Mabe MA0C80400CI0 80 cm 6-Burner Built-in Stove User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Mabe MA0C80400CI0 80 cm 6-Burner Built-in Stove. This manual provides essential information for the safe installation, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read these instructions thoroughly before using the stove and retain them for future reference. Proper use and care will ensure optimal performance and longevity of your appliance.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Your safety and the safety of others are paramount. Please observe all safety warnings and instructions provided in this manual. Failure to do so may result in serious injury or property damage.

- **Professional Installation:** This appliance must be installed by a qualified technician in accordance with all local codes and regulations. Improper installation can lead to gas leaks, electric shock, or fire.
- **Gas Safety:** Ensure proper ventilation when using gas burners. If you smell gas, immediately turn off the gas supply, open windows, and do not operate any electrical switches or appliances. Contact a qualified technician.
- **Burn Hazard:** Surfaces of the stove and oven become hot during use. Use oven mitts or pot holders when handling hot items. Keep children and pets away from the appliance during operation.
- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the appliance is properly grounded. Do not use extension cords. Disconnect power before servicing.
- **Flammable Materials:** Keep flammable materials such as aerosols, cleaning products, and plastics away from the stove.
- **Cleaning:** Always allow the appliance to cool before cleaning. Do not use abrasive cleaners or sharp objects that could damage surfaces.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Mabe MA0C80400CI0 is a built-in stove designed for integration into kitchen cabinetry. Accurate measurements and professional installation are crucial for safe and proper operation.

3.1 Dimensions and Clearance

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the controls and features of your Mabe stove before first use.

4.1 Gas Burners

Your stove is equipped with 6 gas burners and durable cast iron grates, designed for efficient cooking with various pot sizes.

4.1.1 Manual Ignition

1. Place your cookware on the cast iron grate over the desired burner.
2. Push in and turn the corresponding burner knob counter-clockwise to the 'HIGH' position.
3. Immediately apply a flame from a match or lighter to the burner.
4. Once the burner ignites, continue to hold the knob in for a few seconds to allow the thermocouple to heat up.
5. Release the knob and adjust the flame to your desired cooking level (LOW to HIGH).
6. To turn off, turn the knob clockwise to the 'OFF' position.

Note: If the burner does not light within a few seconds, turn the knob to 'OFF', wait for gas to dissipate, and try again.

4.2 Oven Operation

The oven features a panoramic door with mirror glass and 'Perfect Cook' technology for even heat distribution.

4.2.1 Preheating and Baking

1. Ensure the oven racks are in the desired position.
2. Push in and turn the oven control knob to the desired temperature setting.
3. The oven will begin to preheat. Allow sufficient time for the oven to reach the set temperature (typically 10-15 minutes).
4. Place food inside the oven.
5. Monitor cooking through the panoramic mirror glass door to minimize heat loss.
6. To turn off, turn the oven knob to the 'OFF' position.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will keep your Mabe stove in excellent condition and ensure its efficient operation.

5.1 Cooktop Cleaning

- Allow the cooktop and grates to cool completely before cleaning.
- Remove cast iron grates and burner caps. Wash them with warm, soapy water. Dry thoroughly before replacing.
- Wipe the stainless steel cooktop surface with a soft cloth and a mild detergent or a specialized stainless steel cleaner. Avoid abrasive pads or cleaners that can scratch the surface.

5.2 Oven Cleaning

The oven cavity features an 'Easy Clean Pro' coating, making cleaning simpler.

- Ensure the oven is cool.
- Wipe the interior with a damp cloth and mild soap. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive oven cleaner suitable for coated surfaces.
- Clean the panoramic mirror glass door with a glass cleaner and a soft cloth.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting service, review the following common issues and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner does not light	No gas supply; burner port clogged; knob not held long enough.	Check gas valve; clean burner ports; hold knob in for 3-5 seconds after ignition.
Oven not heating	Gas supply issue; oven control knob not set correctly.	Verify gas supply; ensure knob is set to a temperature, not 'OFF'.
Uneven cooking in oven	Improper rack position; oven not preheated sufficiently.	Adjust rack position; allow full preheat time.

If the problem persists after attempting these solutions, please contact a qualified service technician.

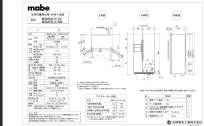

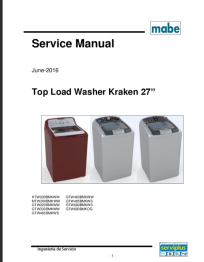
