# THINK 30 Twin Over Twin Wooden Bunk Bed with Trundle, Cabinet, Wardrobe, Desk and Drawers

## 1. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

This product requires assembly. It is delivered in 4 separate packages. Please ensure all packages have arrived before beginning assembly. Review the included instruction manual thoroughly before starting. Two adults are recommended for assembly.

### 1.1 Safety Precautions

- Always follow the assembly steps in the provided manual.
- Ensure all hardware is securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten fasteners.
- Do not allow children to play on or around the bed during assembly.
- Keep small parts out of reach of children to prevent choking hazards.
- Place the bed on a flat, level surface during assembly to prevent instability.

### 1.2 Components Overview

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your bunk bed system:

- Upper Bunk Bed Frame
- Lower Bed Frame
- Pull-out Trundle Bed with Drawers
- Integrated Wardrobe Unit
- Integrated Cabinet Unit
- Pull-out Desk
- Ladder
- Guardrails for Upper Bunk
- Various Drawers and Shelves

### 1.3 Assembly Steps (General)

Refer to the detailed graphical instructions included in your product packaging for step-by-step assembly. A

general sequence involves:

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list.
2. Assemble the main bed frames (upper and lower).
3. Attach the ladder and guardrails to the upper bunk.
4. Assemble and integrate the wardrobe and cabinet units.
5. Install the pull-out desk and trundle bed.
6. Insert all drawers into their respective compartments.

### 2.3 Pull-Out Desk Functionality

The integrated desk can be pulled out for use and tucked away when not needed.

1. To use the desk, gently pull the desk surface outwards from its storage compartment.
2. To store, push the desk back into its compartment until it is flush with the unit.

## 2.4 Storage Units (Cabinet, Wardrobe, Drawers)

The bed system includes various storage options:

- **Wardrobe:** Features doors and internal hanging space or shelves. Open doors to access.
- **Cabinets:** Provide enclosed storage. Open doors to access.
- **Drawers:** Located in the trundle, wardrobe, and cabinet units. Pull handles to open, push to close.

## 2.5 Weight Capacity and Safety

Observe the following weight limits and safety guidelines:

- Do not exceed a weight capacity of 410 pounds on the trundle bed or pull-out desk.
- Ensure proper mattress size and thickness for both bunks and the trundle to maintain guardrail effectiveness.
- Always use the ladder to access the upper bunk. Do not jump on or off the bed.

- Avoid placing heavy objects on shelves or in drawers that could cause tipping or damage.

## 3. MAINTENANCE

---

### 3.1 Cleaning

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your bunk bed:

- Wipe surfaces with a damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that may damage the finish.
- Dry immediately with a clean, soft cloth.
- For spills, blot immediately with a clean, dry cloth.

### 3.2 Regular Checks

Periodically inspect the bed for any signs of wear or damage:

- Check all bolts, screws, and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary.
- Inspect the ladder and guardrails for any cracks or loose connections.
- Ensure drawer slides operate smoothly. If stiff, a small amount of silicone lubricant can be applied.

## 4. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 4.1 Common Issues and Solutions

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable	Loose fasteners	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
Drawers stick or are difficult to open/close	Misalignment, debris in slides, or dry slides	Check for obstructions. Ensure drawers are correctly inserted. Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to drawer slides if needed.
Squeaking noises	Loose connections or friction between wood parts	Tighten all hardware. If squeaking persists, disassemble and reassemble the affected section, ensuring all parts are correctly aligned.
Trundle bed or desk does not slide smoothly	Obstruction or dirty/dry rollers/slides	Clear any obstructions. Clean rollers/slides. Apply silicone lubricant if necessary.
