INTRODUCTION

The BISSELL Little Green Mini Portable Carpet and Upholstery Deep Cleaner, Model 4075, is designed for effective spot and stain removal from various surfaces. Its compact and lightweight design allows for easy access to hard-to-clean areas such as staircases, car interiors, carpets, and upholstery. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your device.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your BISSELL Little Green Mini (Model 4075) package includes the following components:

- **Portable Carpet Cleaner Unit:** The main device for deep cleaning.
- **4" Tough Stain Tool:** Features a removable lens for effective scrubbing and suctioning of embedded dirt and stains.
- **HydroRinse Self-Cleaning Hose Tool:** Designed for easy rinsing of the machine's hose after use.
- **8oz. BISSELL Little Green Formula:** A trial-sized formula for instant and permanent stain removal, odor elimination, and protection against future stains with StainProtect® Technology.

SETUP

Before first use, ensure all components are present and undamaged. Follow these steps for initial setup:

1. **Fill the Clean Water Tank:** Remove the clean water tank from the unit. Unscrew the cap and fill the tank with water up to the indicated fill line. For optimal cleaning, use warm (not boiling) tap water.
2. **Add Cleaning Formula:** Pour the provided 8oz. BISSELL Little Green Formula into the clean water tank up to the designated formula fill line. Securely screw the cap back onto the tank and place it back onto the unit.
3. **Attach Desired Tool:** Connect either the 4" Tough Stain Tool or the HydroRinse Self-Cleaning Hose Tool to the end of the hose until it clicks securely into place.
4. **Power Connection:** Unwind the power cord and plug the unit into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To effectively clean stains and messes, follow these operating steps:

1. **Turn On the Unit:** Press the power button located on the top of the unit to turn it on.
2. **Spray Cleaning Solution:** Hold the attached tool directly over the stain. Press the trigger on the tool to spray the cleaning solution onto the stained area. Allow the solution to penetrate the stain for a few minutes, as recommended by the formula instructions.
3. **Scrub the Stain:** Use the bristles on the tool to gently scrub the stained surface. For tougher stains, apply more pressure and scrub in multiple directions.
4. **Suction the Liquid:** Release the spray trigger and tilt the tool slightly to engage the suction nozzle. Pull the tool slowly over the treated area to extract the dirty liquid. Repeat this step until no more dirty liquid is being removed and the area feels as dry as possible.
5. **Repeat if Necessary:** For stubborn stains, repeat the spray, scrub, and suction process until the stain is completely removed.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your cleaner:

1. **Empty and Rinse Dirty Water Tank:** After each use, remove the dirty water tank. Unlock and remove the lid by rotating the handle fully back. Empty the dirty water and rinse the tank thoroughly with clean water. Allow it to air dry before reattaching.
2. **Clean Tools:** Detach the cleaning tool from the hose. Use the HydroRinse Self-Cleaning Hose Tool by attaching it to the hose and placing it into a sink or bucket. Turn on the unit and press the trigger to flush clean water through the hose and tool, removing any residue. Rinse the 4" Tough Stain Tool under running water.
3. **Wipe Down Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth.
4. **Storage:** Store the unit in a cool, dry place. The compact design allows for convenient storage in small spaces like cabinets or closets. Ensure the hose is wrapped neatly around the base of the unit.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BISSELL Little Green Mini, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Suction:** Check if the dirty water tank is properly seated and sealed. Ensure the cleaning tool is firmly attached to the hose. Verify that the dirty water tank is not full.
- **No Spray:** Ensure the clean water tank is filled with water and formula. Check if the clean water tank is properly seated. Verify that the spray trigger on the tool is being pressed.
- **Unit Not Turning On:** Confirm the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check the power button is in the 'On' position.
- **Poor Cleaning Results:** Ensure you are using the correct BISSELL cleaning formula. Allow the formula sufficient time to penetrate the stain before scrubbing and suctioning. Repeat the cleaning process if necessary.

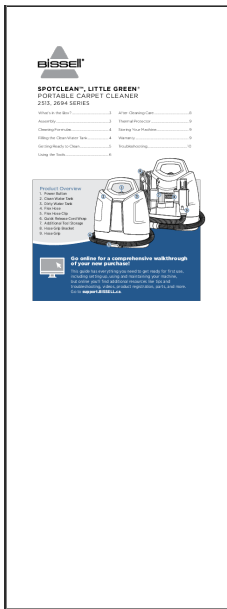

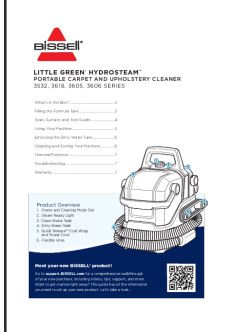
