1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The WIITHINK Cassette Tape Player Recorder Boombox is a versatile audio device combining vintage appeal with modern functionality. It allows you to enjoy classic cassette tapes, listen to AM/FM/SW radio, stream music via Bluetooth, and play/record audio to USB drives and SD cards. Its portable design and dual power options make it suitable for various environments.

Key Features:

- **Cassette Player & Recorder:** Play your favorite cassette tapes and record audio from the built-in microphone, external sources, or radio directly to cassette.
- **Bluetooth Connectivity:** Wirelessly stream audio from your smartphone, tablet, or other Bluetooth-enabled devices.
- **USB/SD Player & Recorder:** Play MP3, WAV, AAC, WMA files from USB flash drives and SD cards. Easily convert cassette audio to MP3 format on USB/SD.
- **AM/FM/SW Radio:** Enjoy a wide range of radio stations with excellent reception thanks to the long antenna and DSP upgrade chip.
- **Premium 10W Sound:** Equipped with dual 5W speakers for clear, powerful, and full sound quality.
- **AC/DC Dual Power Supply:** Operates on AC power (adapter included) or battery power (batteries not included) for true portability.
- **3.5mm Headphone Jack:** For private listening.

2. SETUP GUIDE

2.1 Powering On

Your WIITHINK boombox can be powered by either AC electricity or batteries.

- **AC Power:** Connect the included AC power cable to the AC input jack on the back of the unit and plug the other end into a standard wall outlet.
- **Battery Power:** For portable use, open the battery compartment on the back. Insert 4 x D-cell batteries (not included) or 2 x 18650 button-top rechargeable lithium-ion batteries (not included). Ensure correct polarity (+/-). Flat-top 18650 batteries are not compatible.

The 18650 battery compartment **can only accommodate button top battery models**, flat top battery models cannot be connected to power.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Cassette Playback and Recording

1. **To Play a Cassette:** Press the 'PUSH' button to open the cassette door. Insert a cassette tape with the open edge facing upwards. Close the door. Select 'TAPE' mode using the function switch. Press the 'PLAY' button to begin playback. Use 'STOP', 'FF' (Fast Forward), and 'REW' (Rewind) buttons as needed.
2. **To Record to Cassette:**
 - **From Built-in Microphone:** Insert a blank cassette. Select 'TAPE' mode. Press the 'RECORD' button (red button) along with 'PLAY' simultaneously. The unit will start recording from its internal microphone.
 - **From Radio:** Tune to your desired radio station. Insert a blank cassette. Press 'RECORD' and 'PLAY' simultaneously. The radio broadcast will be recorded onto the cassette.
 - **From External Source (e.g., AUX-in):** Connect an external audio device to the AUX-in port (if available, refer to specifications). Select 'AUX' mode. Insert a blank cassette. Press 'RECORD' and 'PLAY' simultaneously. Play audio from your external device.

3.2 AM/FM/SW Radio

1. Extend the telescopic antenna for optimal reception.
2. Set the function switch to 'RADIO'.
3. Select the desired band: AM, FM, or SW (Shortwave) using the band selector switch.
4. Rotate the 'TUNING' knob to find your desired radio station.

3.3 Bluetooth Connectivity

1. Set the function switch to 'BT' (Bluetooth) mode. The unit will enter pairing mode, indicated by an audible prompt or flashing indicator.
2. On your Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select 'WIITHINK' or a similar name from the list of devices.

4. Once paired, you will hear a confirmation sound. You can now play audio from your device through the boombox.

3.4 USB/SD Playback and Recording

1. **To Play from USB/SD:** Insert a USB flash drive into the USB port or an SD card into the SD card slot. Set the function switch to 'USB/SD' mode. The unit will automatically detect and begin playing compatible audio files (MP3, WAV, AAC, WMA).
2. **To Record to USB/SD (MP3 Conversion):**
 - Insert a USB flash drive or SD card.
 - Select the source you wish to record from (Cassette, Radio, or Microphone).
 - Press and hold the 'RECORD' button on the MP3 player section. The unit will start recording the audio source directly to the USB/SD card in MP3 format.
 - Recordings are typically saved in a directory named 'AB_REC' with filenames like AUX00xx.MP3 (for external/cassette/radio) or MIC00xx.MP3 (for microphone).

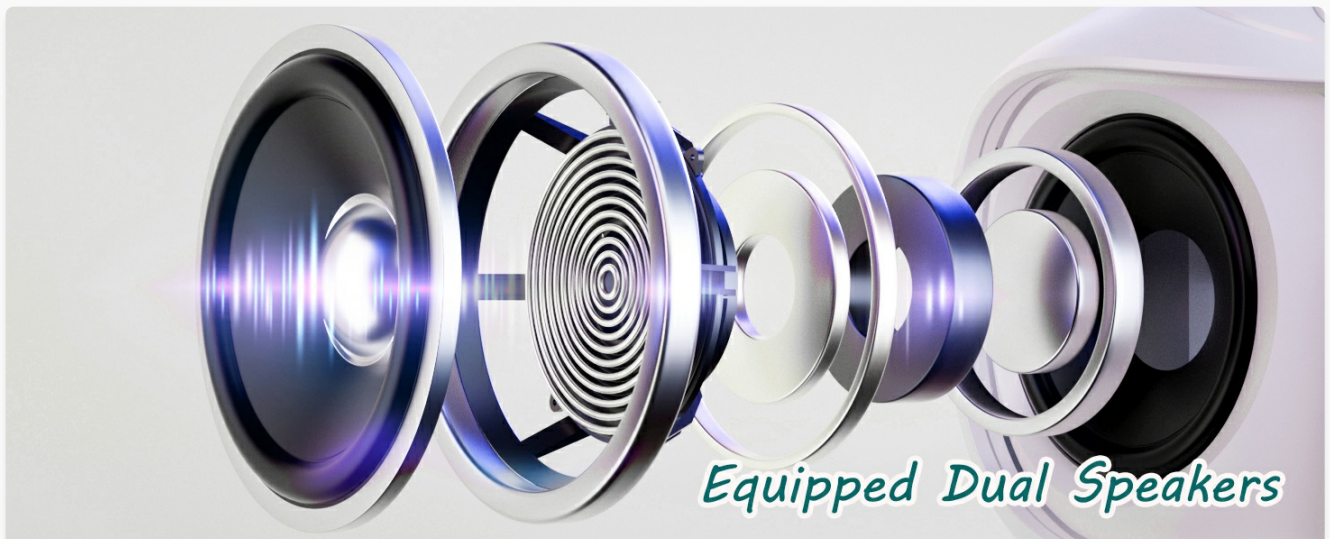


Image: A diagram illustrating various recording options: Tape to USB, USB to Tape, and Radio to Tape, highlighting the versatility of the boombox's recording functions.

3.5 Headphone Use

To enjoy private listening, plug your 3.5mm headphones into the headphone jack located on the unit. The internal speakers will automatically mute when headphones are connected.

4. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Cassette Head Cleaning:** Regularly clean the cassette tape heads, pinch roller, and capstan with a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol to ensure optimal sound quality and prevent tape damage.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, remove batteries and store the unit in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	AC cable not connected properly; Batteries drained or inserted incorrectly.	Check AC cable connection; Replace batteries or ensure correct polarity.
Poor radio reception	Antenna not extended; Weak signal area.	Fully extend the telescopic antenna; Reposition the unit for better signal.
Cassette playback distorted or muffled	Tape heads are dirty; Worn out tape.	Clean tape heads, pinch roller, and capstan; Try a different tape.
Bluetooth not pairing	Unit not in pairing mode; Device too far; Already paired with another device.	Ensure unit is in BT mode; Move device closer; Disconnect from other devices.
USB/SD not playing	Incorrect file format; USB/SD card not inserted correctly or corrupted.	Ensure files are compatible (MP3, WAV, AAC, WMA); Reinsert USB/SD; Try a different card/drive.
Recording quality is poor	Source volume too low; Dirty tape heads (for cassette recording); Microphone too far from source.	Increase source volume; Clean tape heads; Position microphone closer to sound source.




