


Figure 1: XGP X1 Product Package Contents

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The XGP X1 is a state-of-the-art motorcycle helmet communication system designed for clarity, durability, and ease of use. Key features include:

- **Advanced Bluetooth 5.3:** Ensures faster data transmission, lower latency, and a broader transmission range for seamless connectivity.
- **Extended Battery Life:** An 800mAh battery provides up to 60 hours of music playback/phone calls and 360 hours of standby time on a 2-hour charge.
- **IP67 Waterproof Rating:** Comprehensive sealing protects the unit from water ingress, allowing use in various weather conditions.
- **High-Fidelity Audio:** Equipped with 40mm Hi-fi speakers and professional tuning for clear, vibrant sound with deep bass and clear mids/highs.
- **Dual Microphone Options:** Includes both a boom microphone and a button microphone for compatibility with different helmet types.
- **DSP/CVC Noise Cancellation:** Effectively reduces environmental noise for clear voice communication.
- **Voice Assistant Integration:** Double-click the power button to activate Siri or Google Assistant for navigation, music control, and calls.
- **Dual Phone Connectivity:** Supports simultaneous connection to two mobile phones without re-pairing, allowing convenient switching.




Figure 3: High-Capacity Bluetooth V5.3 Chip

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The X1 is designed for broad helmet compatibility, offering two microphone types and two mounting bracket options to suit various helmet styles.

Choosing Your Microphone

- **Boom Microphone:** Ideal for open-face, modular, or flip-up helmets where the microphone needs to extend closer to your mouth.
- **Button Microphone:** Suitable for full-face helmets where the microphone can be discreetly placed inside the chin bar.

Mounting the Main Unit

Choose between the metal bracket or the 3M sticker bracket based on your helmet type and preference.

- **Metal Bracket:** Provides a secure, clamp-on attachment to the helmet shell.
- **3M Sticker Bracket:** Offers a strong adhesive attachment for helmets where clamping is not feasible or preferred. Ensure the surface is clean and dry before applying.

Speaker Installation

The 40mm Hi-fi speakers attach inside the helmet using velcro pads. Position them directly over your ears for optimal sound quality. Use the included speaker pads for comfort and proper fit.

Great Helmet Compatiability

Compatible with different kinds of helmets with two kinds of microphone and brackets provided




Figure 6: Great Helmet Compatibility

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button for approximately 3 seconds until the indicator light illuminates.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for approximately 5 seconds until the indicator light turns off.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the X1 is powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power button for about 5-7 seconds until the indicator light flashes red and blue alternately, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your mobile phone, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "XGP X1" from the list of devices.
5. Once connected, the indicator light will turn solid blue.

Connecting Two Mobile Phones

The X1 supports simultaneous connection to two mobile phones without the need for re-pairing. This is convenient for users with separate personal and work phones.

1. Pair the first phone following the Bluetooth Pairing steps above.
2. Once the first phone is connected, disable Bluetooth on the first phone temporarily.
3. Put the X1 back into pairing mode (red and blue flashing).
4. Pair the second phone.
5. Re-enable Bluetooth on the first phone. Both phones should now be connected to the X1.




Figure 7: Two Mobile Phones Connection

Call Management

- **Answer Call:** Short press the Power button.
- **End Call:** Short press the Power button during a call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds.
- **Auto-Answer:** The X1 can be set to auto-answer incoming calls after 6 seconds. Refer to the user manual for specific settings if this feature is not enabled by default.

Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Short press the Power button.
- **Next Track:** Short press the Volume Up button.
- **Previous Track:** Short press the Volume Down button.
- **Volume Control:** Long press Volume Up or Volume Down buttons.

Voice Assistant

Activate your phone's voice assistant (Siri, Google Assistant) directly from the X1.

- **Activate Voice Assistant:** Double-click the Power button. You can then issue commands for GPS navigation, music playback, making calls, and more.

CHARGING AND BATTERY LIFE

The X1 is equipped with an 800mAh battery, providing extensive usage time.

- **Charging Time:** Approximately 2 hours for a full charge using the provided USB-C cable.
- **Music Playback/Phone Call Time:** Up to 60 hours.
- **Standby Time:** Up to 360 hours.

Connect the USB-C cable to the charging port on the X1 unit and a suitable USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter). The indicator light will show charging status (refer to the full user manual for specific light indications).

WATERPROOFING (IP67)

The XGP X1 features an IP67 waterproof rating, meaning it is protected from dust and can withstand immersion in water up to 1 meter for 30 minutes. This design ensures reliable performance even in rainy conditions.

- Each component is carefully sealed to prevent water ingress.
- Allows you to focus on riding without concern for light rain or splashes.

While the device is waterproof, avoid prolonged submersion or exposure to high-pressure water jets to maintain its integrity.




Figure 11: IP67 Waterproof Feature

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your XGP X1 headset, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the main unit and speakers with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Charging:** Charge the battery regularly, even if not in frequent use, to maintain battery health. Avoid fully discharging the battery for prolonged periods.
- **Port Protection:** Ensure the USB-C charging port cover is securely closed when not charging to maintain waterproofing.
- **Microphone Care:** Keep the microphone foam cover clean and free from debris to ensure clear voice pickup.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your XGP X1, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device won't power on	Low battery; Power button not pressed long enough	Charge the device fully; Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds.
Cannot pair with phone	Device not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on phone; Too many paired devices	Ensure device is flashing red/blue; Enable phone Bluetooth; Delete old Bluetooth connections on phone.
No sound from speakers	Volume too low; Speakers not connected properly; Phone volume low	Increase X1 volume; Check speaker connections; Increase phone volume.
Poor call quality/noise	Microphone position; Excessive wind noise; DSP/CVC not active	Adjust microphone closer to mouth; Ensure microphone foam is intact; DSP/CVC is automatic, but check for obstructions.
Short battery life	Battery not fully charged; Old battery	Ensure full 2-hour charge; Contact support if battery life significantly degrades over time.
