INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Upon opening the package, verify that all components are present and undamaged. The NUU N30 package includes the smartphone, a power adapter, a USB cable, and a clear TPU transparent phone case.

2. SIM Card Installation

The NUU N30 supports Dual SIM (Nano SIM Card) functionality. Locate the SIM tray on the side of the device. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the tray. Insert your Nano SIM card(s) into the designated slots. If expanding storage, insert a microSD card (not included) into its dedicated slot on the triple card tray.

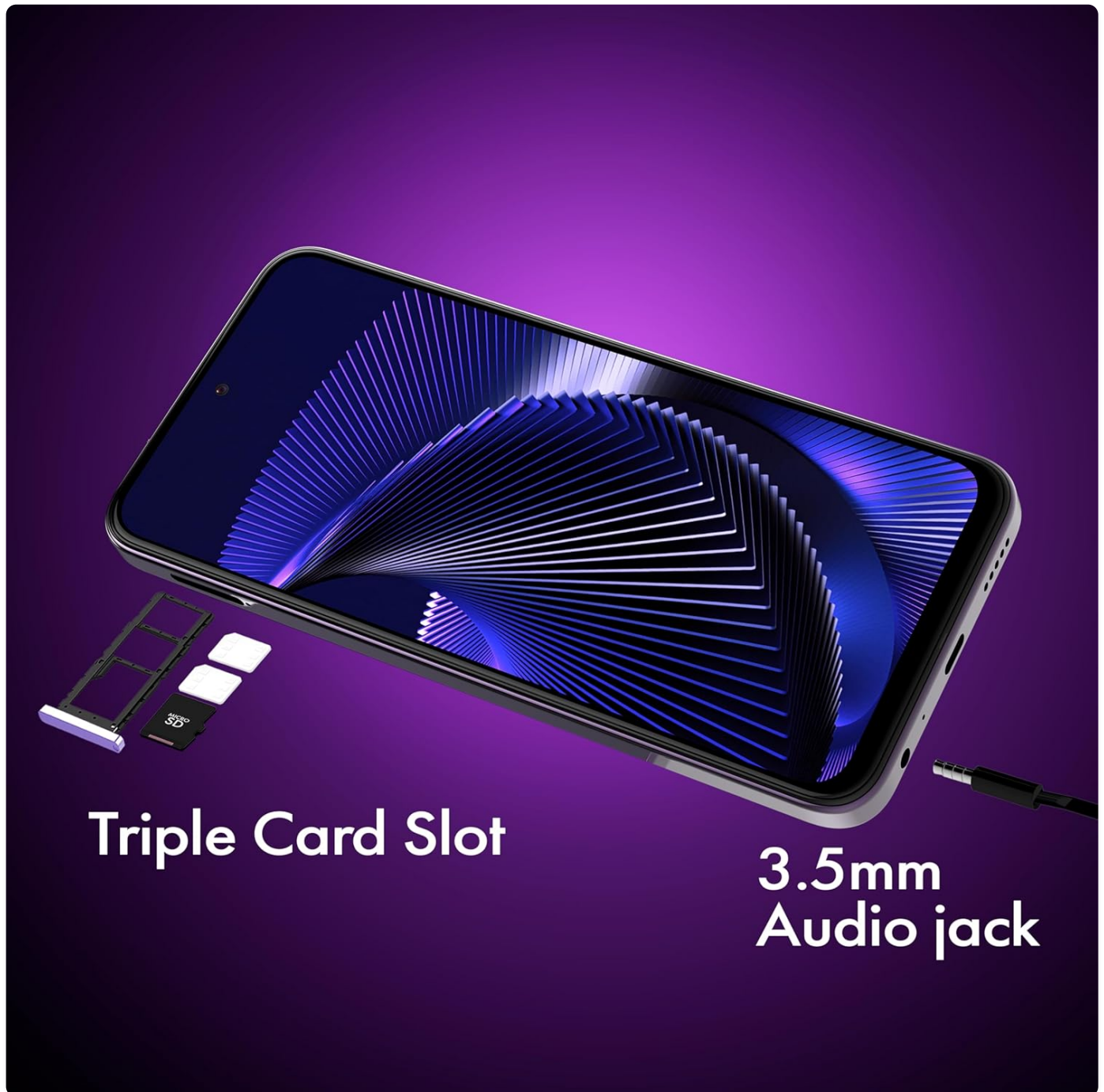


Figure 2: Triple Card Slot and 3.5mm Audio Jack

3. Powering On and Initial Setup

Press and hold the power button until the NUU logo appears. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, and Google account sign-in. The device runs on stock Android 14.

OPERATING YOUR NUU N30

Display and Visuals

The NUU N30 features a 6.7-inch HD+ display with a resolution of 720 x 1600 pixels and a 90Hz refresh rate, providing smooth and vibrant visuals for various activities including streaming, texting, and casual gaming.

Performance and Storage

Powered by an octa-core MediaTek Helio G81 2.0GHz processor and 6GB of RAM (with an additional 6GB virtual RAM for a total of 12GB max), the NUU N30 offers balanced performance for daily tasks. It comes with 128GB of internal storage, expandable up to an additional 256GB via a microSD card (not included).

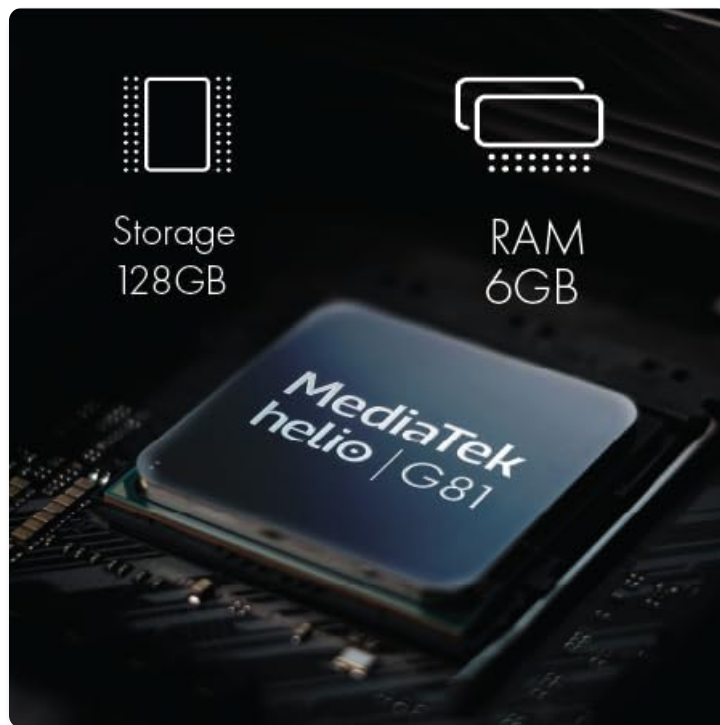


Figure 4: NUU N30 Processor, RAM, and Storage

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your NUU N30, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Keep the device clean using a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- Protect the screen with the included TPU case and consider a screen protector to prevent scratches.
- Avoid exposing the phone to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight for prolonged periods, or excessive moisture.
- Regularly clear cache and unnecessary files to maintain system performance.
- Ensure software updates are installed to benefit from the latest security patches and features.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your NUU N30, consider the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **Device Not Responding:** Press and hold the power button for about 10-15 seconds to force a restart.
- **Network Connectivity Issues:**
 - Check if your SIM card is properly inserted.
 - Toggle Airplane Mode on and off.
 - Verify your carrier settings (APN settings) are correct.
 - Ensure you are within your carrier's supported network area.
- **Battery Draining Quickly:**
 - Reduce screen brightness.
 - Close unused applications running in the background.
 - Disable Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, or GPS when not in use.
- **App Issues:** If an app is crashing or not responding, try clearing its cache and data in the phone's settings, or uninstall and reinstall the app.



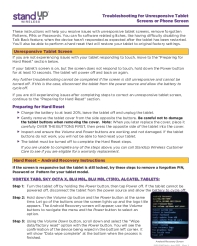
