instructions. Fill the water tank with this solution.
2. **Start Descaling:** Place a large container (at least 1 liter) under the brew head.
3. **Run Cycle:** Press and hold the "Coffee" and "Espresso" buttons simultaneously for 3 seconds to enter descaling mode. The buttons will flash alternately.
4. **Complete Cycle:** The machine will dispense the descaling solution in intervals. This process can take up to 20 minutes.
5. **Rinse:** Once the tank is empty, rinse the water tank thoroughly and fill it with fresh water. Run at least two full rinse cycles (using the "Coffee" button) to flush out any remaining descaling solution.
6. **Exit Descaling:** The machine will automatically exit descaling mode after the rinse cycles.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine not turning on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet.
No coffee dispenses.	Water tank empty; machine not primed; brew head not closed properly; clogged needle.	Fill water tank. Run a rinse cycle. Ensure lever is fully closed. Clean the brew head needle (refer to maintenance).
Coffee is cold or lukewarm.	Machine not preheated; cups not preheated.	Allow machine to fully preheat (buttons solid). Pre-warm your cup with hot water.
Frother not frothing milk.	Incorrect whisk; milk level too high/low; milk type; jug not clean.	Ensure frothing whisk is used. Check milk levels (between MIN/MAX frothing lines). Use cold, fresh milk (dairy or plant-based suitable for frothing). Clean jug thoroughly.
Machine leaking.	Water tank not seated correctly; drip tray full; internal seal issue.	Ensure water tank is firmly in place. Empty drip tray. If leaking persists, contact customer support.
Buttons flashing continuously.	Machine heating up; descaling required.	Wait for buttons to become solid. If flashing persists after heating, descaling may be needed.
