1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY GUIDELINES

- **Anchor Securely:** Ensure the shed is securely anchored to the ground or a concrete slab to prevent wind damage.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation inside the shed, especially if storing flammable materials.
- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not overload the shed with excessive weight or store items against the walls

in a way that could cause structural strain.

- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area. Do not allow them to play inside or around the shed unsupervised.
- **Electrical Safety:** If installing electrical wiring, consult a qualified electrician and adhere to local codes.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

4. SITE PREPARATION

Proper site preparation is crucial for the stability and longevity of your shed.

1. **Choose Location:** Select a location that is level, well-drained, and free from obstructions like overhanging branches or power lines.
2. **Clear Area:** Clear the chosen area of any debris, rocks, or vegetation.
3. **Prepare Foundation:** A solid, level foundation is recommended. Options include a concrete slab, treated timber frame, or gravel base. Ensure the foundation extends slightly beyond the shed's footprint.
4. **Leveling:** Use a spirit level to ensure the foundation is perfectly level. Adjust as necessary.

5. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully. Refer to the diagrams in the separate assembly guide (if provided) for visual assistance. Do not overtighten fasteners unless specified.

5.1. Base Frame Assembly

1. Unpack all frame components and lay them out.
2. Assemble the base frame according to the provided diagrams, securing corners with the designated fasteners.
3. Ensure the base frame is square and level before proceeding.

5.2. Wall Panel Installation

1. Attach the first wall panel to the base frame, aligning holes and securing with screws.

2. Continue attaching subsequent wall panels, ensuring they interlock correctly and are securely fastened to the base and to each other.
3. Install corner protectors as indicated in the assembly guide.

5.3. Door Assembly and Installation

1. Assemble the door panels, attaching hinges and the latch mechanism.
2. Mount the assembled doors to the designated door frame opening, ensuring they swing freely and close securely.
3. Adjust hinges if necessary for proper alignment.

5.4. Roof Assembly and Installation

1. Assemble the roof support beams and attach them to the top of the wall panels.
2. Carefully place and secure the roof panels onto the support structure, ensuring proper overlap for weatherproofing.
3. Install any ridge caps or trim pieces as per the instructions.

5.5. Ventilation Installation

1. Install the shutter vents into their designated openings, typically near the roofline, to ensure proper air circulation.

5.6. Final Checks

1. Review all connections to ensure they are tight and secure.
2. Check door operation for smooth opening and closing.
3. Ensure the shed is properly anchored to its foundation.

6. OPERATION

Using your shed is straightforward once assembled.

- **Opening/Closing Doors:** Use the integrated handles to open and close the double doors. Ensure the latch is engaged when closing to secure the shed.
- **Ventilation:** The integrated shutter vents provide passive airflow. Ensure they are not blocked by

stored items to maintain air circulation and prevent condensation.

- **Storage:** Organize items inside the shed to allow for easy access and to prevent damage to the shed walls or doors.

7. MAINTENANCE & CARE

- **Inspection:** Annually inspect all fasteners, hinges, and anchors for tightness. Tighten any loose components. Check for any signs of rust or damage to the panels.
- **Rust Prevention:** While the shed is made of metal, prolonged exposure to moisture can lead to rust. Address any scratches or chips in the paint finish promptly with rust-inhibiting paint. Ensure proper drainage around the shed.
- **Snow Removal:** In areas with heavy snowfall, remove excessive snow accumulation from the roof to prevent structural strain.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Doors do not close properly or are misaligned.	Uneven foundation; loose hinges; warped door panel.	Check if the shed base is level. Tighten or adjust door hinges. Ensure no obstructions are preventing closure.
Water leakage inside the shed.	Improperly sealed roof panels; gaps in wall connections; damaged panels.	Inspect roof and wall panel overlaps. Apply silicone sealant to any gaps. Check for damage to panels and replace if necessary. Ensure proper drainage around the shed.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Shed feels unstable or wobbly.	Inadequate anchoring; loose frame connections; uneven ground.	Verify the shed is securely anchored to the foundation. Tighten all frame bolts and screws. Re-level the ground or foundation if necessary.
Condensation inside the shed.	Poor ventilation; high humidity.	Ensure vents are clear and unobstructed. Consider adding additional ventilation if the problem persists. Avoid storing wet items.
