INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your RAINPOINT 4-Outlet Sprinkler Timer. Designed for efficient and automated watering, this device helps manage your lawn, garden, and other watering needs with precision. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your sprinkler timer.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- 4 Individual Programmable Zones: Customize watering schedules (start time, duration, frequency) for each of the four outlets, catering to different plant needs across various zones.
- 3 Timed Watering Cycle Modes: Flexible scheduling with options for 12-hour or 24-hour format start times, watering durations from 1 minute to 3 hours 59 minutes, and frequencies of every 8 hours, every 12 hours, or every 1-7 days.
- Rain Delay Function: Temporarily pause watering for 24, 48, or 72 hours to conserve water during rainy periods.
- Manual Watering Mode: Allows for immediate, non-scheduled watering from 1 minute to 6 hours without affecting programmed schedules.
- Easy-to-Use Interface: Features a large 3.4-inch LCD display, a large dial, and four clear buttons for intuitive programming and readability.
- Heavy-Duty Structure with Brass Inlet: Constructed with a weatherproof design and a reinforced brass water inlet to withstand water pressure up to 116 PSI, reducing wear and preventing leaks.
- Low Power Protection: Equipped with a low power indicator that flashes to remind you to replace batteries, and valves automatically close to prevent flooding when power is critically low.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation:

The timer requires 4 AA batteries (not included). Locate the battery compartment on the back of the unit. Open the waterproof battery cover and insert the batteries, ensuring correct polarity. Close the cover securely to maintain water resistance.




Figure 3: Image showing the waterproof battery compartment of the sprinkler timer, highlighting the secure closure for outdoor use.

2. Connecting to Faucet:

Attach the brass inlet of the sprinkler timer to a standard 3/4" outdoor faucet. Ensure the connection is tight to prevent leaks. The brass inlet is designed for durability and a secure fit.




Figure 4: Close-up view of the upgraded brass inlet, designed for stronger and less wear connection to the faucet.

3. Connecting Hoses:

Connect your garden hoses to the four individual outlets at the bottom of the timer. Each outlet is a separate zone. Ensure all connections are secure.

4. Setting the Clock:

Turn the main dial to "SET CLOCK". Use the "+" and "-" buttons to adjust the current time. Press "OK/Manual" to confirm and move to the next setting (e.g., minutes). Press "ZONE" to switch between 12-hour and 24-hour format.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The RAINPOINT Sprinkler Timer offers automatic, manual, and rain delay watering modes. Follow the steps below to program your desired watering schedules.

Automatic Watering Program

This mode allows you to set a recurring watering schedule for each zone.

- 1. **Set Start Time:** Turn the dial to "START TIME". Use "+" or "-" to set the desired start time. Press "OK/Manual" to confirm. Use "ZONE" to select the zone (1-4) you are programming.
- 2. **Set How Long (Duration):** Turn the dial to "HOW LONG". Use "+" or "-" to set the watering duration (from 1 minute to 3 hours 59 minutes). Press "OK/Manual" to confirm. Use "ZONE" to select the zone.
- 3. **Set How Often (Frequency):** Turn the dial to "HOW OFTEN". Use "+" or "-" to set the watering frequency (every 8 hours, every 12 hours, or every 1-7 days). Press "OK/Manual" to confirm. Use "ZONE" to select the zone.
- 4. **Activate Program:** Turn the dial to "ON" to activate your programmed watering schedule. The timer will now operate automatically based on your settings.




Figure 5: The large LCD display and intuitive dial make programming easy for setting start times, durations, and frequencies.

Manual Watering

Use this mode for immediate watering without affecting your automatic schedule.

- 1. Turn the dial to "ON".
- $2. \ \ Press\ and\ hold\ the\ "OK/Manual"\ button\ for\ 3\ seconds.\ The\ display\ will\ show\ "ZONE"\ with\ numbers\ 1-4.$
- 3. Use the "+" or "-" buttons to select the desired zone(s) for manual watering. A short line will appear under the selected zone number.
- 4. Press "OK" to set the watering time (from 1 minute to 6 hours).

5. Press "OK/Manual" again to confirm and start manual watering. The timer will automatically revert to its programmed schedule after the manual watering is complete.




Figure 7: The manual watering feature allows for custom, on-demand watering for specific durations across selected zones.

Rain Delay Function

To prevent overwatering during rainy periods, use the rain delay function.

- 1. Turn the dial to "ON".
- 2. Press and hold the "+/DELAY" button for 3 seconds.

- 3. Use the "+" or "-" buttons to select the desired delay duration (24, 48, or 72 hours).
- 4. Press "OK" to confirm the rain delay. The timer will pause watering for the selected period and resume its programmed schedule afterward.




Figure 8: The rain delay feature helps conserve water by pausing scheduled watering for a set duration during rainy conditions.

MAINTENANCE

- Battery Replacement: Replace batteries when the low power indicator flashes on the display. Ensure to use 4 new AA batteries.
- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the filter washer located in the brass inlet to prevent debris from clogging the timer. Use a soft brush and water.
- Winterization: Before the first frost, disconnect the timer from the faucet and hoses. Drain any remaining water from the unit and store it indoors in a dry, frost-free location. Freezing temperatures can damage the internal components.
- Leak Prevention: Always ensure connections are tight. If leaks occur, check the rubber washers for proper seating and replace if damaged.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Timer not watering / Valves not opening.	Low batteries; Incorrect programming; Water pressure too low; Valves stuck.	Replace batteries. Review programming steps carefully. Ensure faucet is fully open. Check for debris in valves or inlet filter.
Leaks from connections.	Loose connections; Damaged washers.	Tighten all connections. Check rubber washers in the inlet and outlets; replace if worn or damaged.
Manual mode not working as expected.	Incorrect selection of zones or confirmation.	Ensure you hold "OK/Manual" for 3 seconds, then use "+" or "-" to select the zone(s) (a line appears underneath), then press "OK" to set time, and "OK/Manual" again to confirm.
Display is blank or dim.	Dead or low batteries.	Replace all 4 AA batteries with new ones.
