INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the safe and effective use of your MySmile LP233 Pro UVC Sterilizable Countertop Water Flosser. Please read all instructions carefully before operation and retain this manual for future reference.

WARNING: To reduce the risk of electric shock, burns, fire, or injury to persons:

- Do not use with broken or damaged parts.
- Keep away from children.
- Do not use in the shower or near water.
- Do not look directly into the UV sterilizer light.
- Ensure the device is unplugged before cleaning or maintenance.
- Use only as directed in this manual.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The MySmile LP233 Pro is a countertop water flosser designed for effective oral hygiene. It features a large water reservoir, multiple operating modes, and UVC sterilization for jet tips.

Components

- Main Unit with Water Reservoir (800ML capacity)
- Detachable Handle with Pressure Control
- Digital Display Panel
- UVC Sterilization Compartment
- Hydrogen-Rich Water Filter
- Assorted Jet Tips (6 included)




Figure 3: Internal view showing the pump mechanism and product dimensions.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

Follow these steps to set up your MySmile LP233 Pro Water Flosser for the first time:

1. Place the unit on a flat, stable surface near an electrical outlet.
2. Open the water tank lid and fill the reservoir with 800ml of lukewarm water. Ensure the hydrogen-rich water filter

is properly installed.

Enhanced Comfort with Heated Water Flow

Warm water for a gentle and soothing clean, designed for sensitive teeth

3. Select the desired jet tip and firmly insert it into the handle until it clicks into place.
4. Plug the power cord into an electrical outlet.
5. Press the ON/OFF button on the digital display to power on the device.
6. Before first use, run a full tank of water through the unit to prime the pump and flush out any manufacturing residue.

OPERATING MODES AND PRESSURE LEVELS

The MySmile LP233 Pro offers three distinct operating modes and multiple pressure levels to customize your flossing experience:

- **Normal Mode:** Offers 10 pressure levels (1-10) for daily cleaning, effectively removing food debris and plaque.
- **Pulse Mode:** Provides 3 pressure levels (1-3) with a strong-weak cycle, ideal for gum massage and for individuals with mild periodontitis.
- **Child Mode:** Features 3 pressure levels (1-3), designed for children above 6 years old under adult supervision,

offering a gentle cleaning experience.

Use the touch-sensitive panel on the main unit or the pressure adjustment buttons on the handle to select your desired mode and pressure level. The digital display will clearly indicate the current settings.

Using the Water Flosser

1. Lean over the sink and place the jet tip into your mouth, aiming the stream at your gumline at a 90-degree angle.
2. Turn on the device and allow the water to flow from your mouth into the sink.
3. Move the tip along your gumline, pausing briefly between teeth.
4. The magnetic handle allows for easy removal and reattachment. You can also pause your flossing routine at any time by clicking the button on the handle.
5. For sensitive teeth, activate the heating function to warm the water to approximately $20\pm2^{\circ}\text{C}$ ($68\pm4^{\circ}\text{F}$) in about 20 seconds.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

UVC Sterilization

The device includes a UVC sterilizer light in the side storage compartment to eliminate 99.99% of bacteria from your jet tips. After use, place the tips in the compartment and activate the UVC light for sterilization. The magnetic control automatically shuts off power when the door is open for safety.

Water Filter

The integrated hydrogen-rich water filter helps remove impurities and boost hydrogen content in the water. Replace the filter periodically according to usage or when water quality appears diminished. Refer to the filter replacement guide for detailed instructions.

Enhanced Water Reservoir & Filter for Flossing

Enjoy a cleaner, more efficient flossing experience with a larger reservoir and advanced filtration




Figure 8: Hydrogen-rich water filter for improved water quality.

General Cleaning

- Always unplug the device before cleaning.
- Empty any remaining water from the reservoir after each use.
- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water.
- Clean the water reservoir and jet tips regularly with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.
- Do not leave water in the tank for extended periods to prevent mineral buildup.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your MySmile LP233 Pro, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; device malfunction.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Test the outlet with another device. If problem persists, contact customer support.
Weak water pressure.	Low water level; clogged jet tip; mineral buildup.	Refill water reservoir. Clean or replace jet tip. Descaling the unit by running a solution of white vinegar and water through it.
Water leakage.	Reservoir not seated correctly; damaged hose/seal.	Ensure water reservoir is properly seated. Check for visible damage to hoses or seals. Contact customer support if leakage continues.
Heating function not working.	Device malfunction.	Ensure the heating function is activated on the digital display. If it still does not heat, contact customer support.
