INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Apple 2024 iMac with the M4 chip. The iMac is an all-in-one desktop computer designed for a seamless user experience, featuring a 24-inch Retina Display and powered by the Apple M4 chip.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all components are present in your iMac packaging:

- iMac (24-inch, M4)
- Power cord (2 meters) and 143W power adapter
- Magic Mouse
- USB-C Charge Cable
- Magic Keyboard with Touch ID

SETUP

- 1. **Unpack the iMac:** Carefully remove the iMac and its accessories from the packaging.
- 2. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into the power adapter, then connect the adapter to the iMac's power port. Plug the other end of the power cord into a wall outlet.
- 3. **Connect Keyboard and Mouse:** The Magic Keyboard and Magic Mouse are pre-paired. Simply turn them on. If they do not connect automatically, use the included USB-C Charge Cable to connect them to the iMac's Thunderbolt 4 ports for initial pairing.
- 4. **Power On:** Press the power button located on the back of the iMac.
- 5. **Initial Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, connect to Wi-Fi, create a user account, and set up macOS.

macOS and M4 Chip

Your iMac runs on macOS, providing a powerful and intuitive operating system. The M4 chip delivers enhanced performance for various tasks, from daily productivity to demanding creative applications and gaming.

The 24-inch 4.5K Retina display offers vibrant colors and sharp details. Adjust brightness and display settings through System Settings (or System Preferences on older macOS versions).

Camera and Audio

The integrated 12MP Center Stage camera automatically keeps you framed during video calls. The three studio-quality microphones ensure clear audio input, and the six-speaker sound system with Spatial Audio provides an immersive listening experience.

Connectivity

The iMac features up to four Thunderbolt 4 ports for high-speed data transfer and connecting external displays. It supports Wi-Fi 6E for fast wireless internet and Bluetooth 5.3 for connecting accessories. Utilize iPhone Mirroring to seamlessly interact with your iPhone directly from your iMac.

The iMac is built for Apple Intelligence, a personal intelligence system designed to enhance productivity and creativity with advanced features while maintaining user privacy.




Image: iMac display demonstrating Apple Intelligence features in an email application.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- **Display:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water to clean the screen. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Chassis: Wipe the aluminum casing with a soft, dry cloth.
- Accessories: Clean the Magic Keyboard and Magic Mouse with a soft, lint-free cloth.

Software Updates

Regularly update macOS and installed applications to ensure optimal performance, security, and access to the latest features. You can check for updates in System Settings > General > Software Update.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your iMac, consider the following common solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely connected to both the iMac and the wall outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **Display Issues:** If the screen is black or unresponsive, try restarting the iMac. Check display settings if an external monitor is not detected.
- Accessory Connection: If your Magic Keyboard or Magic Mouse is not responding, ensure they are charged and turned on. Re-pair them via Bluetooth settings if necessary.
- **Slow Performance:** Close unnecessary applications. Check for available macOS updates. Ensure sufficient free storage space.
- **Software Problems:** Restart the application or the iMac. If an application consistently crashes, consider reinstalling it.
