1. INTRODUCTION

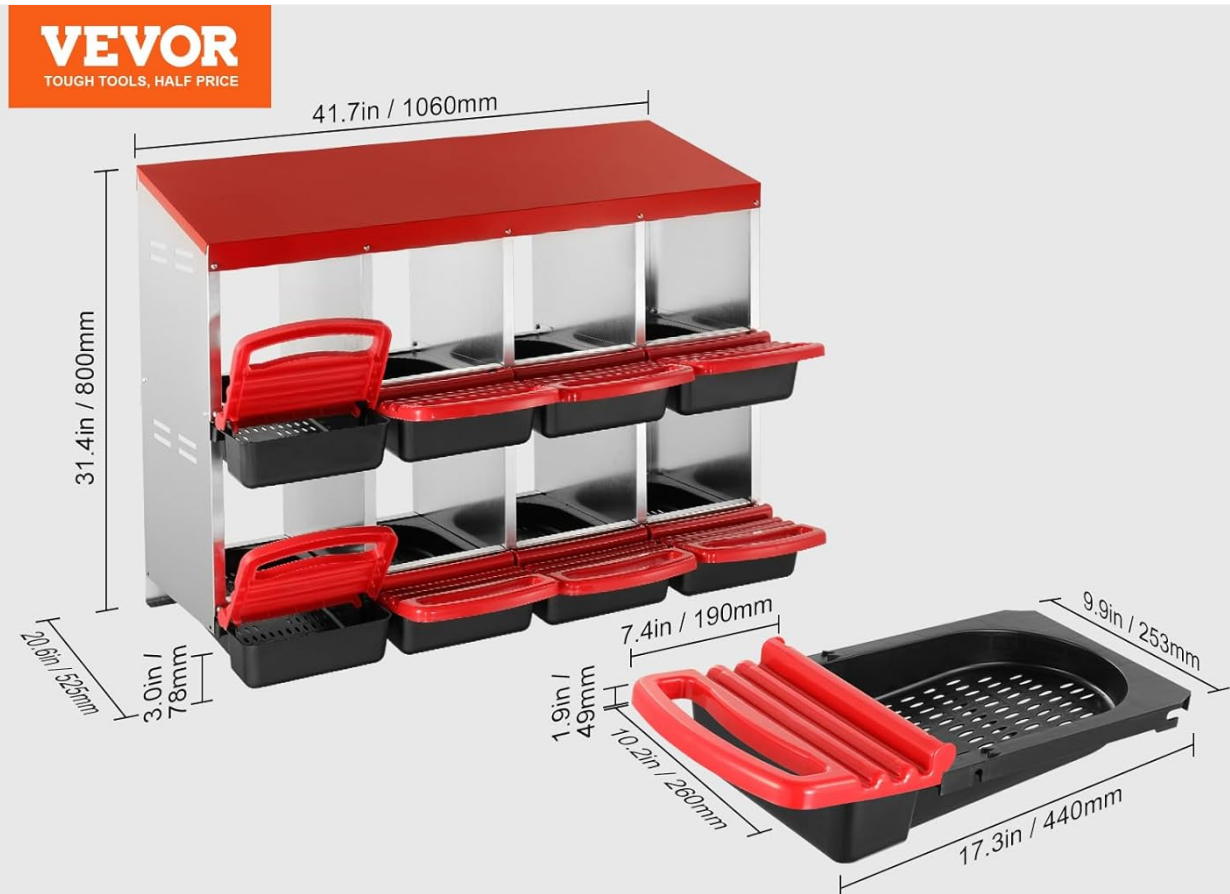

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. Refer to the parts list and the assembly video for visual guidance.

3.1 Included Accessories

- Screw Kit: 40 x M6 x 8 mm Screws, 40 x M6 Nuts, 4 x M5 x 35 mm Self-tapping Screws, 4 x Expansion Sleeves
- 1 x Phillips Screwdriver
- 1 x Hex Key
- 1 x Instruction Manual

3.2 Assembly Steps

1. **Prepare the Base:** Invert the top cover (red panel) and attach the side panels using the M6 screws and nuts. Ensure all connections are secure.
2. **Install Dividers:** Attach the bottom crossbar to the side panels. Then, insert the vertical divider panels into the designated slots on the base and secure them with screws.
3. **Add Support Bars:** Install the horizontal support bars across the top and middle sections of the frame, securing them to the vertical dividers and side panels.
4. **Attach Roof:** Place the red roof panel onto the assembled frame and secure it with screws.
5. **Assemble Nesting Trays:** For each nesting compartment, attach the red plastic cover to the black plastic tray. Ensure the cover snaps securely into place.
6. **Insert Trays:** Slide the assembled nesting trays into each compartment of the metal frame. The inclined design will guide eggs to the front collection area.
7. **Mounting (Optional):** If desired, use the pre-drilled holes on the back of the nest box to mount it to a wall using the provided M5 self-tapping screws and expansion sleeves. Ensure the mounting surface is sturdy enough to support the weight of the nest box and its contents.

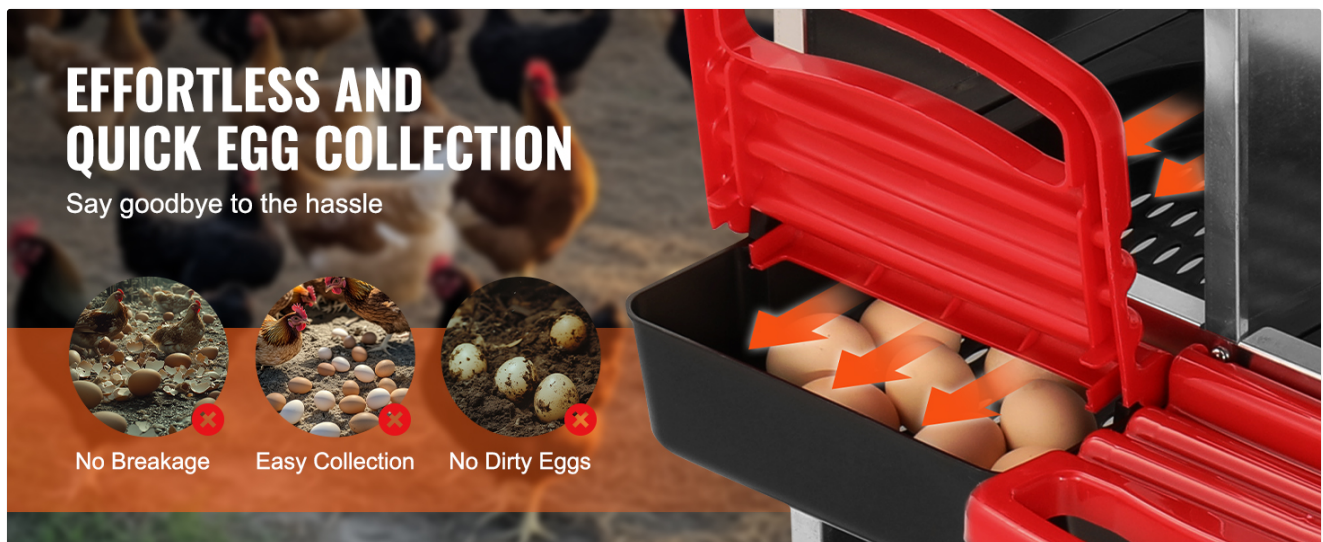


Figure 3: Visual guide for the assembly process of the VEVOR Chicken Nest Box.

4. OPERATION

The VEVOR Chicken Nest Box is designed to provide a comfortable and secure environment for hens to lay eggs, facilitating easy collection and minimizing breakage.

4.1 Egg Collection

The nest box features an inclined design in each compartment. After a hen lays an egg, it will gently roll forward into a protected collection area, preventing hens from pecking at or breaking the eggs. This design also keeps eggs clean and simplifies the collection process.

4.2 Resting Platform

Each compartment includes a resting platform, allowing hens easy entry and a comfortable space before and after laying. This promotes natural behavior and encourages consistent use of the nest box.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance are crucial for ensuring a hygienic environment for your poultry and prolonging the life of the nest box.

5.1 Cleaning the Trays

The plastic nesting trays are removable for easy cleaning. They feature small holes at the bottom to prevent water accumulation and allow debris to fall through. Simply slide out the trays, empty any contents, and wash them with water and a mild disinfectant. Ensure they are completely dry before reinserting.

5.2 Ventilation

The nest box is designed with ventilation holes to ensure continuous air circulation. This helps to eliminate moisture

and odors, contributing to a clean and healthy environment for your hens.

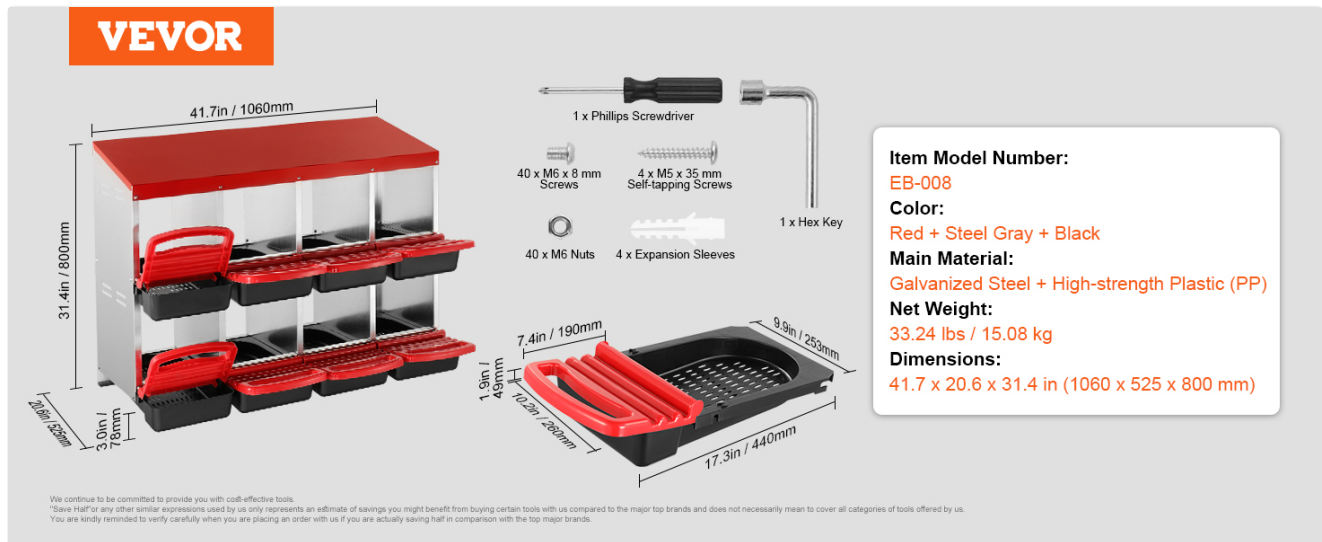


Figure 5: Key features for easy cleaning and comfort, including removable trays with bottom holes, side ventilation, and a resting platform.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your VEVOR Chicken Nest Box.

6.1 Assembly Difficulties

- **Holes Not Aligning:** Ensure all panels are oriented correctly according to the instructions and video. Sometimes, a slight adjustment or gentle pressure may be needed to align holes before tightening screws. Avoid forcing components.
- **Plastic Trays Not Fitting:** Verify that the red plastic covers are correctly attached to the black trays and that the trays are inserted with the correct orientation. Check for any obstructions within the metal compartments.

6.2 Hens Not Using the Nest Box

- **New Environment:** Hens may need time to adjust to a new nest box. Place a few fake eggs or golf balls in the compartments to encourage use.
- **Location:** Ensure the nest box is in a quiet, private, and dimly lit area of the coop, away from high traffic or direct sunlight.
- **Comfort:** While the trays are designed for comfort, some hens prefer nesting material. You may add a small amount of straw or wood shavings to the trays initially to encourage use.
