1. SETUP

1.1 Package Contents

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- BEARBISU Digital Camera H15
- 64GB SD Card
- Wrist Strap
- Rechargeable Battery
- USB-C Charging Cable
- USB Adapter
- User Manual (this document)

## 1.2 Battery Installation and Charging

1. Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the camera.
2. Open the compartment cover.
3. Insert the rechargeable battery, ensuring the correct polarity as indicated inside the compartment.
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.
5. Connect the camera to a power source using the provided USB-C charging cable and adapter. The charging indicator light will illuminate.
6. Charge the camera until the indicator light changes or turns off, signifying a full charge.

## 1.3 Memory Card Installation

The camera supports SD cards up to 64GB. A 64GB card is included.

1. Locate the SD card slot, typically near the battery compartment or on the side of the camera.
2. Insert the 64GB SD card into the slot with the metal contacts facing the front of the camera, until it clicks into place.

3. To remove, gently press the card inward until it springs out.

## 1.4 Powering On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the Power button (usually marked with a circle and a vertical line) until the screen illuminates.
- To power off: Press and hold the Power button again until the screen turns off.

### 2.1 Basic Photography (Photo Mode)

The camera captures 44MP photos and 1080p videos.

## 2.1.1 Taking a Photo

1. Ensure the camera is in Photo Mode (indicated by an icon on the screen, typically a camera symbol).
2. Frame your subject using the LCD screen.
3. Press the Shutter button (usually on top of the camera) halfway down to focus, then fully press to capture the image.



### 2.1.2 Zoom Function

The camera features 16x digital zoom.

- Use the 'W' (Wide) and 'T' (Telephoto) buttons, typically located near the shutter, to zoom out and zoom in, respectively.

### 2.1.3 Using Filters

The camera includes 20 unique filters to enhance your photos.

- Access the filter options through the camera's menu.
- Navigate using the directional buttons and select your desired filter.

#### **2.1.4 Self-Timer**

Utilize the self-timer for group photos or stable shots.

- Access the self-timer setting in the menu.
- Choose from 2-second, 5-second, or 10-second delays.

### **2.2 Video Recording (Video Mode)**

The camera records in Full HD 1080p.

#### **2.2.1 Starting/Stopping Recording**

1. Switch the camera to Video Mode (indicated by a video camera icon).
2. Press the Shutter button to start recording. A red dot or recording indicator will appear on the screen.
3. Press the Shutter button again to stop recording.

#### **2.2.2 Built-in Microphone**

The integrated microphone captures audio during video recording.

### **2.3 Anti-Shake Function**

The anti-shake feature helps reduce blur caused by camera movement.

- This function is typically enabled by default or can be toggled in the camera settings.

## 2.4 Webcam Functionality

The camera can function as a webcam when connected to a computer.

1. Connect the camera to your computer using the USB-C cable.
2. Select 'Webcam Mode' or 'PC Camera' from the options displayed on the camera screen (if prompted).
3. Your computer should recognize the camera as a webcam for video conferencing or streaming

applications.

### 3. MAINTENANCE

#### 3.1 Cleaning the Camera

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the camera body.
- For the lens and screen, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution, applying gently to avoid scratches.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

#### 3.2 Battery Care

- Charge the battery fully before first use.
- Avoid completely draining the battery regularly to prolong its lifespan.
- If storing the camera for an extended period, remove the battery.

#### 3.3 Storage

- Store the camera in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Use a protective case or pouch to prevent dust and scratches.

### 4. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not power on.	Battery is drained or incorrectly inserted.	Ensure battery is fully charged and correctly inserted.
Cannot take photos/videos.	SD card is full, not inserted, or corrupted.	Check SD card storage. Reinsert or replace SD card. Format SD card (this will erase all data).
Images are blurry.	Anti-shake off, insufficient light, or camera movement.	Ensure Anti-Shake is enabled. Use fill light in low light conditions. Hold camera steady.
Poor battery life.	Frequent use of flash/screen, old battery.	Reduce screen brightness. Limit flash use. Consider a replacement battery if performance significantly degrades.
Camera freezes or becomes unresponsive.	Software glitch or memory card issue.	Remove and reinsert the battery. If using an SD card, try removing it and restarting the camera.





### 6.1 Product Warranty
