SETUP & INITIAL USE (SLEVOO C2-M25 SYSTEM)

While this manual focuses on the ROC replacement filter, understanding the overall system setup is beneficial for optimal performance.

First-Time Setup Steps:

1. **Plug In:** Connect the power cord to a suitable electrical outlet.

2. **Fill Water Tank:** Remove the water tank and fill it with tap water up to the maximum level indicator.

FILTER REPLACEMENT

When to Replace Your ROC Filter

The Slevoo ROC Replacement Filter has a recommended lifespan of up to 24 months. The system's display panel will indicate when it's time for replacement. Regular replacement ensures optimal filtration performance.

Replacement Procedure (3-Second Filter Replacement)

Replacing the ROC filter is a quick and simple process:

1. **Open Filter Compartment:** Locate the filter compartment on your Slevoo C2-M25 system and open its cover.
2. **Remove Old ROC Filter:** Gently twist and pull out the old ROC filter (labeled '2' or 'ROC') from its slot.

Dispose of the old filter responsibly.

3. **Insert New ROC Filter:** Align the new Slevoo ROC Replacement Filter with the designated slot (slot '2' or 'ROC') and push it in firmly until it clicks into place. Ensure it is securely seated.

4. **Close Compartment:** Close the filter compartment cover.
5. **Reset Filter Life:** After replacing the filter, reset the filter life indicator on the system's control panel. Refer to the 'Maintenance' section for instructions on resetting the filter life.

Filter Life Indicator & Reset

The control panel features a 'Filter Life Indicator' (PC and RO icons) that shows the remaining life of your filters. When the ROC filter needs replacement, its indicator will signal. After replacing the ROC filter, press and hold the 'Reset' button on the control panel until the indicator resets, typically for 3-5 seconds.

Manual Flush Function

The system includes a 'Manual Flush' button. This function helps to clean the RO membrane and extend its lifespan by flushing out accumulated impurities. It is recommended to perform a manual flush periodically, especially after filter replacement or if you notice a decrease in water flow.

General Cleaning

Regularly clean the exterior of the system with a soft, damp cloth. For the water tank, remove it and wash with mild soap and water, then rinse thoroughly. Ensure all parts are dry before reassembling.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Low Water Flow:**
 - Check if the ROC filter is due for replacement.
 - Perform a manual flush to clear any blockages in the membrane.
 - Ensure the water tank is sufficiently filled.
- **Unusual Taste or Odor:**
 - This often indicates that the filters (PPC or ROC) need to be replaced.
 - Ensure the system has been flushed adequately after filter replacement.
- **Filter Life Indicator Not Resetting:**
 - Ensure you are pressing and holding the 'Reset' button for the required duration (typically 3-5 seconds) after replacing the filter.
 - Verify the new filter is correctly installed and fully seated.
- **Water-Changing Indicator On:**
 - This indicates the raw water tank needs to be refilled.
