1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using this appliance and retain for future reference. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Ensure the power supply voltage matches the rating label on the appliance.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use, before cleaning, or before moving.
- Keep hands, hair, and clothing away from the fan opening during operation.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- This appliance is for indoor household use only.
- Do not block air openings or operate near curtains or other materials that could block airflow.
- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the appliance.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Defy DBF400 is a bladeless fan and air purifier designed to provide both cooling and improved air quality. Its sleek design integrates seamlessly into various home environments.

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Defy DBF400 Bladeless Fan and Purifier:

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the appliance from its packaging. Retain all packaging materials for future storage or transport.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the unit on a firm, level surface. Ensure there is at least 30 cm (12 inches) of clear space around the unit for optimal airflow. Avoid placing it near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- 3. **Power Connection:** Insert the power plug into a standard 220V AC electrical outlet. Ensure the cord is not pinched or placed under heavy objects.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Defy DBF400 can be operated using the touch control panel on the unit or the included remote control.

4.1 Control Panel

The control panel features a digital display and touch-sensitive buttons for various functions:

- Power Button (): Turns the unit ON or OFF.
- Mode Button (M): Cycles through the 4 wind modes: Normal, Sleep, Smart, and Baby.
- Speed Adjustment (+ / -): Increases or decreases the fan speed (10 speed settings).
- Oscillation Button (©): Activates or deactivates the 60-degree oscillation function.
- Timer Button (): Sets the auto-off timer.

4.2 Remote Control

The remote control provides convenient access to all functions from a distance. Ensure the remote control is pointed towards the unit's control panel for proper operation.

- Power Button: Turns the unit ON or OFF.
- Mode Button (M): Selects desired wind mode.
- Speed Adjustment (+ / -): Adjusts fan speed.
- Oscillation Button: Toggles oscillation.
- Timer Button (L): Sets the auto-off timer.

4.3 Wind Modes

- Normal Wind Mode: Provides a continuous airflow at the selected speed.
- Sleep Mode: Gradually decreases fan speed over time to provide a quieter environment for sleep.
- Smart Mode: Adjusts fan speed automatically based on ambient room temperature.
- Baby Mode: Operates at a gentle, low speed for minimal disturbance.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your Defy DBF400.

5.1 Cleaning the Exterior

- 1. Always unplug the unit before cleaning.
- 2. Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- 3. Ensure no water enters the internal components.

5.2 Air Filter Cleaning/Replacement

The air purifier function relies on a clean filter. Refer to the product's specific filter access instructions for cleaning or replacement. Typically, filters should be checked every 3-6 months depending on usage and air quality.

- · Unplug the unit.
- Locate the filter cover (usually at the back or bottom of the unit).
- Remove the filter. If washable, clean according to instructions. If not, replace with a genuine Defy replacement filter.
- · Reinsert the filter and secure the cover.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Defy DBF400, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on	No power supply; Power cord not properly plugged in	Check power outlet; Ensure power cord is securely plugged in
Weak airflow	Air intake/outlet blocked; Filter dirty; Low fan speed setting	Clear obstructions; Clean or replace filter; Increase fan speed
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted; Obstruction between remote and unit; Remote not pointed correctly	Replace batteries; Remove obstructions; Point remote directly at control panel
Unusual noise	Unit not on a level surface; Foreign object inside	Place on a stable, level surface; Unplug and carefully check for obstructions (do not disassemble)
