1. IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

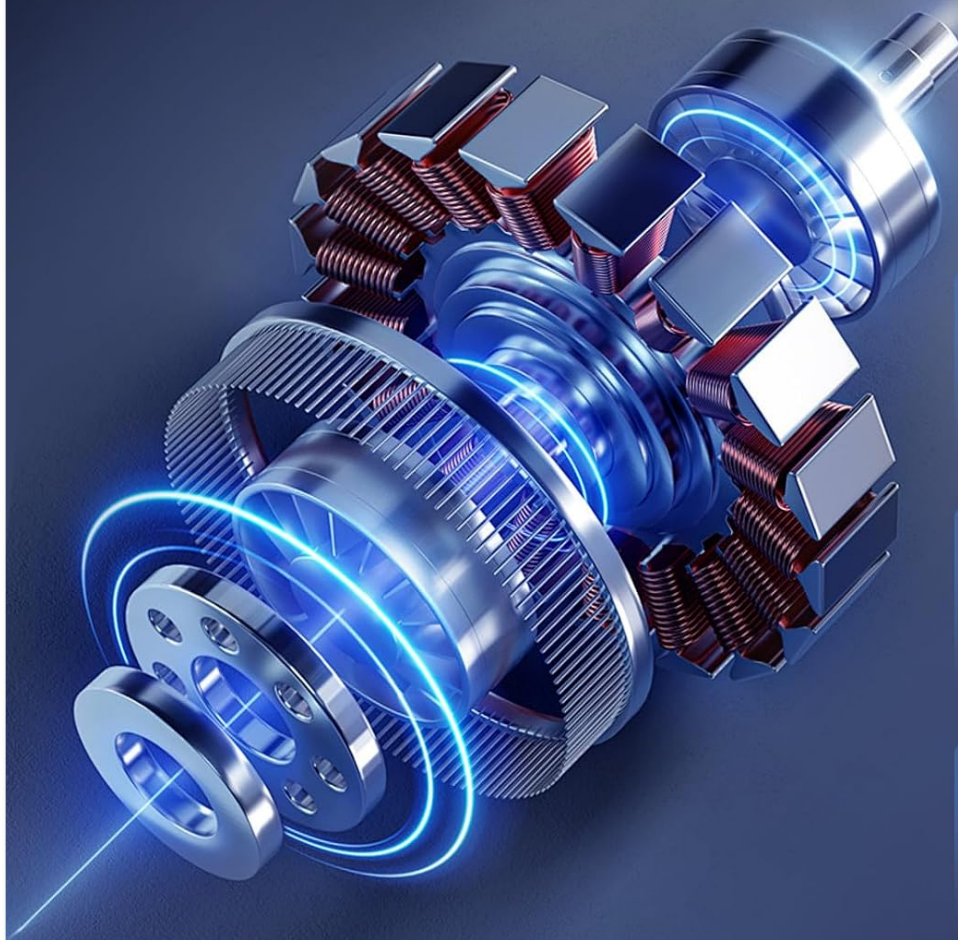
Please read all instructions carefully before using this appliance to prevent injury and damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Ensure the air purifier is connected to a 120V power supply, suitable for use in the United States.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Unplug the air purifier before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Keep the air inlet and outlet clear of obstructions.
- Do not use essential oils containing acetone or ether, as they may corrode plastic parts.
- This appliance is for indoor use only.
- Do not allow children to operate the air purifier without supervision.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AromaRoom Air Purifier is designed to improve indoor air quality by filtering airborne particles and odors. It features a 3-in-1 filtration system, an aroma pad for essential oils, and colorful ambient lighting.

- **Efficient Air Circulation:** Provides 360-degree air outlets for effective purification in rooms up to 157 sq ft (15m²) with 2 air changes per hour.

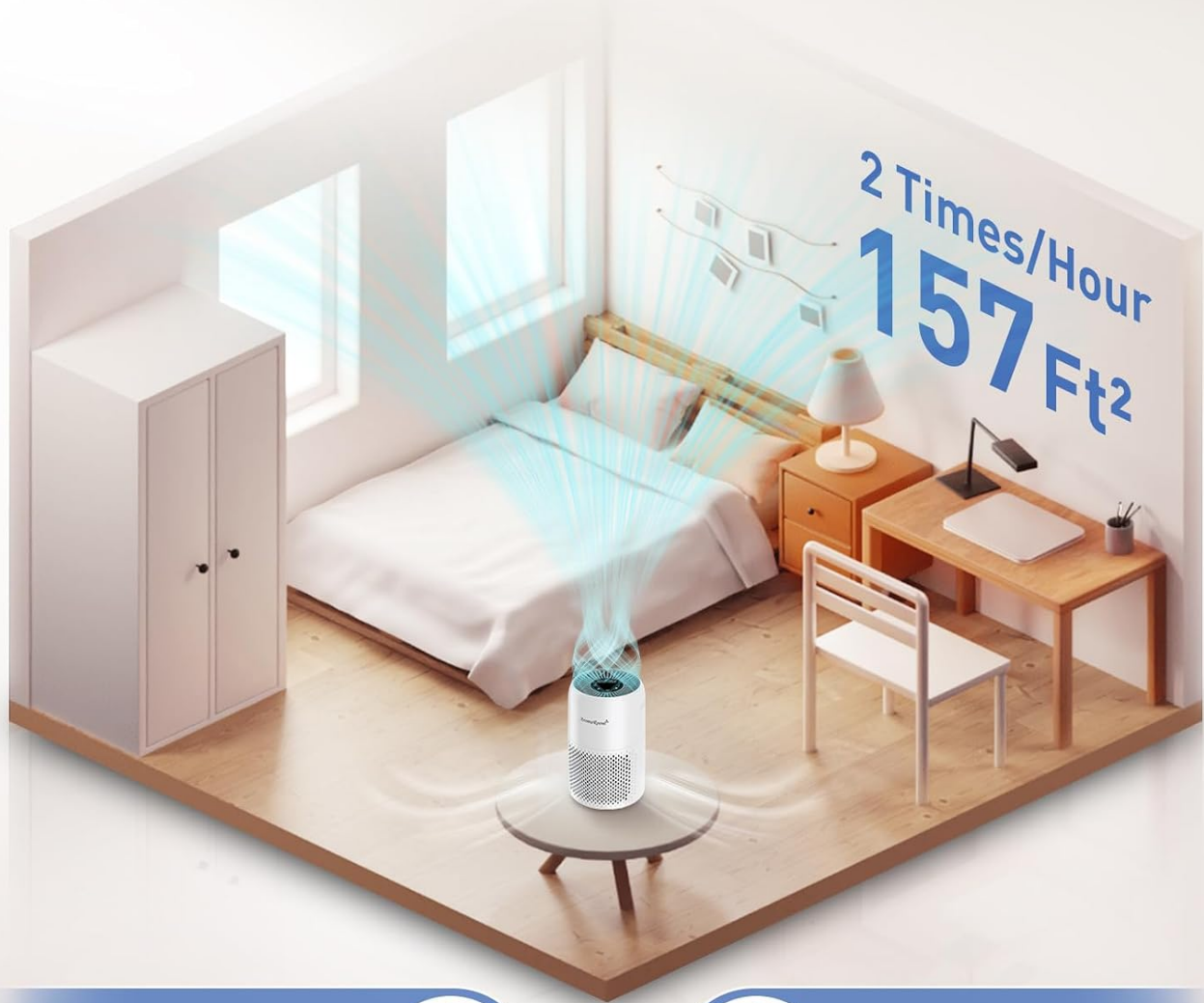

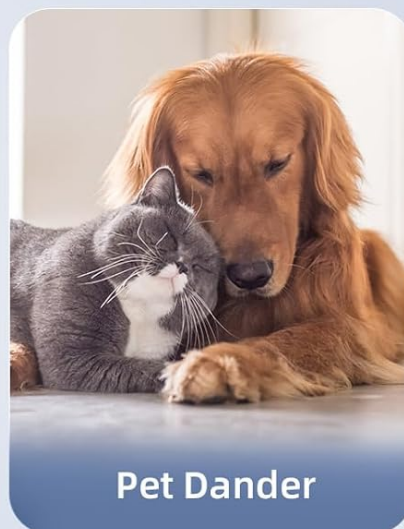

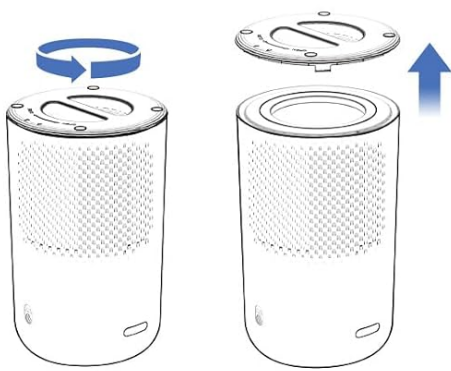
3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking and Filter Installation

1. Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging.
2. Before first use, the filter must be removed from its protective plastic bag.

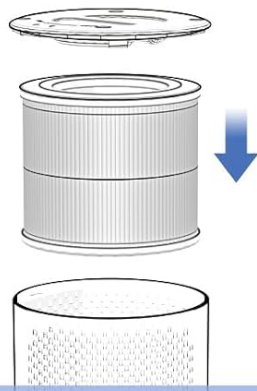
Rotate the cover counterclockwise to unscrew it

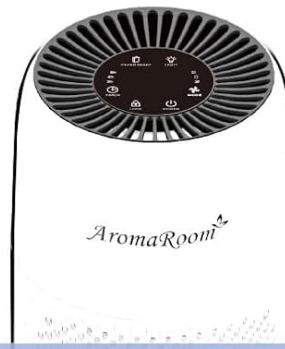
Take off the plastic bag and install the new filter

Attach the filter back and secure the cover by turning it clockwise

Press and hold the " " button for 3 seconds until the red light disappears

- Rotate the bottom cover counterclockwise to unlock and remove it.
- Take out the filter and remove the plastic bag.
- Place the filter back into the unit.
- Replace the bottom cover and rotate it clockwise to secure.

3.2 Placement

- Place the air purifier on a firm, level surface.
- Ensure there is at least 6 inches (15 cm) of space around the unit for optimal airflow.
- Avoid placing the unit near heat sources, direct sunlight, or in areas with high humidity.
- Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC outlet.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The AromaRoom Air Purifier features touch controls on the top panel.

4.1 Power On/Off

- Press the **Power button** to turn the unit on or off.

4.2 Fan Speed / Modes

- Press the **Fan Speed button** to cycle through different fan speeds (e.g., Low, Medium, High).
- **Sleep Mode:** Activate Sleep Mode for ultra-quiet operation (22dB). In this mode, the display lights will automatically turn off after 8 seconds to ensure an undisturbed sleeping environment.

In sleep mode "Z" , the lights will automatically turn off after 8 seconds.

4.3 RGB Ambient Lights

- Press the **Light button** to turn the ambient lights on/off or to cycle through different color modes, including a gradient light mode.

4.4 Aromatherapy Function

- Locate the aroma pad slot on the side of the unit.
- Add 4-5 drops of your preferred essential oil (not included) onto the aroma pad.
- Insert the aroma pad back into its slot. The scent will circulate with the purified air.
- *Note:* Do not use essential oils containing acetone or ether as they may corrode plastic parts.

REFRESH WITH FRAGRANCE

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Filter Replacement

The air purifier is equipped with a filter replacement reminder. A red light will illuminate after approximately 2160 hours of use (equivalent to 3-6 months, depending on usage and air quality).

To ensure optimal performance and air quality, replace the filter every 3-6 months.

- Unplug the air purifier from the power outlet.
- Follow the steps outlined in Section 3.1 and the accompanying image to replace the filter.
- After replacing the filter, plug the unit back in. Press and hold the **Filter Reset button** (often indicated by a filter icon) for 3 seconds until the red light disappears. This resets the filter timer.

5.2 Cleaning the Unit

- Always unplug the air purifier before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- The pre-filter can be gently vacuumed to remove larger dust particles between filter replacements.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on	Not plugged in; Power outage; Filter not installed correctly.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in; Check power supply; Reinstall filter and ensure bottom cover is secured.
Weak airflow / Noisy operation	Filter is dirty or clogged; Obstruction in air inlet/outlet.	Replace the filter; Ensure nothing is blocking the air vents.
Red filter indicator light is on	Filter needs replacement.	Replace the filter and reset the filter timer as per Section 5.1.
No aroma diffusion	No essential oil added; Aroma pad is dry.	Add 4-5 drops of essential oil to the aroma pad.
