Thank you for purchasing the Monster Cycle Plus Bluetooth Speaker. This portable party speaker is designed to deliver powerful, high-fidelity audio with dynamic lighting effects, making it ideal for various indoor and outdoor settings. This manual provides detailed instructions on how to set up, operate, and maintain your speaker to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

- **Power Button:** Turns the speaker on or off.
- **Bluetooth Button:** Initiates Bluetooth pairing mode.
- **Volume Knob:** Adjusts the master volume.
- **Light Mode Button:** Cycles through different lighting effects.
- **Sound Mode Button (Bass Boost):** Toggles between EQ modes, including Bass Boost.
- **Microphone Volume/Echo Controls:** Adjusts microphone input volume and echo effect.
- **Backup/Original Vocals Switch:** For karaoke functions.
- **Microphone Priority:** Prioritizes microphone audio over music.
- **USB Port:** For USB drive playback.
- **TF Card Slot:** For TF (MicroSD) card playback.
- **USB-C Port:** For charging the speaker.
- **MIC IN:** 6.35mm input for microphone.
- **AUX OUT:** 3.5mm audio output.
- **MONITOR:** 3.5mm monitor output.
- **AUX IN:** 3.5mm audio input.
- **RESET Button:** Resets the speaker.
- **GUITAR IN:** 6.35mm input for guitar.
- **Bottle Opener:** Integrated utility feature.

5. SETUP

5.1 Charging the Speaker

Before first use, fully charge the speaker. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the speaker's USB-C port and the other end to a compatible USB power adapter (not included). The charging indicator will show the charging status. A full charge provides up to 24 hours of playtime, depending on volume and audio content.

Supports both phones and iPads, offering a unique KTV experience.

5.2 Powering On/Off

Press and hold the Power button on the control panel to turn the speaker on or off.

5.3 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Turn on the Monster Cycle Plus speaker. It will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode, indicated by a flashing Bluetooth indicator.
2. Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device (smartphone, tablet, etc.).
3. Search for "Monster Cycle Plus" in the list of available Bluetooth devices.
4. Select "Monster Cycle Plus" to connect. Once connected, the Bluetooth indicator will stop flashing and remain solid.
5. You can now play audio from your device through the speaker.

5.4 Connecting Multiple Speakers (Bluetooth Broadcast Link)

The Monster Cycle Plus supports connecting up to 100 units for a wider sound experience. Refer to the Quick Start Guide for specific instructions on initiating the Bluetooth Broadcast Link feature.

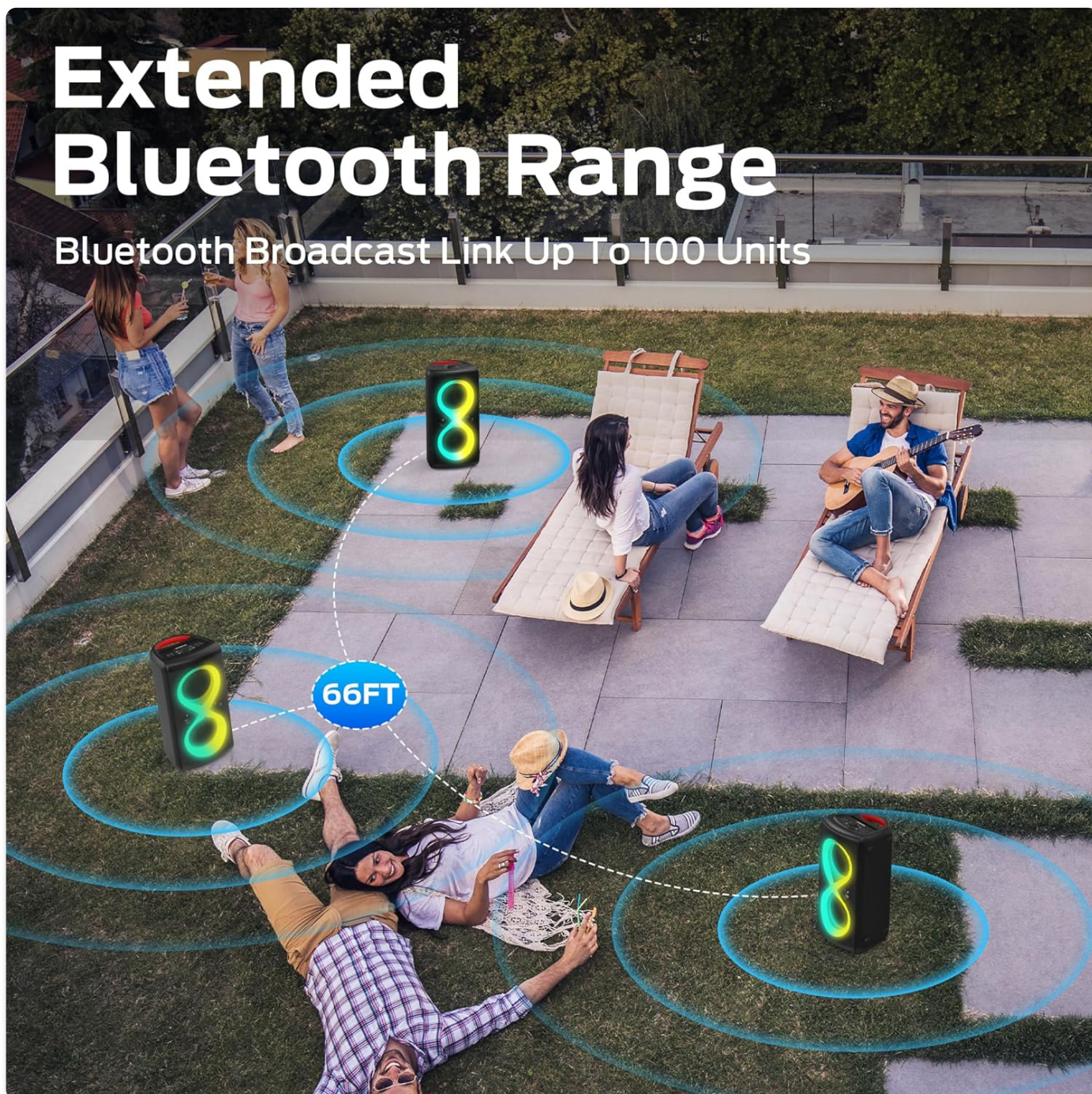


Figure 5.3: Extend your audio coverage by linking multiple speakers with an effective range of up to 66 feet.

5.5 AUX, USB, and TF Card Connections

- **AUX Input:** Use the provided AUX cable to connect external audio devices (e.g., MP3 players, laptops) to the speaker's AUX IN port.
- **USB Playback:** Insert a USB flash drive containing audio files into the USB port for direct playback.
- **TF Card Playback:** Insert a TF (MicroSD) card containing audio files into the TF Card slot for direct playback.

6. OPERATION

6.1 Basic Audio Controls

- **Volume Adjustment:** Rotate the master volume knob to increase or decrease the volume.
- **Play/Pause:** Press the Play/Pause button (usually integrated with the volume knob or a dedicated button) to pause or resume playback.

- **Track Skip:** Use the Previous/Next track buttons to navigate through your audio files.

6.2 EQ Modes and Bass Boost

The speaker features 3 EQ modes. Press the Sound Mode button (often labeled "Bass Boost") to cycle through available equalization presets, including a powerful Bass Boost mode for enhanced low-frequency sound.

6.3 Dynamic Lighting Effects

The Monster Cycle Plus speaker features 7 dynamic lighting effects. Press the Light Mode button to cycle through these effects and enhance your listening experience with vibrant visuals.

6.4 Microphone and Guitar Input

Connect a microphone to the MIC IN port or a guitar to the GUITAR IN port. Use the dedicated volume and echo controls for the microphone to adjust the sound. The Microphone Priority function allows the microphone audio to take precedence over background music.

6.5 Mobile Phone Holder Function

The speaker is designed with an integrated slot on top to securely hold your mobile phone or tablet, providing a convenient setup for karaoke or media viewing.

6.6 Portability and Placement

The Monster Cycle Plus speaker features grab handles for easy single-handed or two-handed carrying. It can be placed vertically or horizontally to suit your space and audio projection needs.

6.7 Water Resistance (IPX6)

The speaker is rated IPX6, meaning it is protected against powerful water jets. This makes it suitable for outdoor use and poolside environments, but it should not be submerged in water.

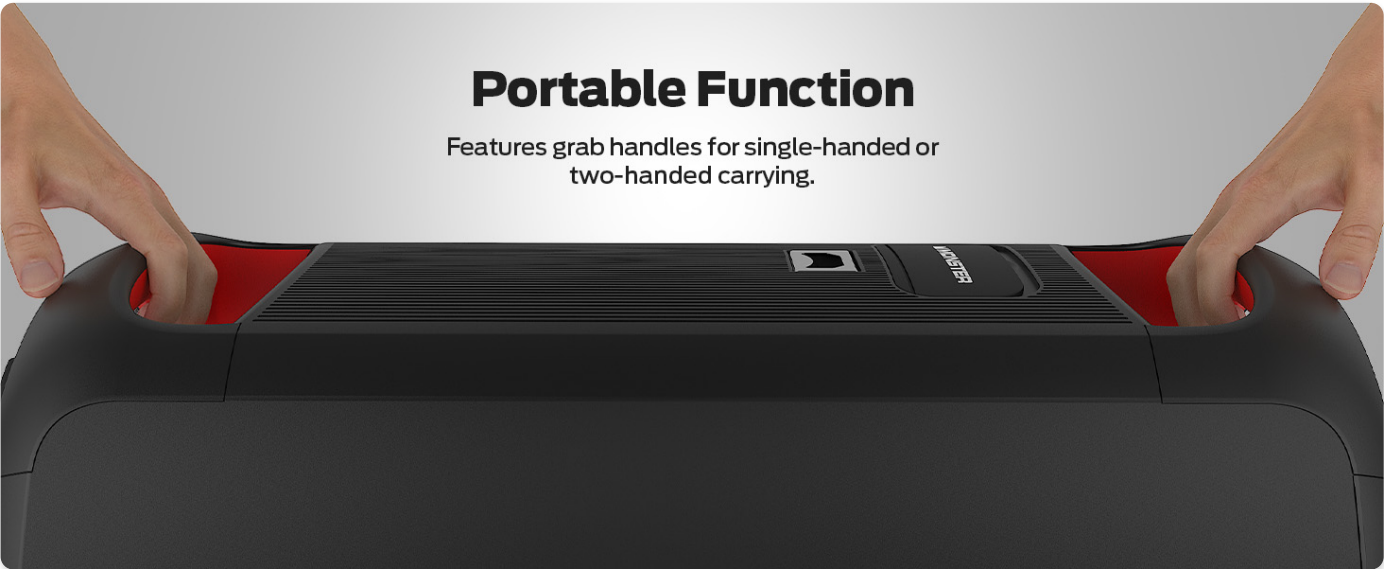


Figure 6.6: The IPX6 rating provides protection against strong water splashes.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the speaker with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or other chemical solvents, as they may damage the surface.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the speaker in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the speaker regularly, even if not in use.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not turn on.	Battery is low or depleted.	Charge the speaker using the provided USB-C cable.
No sound from the speaker.	Volume is too low; Device not connected; Incorrect input mode.	Increase volume; Ensure Bluetooth is paired or AUX/USB/TF card is properly connected; Select correct input mode.
Bluetooth connection unstable or fails.	Device is too far from speaker; Interference; Speaker not in pairing mode.	Move device closer to speaker (within 66ft); Avoid obstacles; Re-enter pairing mode on speaker and device.
Microphone/Guitar input not working.	Cable not fully inserted; Volume too low; Microphone Priority not enabled.	Ensure cables are securely connected; Adjust MIC/GUITAR volume; Activate Microphone Priority if needed.
Lights are not working.	Light mode is off or set to a static color.	Press the Light Mode button to cycle through effects.
