# User Manual for Mama Store Under-Sink Column Base Cabinet

### 1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper use, installation, and maintenance of your Mama Store Under-Sink Column Base Cabinet, Model ERA113BINO. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and keep it for future reference.

#### 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Installation Surface:** Furniture must be installed on horizontal surfaces. Avoid impacts during installation and use. Positioning on uneven surfaces can cause tension, leading to deformation and failure of closing mechanisms. Such failures are not considered manufacturing defects.
- Liquid and Heat Exposure: Do not place wet or hot objects directly on the furniture surfaces. In case of contact with water or other substances, immediately clean with soft, absorbent, slightly damp textile materials.
- **Environment:** Install the cabinet in well-ventilated rooms, away from direct sunlight and water contact. This furniture is not designed for outdoor installation. Avoid direct contact with water.
- **Humidity:** The cabinet is designed to withstand normal humidity (steam, accidental splashes). Permanent exposure to high humidity will cause deterioration (swelling), which is not covered by warranty.
- **Heat Sources:** Position the cabinet away from heat sources (e.g., radiators), maintaining a minimum distance of 30 cm.
- **Cleaning:** For general cleaning, wipe surfaces with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or aggressive products. For grease or liquid marks, use a dry cloth immediately.
- **Tipping Hazard:** In case of overturning or falling, the furniture can cause serious, even fatal, injuries. To prevent this risk, the cabinet **must be adequately fixed to the wall**
- Wall Fixing Materials: The fixing methods depend on your wall type and resistance. Any fixing materials (e.g., dowels, hooks, screws) included are for indicative purposes only. They must be correctly verified and possibly replaced as appropriate for your specific wall. We recommend consulting specialized personnel for selecting the correct accessories.

# 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

- 3. Retain packaging materials until you are satisfied with the product.

## 4.2 Positioning and Wall Fixing

As per safety guidelines, proper positioning and wall fixing are crucial.

- Choose a horizontal and stable surface for placement.
- Ensure the location is well-ventilated and away from direct sunlight or excessive moisture.
- Securely fix the cabinet to the wall to prevent tipping. The cabinet is equipped with rear wheels at the base, allowing for easy movement by lifting it from the ground. However, for permanent stability and safety, wall fixing is mandatory.
- Consult a professional for wall fixing if you are unsure about the appropriate hardware for your wall type.

### 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The cabinet is designed for straightforward operation and storage.

#### **5.1 Doors and Drawers**

- The cabinet features two doors with metal hinges and two comfortable drawers.
- To open a door, gently pull the handle. To close, push until it is flush with the cabinet frame.
- To open a drawer, pull the handle outwards. To close, push firmly until it is fully recessed.
- Avoid forcing doors or drawers if they feel stiff. Check for obstructions.

## **5.2 Storage Capacity**

- Utilize the internal compartments for storing bathroom essentials.
- Distribute weight evenly within drawers and on shelves to maintain stability.

#### 6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your cabinet.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Doors/Drawers do not close properly or are stiff.	Obstruction in the mechanism.  Cabinet not on a horizontal surface, causing tension.  Hinges/slides require adjustment or lubrication.	Check for and remove any objects blocking the movement.  Ensure the cabinet is placed on a perfectly level surface. Adjust if necessary.  Inspect hinges and slides for damage or misalignment. Consult a professional if adjustment is needed.
Cabinet appears unstable or wobbly.	Not properly fixed to the wall. Uneven floor surface.	Immediately secure the cabinet to the wall using appropriate hardware for your wall type.  Adjust cabinet leveling feet (if present) or place shims under the base to stabilize.
Surface swelling or discoloration.	Prolonged exposure to high humidity or direct water contact.  Placement near heat sources.	Ensure proper ventilation in the room.  Wipe away any moisture immediately.  Relocate the cabinet away from heat sources (minimum 30 cm). Note: Damage from excessive humidity is not covered by warranty.
