IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, observe the following safety precautions:

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not touch the evaporator or ice cubes directly during operation to avoid frostbite.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or any part of the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Supervise children when the appliance is in use.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug. Contact customer support for repair.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the appliance. Maintain at least 5 inches of space on all sides.
- Use only potable water in the water reservoir.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or when not in use.
- Do not use the appliance for purposes other than its intended use.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The OLIXIS Portable Countertop Ice Machine Maker is designed to produce bullet-shaped ice cubes efficiently. It features a compact design with a handle for portability and a self-cleaning function.

Components:

- Ice Machine Unit
- Ice Basket (removable)

- Ice Scoop

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, tape, and any protective film.
2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is at least 5 inches (12.7 cm) of clear space around the unit for proper ventilation.

3. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Refer to the "Maintenance and Cleaning" section for detailed instructions.
4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to produce ice cubes:

1. **Add Water:** Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line. The reservoir capacity is 1.5 liters.

2. **Power On:** Press the **ON/OFF** button to start the ice making process. The **POWER** indicator light will illuminate.
3. **Select Ice Cube Size:** Press the **SELECT** button to choose between small (S) or large (L) ice cube sizes. The corresponding indicator light will illuminate. Small cubes are approximately 22*24mm, and large cubes are 25*26mm.

4. **Ice Production:** The ice maker will begin producing ice. Approximately 9 bullet-shaped ice cubes will be ready in about 6 minutes.

5. Indicator Lights:

- **ADD WATER:** Illuminates when the water reservoir is low. Refill with water.
- **ICE FULL:** Illuminates when the ice basket is full. Empty the ice basket.
- **POWER:** Indicates the unit is powered on and operating.

6. **Noise Level:** The ice maker operates at a noise level below 40dB, comparable to a working refrigerator.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and hygiene.

1. **Self-Cleaning Function:** The ice maker features an automatic self-cleaning cycle. To activate, press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for 5 seconds. The cleaning cycle typically runs for 15 minutes.

2. **Draining Water:** After the self-cleaning cycle or when preparing for storage, drain any remaining water from the reservoir. Locate the drain plug at the bottom of the unit, remove it, and allow water to flow out.
3. **Manual Cleaning:** For thorough cleaning, unplug the unit. Remove the ice basket. Wipe the interior with a soft cloth and a mild detergent solution. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Clean the exterior with a damp cloth.
4. **Storage:** Ensure the unit is completely dry before storing. Store in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Review the following common issues and solutions before contacting customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; power issue; ambient temperature too high.	Fill water reservoir; check power connection; ensure proper ventilation.
"ADD WATER" indicator is on.	Water level is low.	Refill the water reservoir with potable water.
"ICE FULL" indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Empty the ice basket.
Ice cubes melt quickly in the basket.	Ice basket is not refrigerated.	This is normal. Transfer ice to a freezer for long-term storage.
Unusual noise during operation.	Normal operating sounds (compressor, water pump, ice dropping).	Verify the noise is not excessive (should be below 40dB). If unusual, contact support.
