1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your redbeat M2 Android 14 Tablet. Please read this guide thoroughly before using your device to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all items are present in your package:

- redbeat M2 Tablet
- Pink Protective Case
- Type-C Charging Cable
- Instruction Book (this manual)
- SIM Card Tray Ejector Tool

3. DEVICE LAYOUT

Familiarize yourself with the physical components of your redbeat M2 Tablet:

- **Front Camera:** Located at the top center when held vertically.
- **10.95-inch HD Display:** Main touchscreen interface.
- **Rear Camera:** Located on the back, typically in the upper left corner.
- **Power Button:** Usually on the side, used to turn the device on/off or wake/sleep.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjacent to the power button, for adjusting audio levels.
- **USB Type-C Port:** For charging and data transfer.
- **3.5mm Headphone Jack:** For connecting wired audio devices.
- **SIM Card/MicroSD Card Slot:** For inserting SIM cards and expanding storage.
- **Four Stereo Speakers:** Positioned for enhanced audio output.

4. SETUP GUIDE

4.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge your tablet using the provided Type-C cable and a compatible 18W fast charger. The 8000mAh battery provides extended usage time.

4.2 Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the redbeat logo appears.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Power off' from the options on the screen.
- **To Restart:** Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Restart'.

4.3 SIM Card and Storage Expansion

The redbeat M2 Tablet supports dual Nano SIM cards for 4G LTE connectivity and a TF (MicroSD) card for storage expansion up to 1TB.

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of the tablet.
2. Insert the SIM card tray ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray and press gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano SIM card(s) and/or TF card into the designated slots on the tray. Ensure correct orientation.
4. Carefully reinsert the tray into the tablet.



4.4 Initial Device Setup

Upon first power-on, follow the on-screen prompts to configure your tablet:

- Select your language and region.
- Connect to a Wi-Fi network (2.4G/5G supported).
- Sign in with your Google account or create a new one. This is necessary to download apps from the Google Play Store.
- Set up screen lock (PIN, pattern, password, or Face Unlock).
- Review and accept terms and conditions.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Touchscreen Gestures

Navigate your tablet using standard Android gestures:

- **Tap:** Select an item or open an app.
- **Long Press:** Access contextual menus or move icons.
- **Swipe:** Scroll through pages, lists, or switch between home screens.
- **Pinch-to-Zoom:** Zoom in or out on images and web pages.

5.2 Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to *Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi* to connect to available networks. Supports 2.4G and 5G bands.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to *Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth* to pair with Bluetooth devices (e.g., headphones, keyboards). Supports BT5.0.
- **Mobile Data (4G LTE):** Ensure a valid SIM card is inserted. Enable mobile data in *Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network*.

5.3 Camera Usage

The tablet features a 13MP rear camera and a 5MP front camera.

1. Open the Camera app from your home screen or app drawer.
2. Tap the shutter button to take a photo.
3. Switch between front and rear cameras using the camera icon.
4. Select video mode to record videos.

5.4 Audio and Multimedia

Enjoy immersive audio with the tablet's four stereo speakers and Dolby panoramic surround sound. A 3.5mm headphone jack is available for private listening.

5.5 Face Unlock and GPS

The redbeat M2 Tablet includes Face Unlock for convenient security and GPS for navigation and location-based services.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning Your Tablet

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of your tablet. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals that could damage the surface.

6.2 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to *Settings > System > System update*

6.3 Storage Management

To optimize performance, periodically manage your tablet's storage. Delete unnecessary files, uninstall unused apps, and move large media files to external storage (TF card) if applicable. Go to *Settings > Storage*.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your rebeat M2 Tablet, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Device not turning on:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the tablet to the charger for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on.
- **Screen unresponsive:** Try restarting the tablet by holding the Power button for 10-15 seconds.
- **Wi-Fi/4G connectivity issues:** Toggle Wi-Fi/Mobile Data off and on. Restart your router or check your SIM card insertion.
- **Apps crashing or slow performance:** Close background apps, clear app cache (*Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache*), or restart the tablet.
- **Battery draining quickly:** Reduce screen brightness, disable unused features (Bluetooth, GPS, Wi-Fi when not needed), and check for power-intensive apps in *Settings > Battery*.
- **Tablet not charging:** Ensure the Type-C cable and charger are working correctly. Try a different cable or power adapter. Clean the charging port for any debris.

If problems persist, contact rebeat customer support for further assistance.
