INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the proper use, care, and maintenance of your Timberland PRO Men's 8 Inch Boondock Soft Toe Waterproof Work and Hunt Boots. Adhering to these guidelines will help ensure the longevity and performance of your footwear.

KEY FEATURES

- **Anti-Fatigue Technology:** Engineered with shock-absorbing, geometrical technology to return energy to the foot, providing all-day support and comfort.

- **Waterproof Membrane:** Provides maximum waterproof protection and meets ASTM F1671-07 safety standards for resistance to blood-borne pathogens.

- **ReBOTL Material:** Linings are made from ReBOTL fabric, containing at least 50% recycled PET (polyethylene terephthalate) from plastic bottles, contributing to environmental sustainability.
- **Electrical Hazard Protection:** Provides secondary underfoot protection against live electrical circuits, electrically energized conductors, parts, or apparatus; meets ASTM F2412-18a, ASTM F2413-18, and ASTM F2892-18 standards.

SETUP

Initial Fit and Lacing

1. **Try-On:** Wear the boots with the type of socks you typically use for work or outdoor activities. Ensure there is adequate room for your toes to move freely without touching the front of the boot.
2. **Lacing:** Lace the boots securely, starting from the bottom eyelets and working your way up. Ensure even tension across all laces. Use the speed hooks at the top for quick and efficient lacing.

3. **Break-In Period:** While these boots are designed for comfort, a short break-in period may be beneficial. Wear them for shorter durations initially to allow the leather to conform to your foot shape.

OPERATING (INTENDED USE)

These Timberland PRO Boondock boots are designed for demanding work environments and outdoor activities requiring robust protection and comfort. They are suitable for:

- Construction and industrial work.
- Outdoor hunting and rugged terrain.
- Environments requiring waterproof and electrical hazard protection.

Always ensure the boots are properly laced and fitted for optimal support and safety during use.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning and Care

1. **Regular Cleaning:** After each use, especially in dirty or wet conditions, brush off loose dirt and debris with a soft brush. For stubborn dirt, use a damp cloth.
2. **Drying:** Allow boots to air dry naturally at room temperature. Avoid direct heat sources like radiators or open flames, as this can damage the leather and adhesives. For faster drying, you may remove the footbeds.
3. **Leather Conditioning:** Periodically apply a high-quality leather conditioner or waterproofing treatment suitable for full-grain leather to maintain its suppleness and water resistance. Follow the product manufacturer's instructions.
4. **Storage:** Store boots in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. Using boot trees can help maintain their shape.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues

- **Reduced Waterproofing:** Over time, the external waterproofing treatment on leather can diminish. Regular application of a suitable leather waterproofing spray or wax can restore this. Ensure the internal waterproof membrane is not compromised by punctures or excessive wear.
- **Discomfort/Poor Fit:** Ensure you are wearing the correct size and width. Refer to the sizing information section. If discomfort persists, consider trying different insoles or consulting a footwear specialist.
- **Squeaking:** New boots may sometimes squeak due to friction between components. This often resolves with wear. If it persists, try applying a small amount of talcum powder or silicone spray to areas of friction.
