## INTRODUCTION

The Logitech Zone 300 Wireless Bluetooth Headset is designed to provide a superior audio experience for both work and leisure. Featuring multipoint Bluetooth connectivity, noise-canceling microphones, and a comfortable, lightweight design, this headset ensures clear communication and extended wearability. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Zone 300 headset.

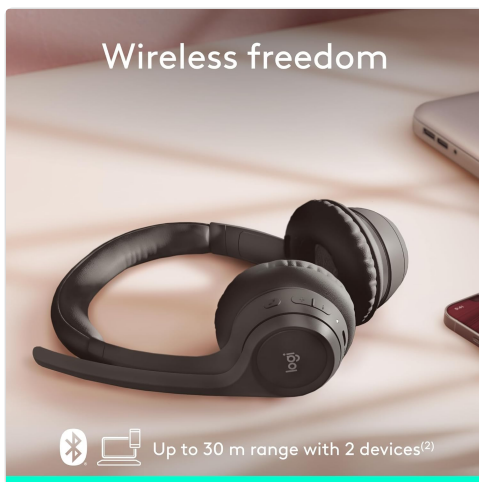
## SETUP

### 1. Charging the Headset



Before first use, fully charge your Zone 300 headset. Connect the included USB-C charging cable to the headset's charging port and the other end to a USB power source. A full charge provides up to 20 hours of listening time or 16 hours of talk time. A quick 5-minute charge can provide up to 1 hour of talk time.

## 2. Pairing with Devices (Multipoint Bluetooth)



The Zone 300 supports multipoint Bluetooth, allowing it to pair with up to six devices and connect simultaneously to two. This enables seamless switching between your computer and mobile phone, for example.

1. Ensure the headset is powered on.
2. Activate Bluetooth on your device (e.g., Windows PC, macOS, iOS, Android smartphone/tablet).
3. Put the headset into pairing mode (refer to the headset's power/Bluetooth button for specific instructions, usually a long press). The LED indicator will typically flash to indicate pairing mode.
4. Select "Logitech Zone 300" from the list of available Bluetooth devices on your device.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator on the headset will show a solid light.

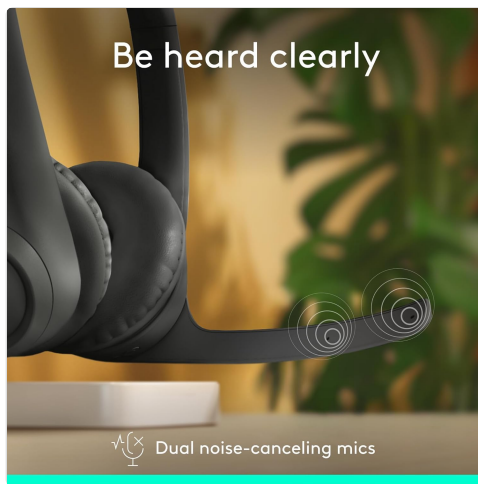
## OPERATING THE HEADSET

---

### 1. Basic Controls

The headset features intuitive controls for managing calls and audio playback. These controls are typically located on the earcup or inline on the cable (if applicable). Refer to the physical buttons on your headset for specific functions such as volume up/down, play/pause, track skip, and call answer/end.

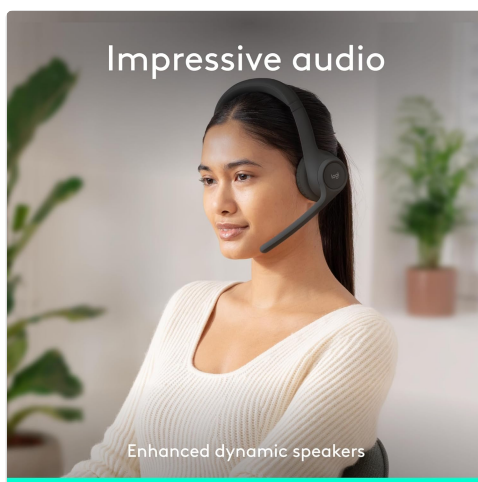
### 2. Microphone Usage



The Zone 300 is equipped with dual noise-canceling microphones on an extended boom. This design effectively suppresses background noise, ensuring your voice is heard clearly during calls and online meetings. Position the microphone boom approximately two fingers' width from your mouth for optimal voice pickup.

- **Mute/Unmute:** Locate the microphone mute button on the headset to quickly mute or unmute your voice during calls.
- **Microphone Position:** Adjust the flexible microphone boom for the best voice clarity.

### 3. Audio Experience



The headset features enhanced dynamic speakers designed to deliver impressive audio quality for both communication and media consumption. The on-ear design with comfortable earpads ensures a pleasant listening experience for extended periods.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Logitech Zone 300 headset.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the headset. For earpads, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, but ensure they are completely dry before use. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headset in its protective pouch to prevent dust accumulation and physical damage. Avoid storing in extreme temperatures or high humidity.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the headset frequently. Charge it regularly, even if not in constant use.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Zone 300 headset, try the following common troubleshooting steps:

Issue	Possible Solution
Headset not powering on	Ensure the headset is fully charged. Connect it to a power source and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on again.
Cannot pair with device	Ensure the headset is in pairing mode (LED flashing). Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device. Move the headset closer to your device. Forget the device from your Bluetooth settings and try pairing again.
Poor audio quality or no sound	Check the volume levels on both the headset and your connected device. Ensure the headset is selected as the audio output device in your system settings. Move closer to your device to avoid signal interference. Disconnect and reconnect the headset.
Microphone not working	Ensure the microphone is not muted. Check microphone input settings on your computer or device. Adjust the microphone boom's position.

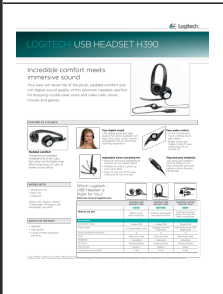

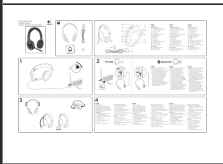
