## 1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembling and using this bunk bed. Retain this manual for future reference.

- **Age Restriction:** The top bunk is intended for use by children 6 years of age and older.
- **Weight Capacity:** The upper bed has a weight capacity of 300 LBS. The bottom bed has no specific weight limit. Do not exceed these limits.
- **Guardrails:** Ensure all guardrails are securely attached and in place before use. Guardrails are designed to prevent falls from the top bunk.
- **Mattress Thickness:** Use only mattresses that are 6 inches thick or less for both the upper and lower bunks to ensure proper guardrail height and safety.

- **No Jumping:** Do not allow jumping on the bed.
- **Ladder/Stairs Safety:** Always use the provided stairs for access to the top bunk. Do not use alternative methods.
- **Ventilation:** The wood frame and slats are designed to allow air to move freely around your mattress, promoting freshness.
- **Assembly:** Ensure all hardware is tightened securely during assembly. Periodically check and re-tighten hardware as needed.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate airflow around the mattress for hygiene and longevity.

## 2. COMPONENTS AND HARDWARE

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components and hardware are present and undamaged. Refer to the included assembly instructions for a detailed list and diagrams.

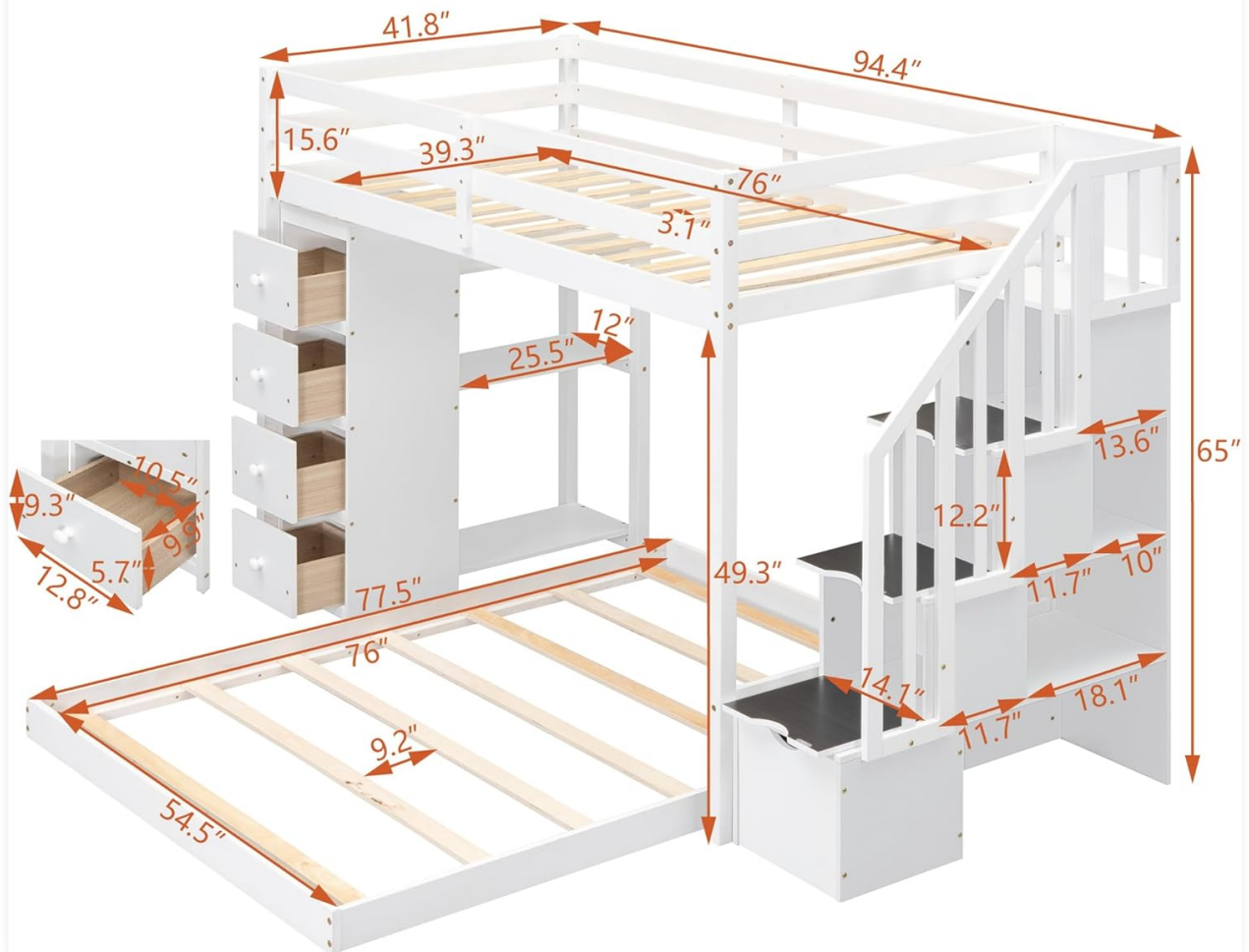
## 2.1 Main Components

- Upper Twin Bed Frame
- Lower Full Bed Frame (pull-out design)
- Integrated Storage Stairs
- Side Shelving Unit with Drawers
- Bed Slats (for both upper and lower bunks)
- Guardrails

## 2.2 Hardware Package

A comprehensive hardware package is included with all necessary screws, bolts, and tools for assembly. Please ensure all items are accounted for before starting.

## 3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the roomfitters Twin Over Full Bunk Bed requires careful attention to detail. It is recommended to have two adults for assembly. All necessary tools are provided.

### 3.1 Preparation

1. Clear a spacious area for assembly, ensuring enough room to move around the bed components.
2. Unpack all boxes and lay out components on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
3. Identify all parts and hardware by comparing them with the included assembly manual's parts list.

### 3.2 Assembly Steps

Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly manual included with your purchase. General steps typically include:

1. Assemble the main frame of the lower full bed.
2. Attach the side shelving unit and drawers.
3. Assemble the upper twin bed frame and attach it to the main structure.
4. Install the integrated storage stairs.
5. Securely attach all guardrails to the upper bunk.
6. Place the bed slats onto both the upper and lower bed frames.
7. Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened. Do not overtighten.

**Note:** Some assembly steps may require lifting heavy components. Seek assistance to prevent injury.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This bunk bed is designed for maximized space and functionality, offering various storage and sleeping options.

### 4.1 Using the Pull-Out Lower Bed

The lower full-size bed is designed to be pulled out for independent use or pushed in to save space. Gently pull the bed frame outwards from the main structure until it is fully extended. To retract, push the bed frame back into its original position until it aligns with the main structure.

## 4.2 Utilizing Storage Drawers and Shelves

The bunk bed features four large drawers integrated into the side shelving unit and additional storage compartments within the stairs. These are ideal for storing clothes, books, toys, or other personal items.

- **Drawers:** Gently pull the knobs to open the drawers. Ensure items are placed evenly to prevent tipping.
- **Shelves:** The open shelves can be used for displaying decorations, storing books, or placing a laptop. Ensure items are stable and do not obstruct pathways.
- **Stair Storage:** Each step of the stairs may contain a hidden storage compartment. Lift the step cover to access.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and safety of your roomfitters bunk bed.

### 5.1 Cleaning

- Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- For stubborn marks, use a mild soap solution and immediately dry with a clean cloth.

### 5.2 Hardware Checks

- Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months), inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary.
- Do not overtighten, as this can strip threads or damage wood.

### 5.3 Mattress Care

- Ensure mattresses are of the recommended thickness (6 inches or less) to maintain guardrail effectiveness.
- The slatted base promotes air circulation, helping to keep mattresses fresh.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bunk bed.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable	Loose hardware connections.	Check and re-tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
Squeaking noises	Loose connections or friction between wood parts.	Re-tighten all hardware. If squeaking persists, apply a small amount of furniture wax or silicone spray to contact points (avoiding areas that bear weight).
Drawers stick or are difficult to open/close	Misalignment or obstruction.	Ensure drawers are correctly seated on their glides. Check for any items obstructing the drawer's path. Verify assembly of drawer glides.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Missing parts during assembly	Packaging error or overlooked part.	Carefully re-check all packaging materials. If still missing, contact roomfitters customer support with your purchase details.
