4. Inspect the new Sourcefy 75-075-0200 Spark Plug for any damage.
5. Thread the new spark plug into the cylinder head by hand to prevent cross-threading.
6. Once finger-tight, use a torque wrench to tighten the spark plug to the manufacturer's specified torque setting for your heating unit. Overtightening can damage the plug or cylinder head.
7. Reconnect the spark plug wire securely.
8. Restore power to the heating unit and test for proper operation.
