1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Donner DDP-95 Digital Piano. This instrument is designed to provide an authentic piano playing experience with modern digital features, suitable for beginners and experienced players alike. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your digital piano.

1.1 SAFETY INFORMATION

- Power Supply: Use only the specified power adapter. Ensure the voltage matches your local power supply.
- Placement: Place the piano on a stable, level surface. Avoid direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive humidity.
- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth for cleaning. Do not use liquid cleaners or solvents.
- Water and Moisture: Keep the instrument away from water or any liquids. Do not operate with wet hands.
- Ventilation: Ensure proper ventilation around the instrument to prevent overheating.
- Servicing: Do not attempt to repair the instrument yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.

2. Product Overview

The Donner DDP-95 features an 88-key weighted keyboard, a 4.3-inch LCD display, and a wide array of tones, rhythms, and teaching modes to enhance your musical journey.




Figure 2.2: Top-down view of the DDP-95 control panel, highlighting the LCD display and various function buttons for wireless connection, split, dual tones, MP3, transpose, chord, drum kit, and metronome.

3. Setup

3.1 ASSEMBLY

The DDP-95 typically comes with the keyboard and stand as separate components. Follow the included assembly guide for detailed instructions on attaching the keyboard to the stand and securing the pedal unit. Ensure all screws

are tightened securely before use.

3.2 CONNECTING POWER

- 1. Connect the DC power adapter to the DC 15V input jack on the rear of the piano.
- 2. Plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

3.3 CONNECTING PEDALS

Connect the pedal unit cable to the 'PEDAL' jack on the rear of the piano. The DDP-95 features a 3-pedal system for Soft, Sostenuto, and Sustain functions.




Figure 3.1: The three-pedal system, including Soft, Sostenuto, and Sustain pedals, designed for an authentic playing experience.

3.4 AUDIO CONNECTIONS




Figure 3.2: Rear panel connections, including (1) DC power jack, (2) Sustain Pedal Jack, (3) Headphone jack, (4) Audio input/output jacks, and (5) USB-MIDI port for connecting to computers, smartphones, and tablets.

- **Headphones:** Connect standard 6.35mm stereo headphones to the 'HEADPHONE' jack for private practice.
- Audio In/Out: Use the 'AUDIO IN' and 'AUDIO OUT' 6.35mm jacks to connect to external audio devices like amplifiers, mixers, or other instruments.

3.5 USB-MIDI AND BLUETOOTH CONNECTIVITY

• USB-MIDI: Connect the piano to a computer, smartphone, or tablet using a USB-MIDI cable for MIDI data

transfer with compatible software.

• **Bluetooth:** The DDP-95 supports wireless Bluetooth connection for MIDI-compatible applications. Refer to your device's Bluetooth settings and the application's instructions for pairing.

4. Operating Instructions

4.1 BASIC OPERATION

- Power On/Off: Press the 'POWER' button to turn the piano on or off.
- Volume Control: Use the 'VOLUME' knob or buttons to adjust the overall sound level.
- **Tone Selection:** The DDP-95 offers 610 tones. Use the 'TONE' buttons and the LCD display to browse and select different instrument sounds.
- Rhythm Selection: Choose from 600 rhythms (including 128 accompaniment styles) using the 'RHYTHM' buttons.
- **Demo Songs:** Play through 100 built-in demo songs for inspiration or practice.
- Metronome: Activate the metronome function to assist with timing and rhythm practice.




Figure 4.1: Overview of the DDP-95's extensive sound library, including 610 tones, 600 rhythms, 110 demo songs, and 128-note polyphony.

4.2 LCD DISPLAY

The 4.3-inch blue light LCD display provides visual feedback on various settings and functions. It can show notes in staff notation, indicate key positions, and offer intuitive prompts.




Figure 4.2: The 4.3-inch blue light LCD display, showing real-time information and musical notation.

4.3 KEYBOARD FEATURES

- 88-Key Fully Weighted Keyboard: Provides an authentic piano feel with hammer action.
- 16-Level Touch Sensitivity: Adjusts the volume and timbre based on how hard or soft you play the keys, allowing for expressive dynamics.

4.4 TEACHING MODES

The DDP-95 includes three teaching modes to assist learners:

- Single Key: Practice individual notes.
- Follow Along: The piano waits for you to play the correct note before proceeding.
- Ensemble: Practice with an accompaniment, playing your part along with the built-in music.

4.5 RECORDING AND PLAYBACK

The piano allows you to record your performances, with a capacity of up to 5000 bytes. This feature is useful for reviewing your playing, identifying areas for improvement, and capturing musical ideas.

- · Press the 'RECORD' button to start recording.
- Press 'PLAY' to listen to your recorded performance.

4.6 Additional Functions

- **Split Keyboard:** Divides the keyboard into two sections, allowing two different tones to be played simultaneously or for two people to play together.
- Dual Tones: Layers two different tones to create a richer, more complex sound.
- Transpose: Shifts the pitch of the entire keyboard up or down in semitone steps.
- Chord Function: Provides automatic chord accompaniment based on the keys played.
- Drum Kit: Access various drum sounds for rhythm creation.

5. Maintenance

5.1 CLEANING

To maintain the appearance and functionality of your DDP-95 Digital Piano:

- Wipe the surface with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water, then wipe dry immediately.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they can damage the finish.

5.2 STORAGE

When not in use for extended periods, store the piano in a cool, dry place, away from extreme temperatures and humidity. Cover the keyboard with a dust cover to protect the keys and internal components.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Donner DDP-95, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound	Volume too low; headphones connected; power issue.	Increase volume; disconnect headphones; check power connection.
Keys not responding	Function mode active (e.g., teaching mode); internal error.	Exit special modes; power cycle the instrument.
Bluetooth connection fails	Device not in pairing mode; interference; distance.	Ensure device is discoverable; reduce distance; restart both devices.
Distorted sound	Volume too high; faulty cable; external speaker issue.	Lower volume; check/replace cables; test with different speakers/headphones.
