# 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Ensure proper ventilation around the appliance. Do not block any ventilation openings.
- Always supervise children when the microwave is in use.
- Do not place metal objects, foil, or metal-edged dishes inside the microwave, as this can cause arcing and damage the appliance.

#### 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Cecotec Proclean 5010 Flatbed Digital Microwave Oven offers a 20-liter capacity with a flatbed design, eliminating the need for a turntable. This design maximizes usable space and simplifies cleaning. It features 700W microwave power, an 800W halogen grill, an LED display, and 8 automatic programs, incorporating 3DWave technology for even cooking.

# 3. SETUP

# 3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the microwave oven and all packing materials from the carton. Check the oven for any damage, such as dents or a broken door. Do not operate the oven if it is damaged. Contact your retailer or authorized service center.

#### 3.2 Placement

- Place the oven on a flat, stable surface that can support its weight and the heaviest food likely to be cooked in the oven.
- Ensure there is adequate ventilation space: at least 20 cm of space above the oven, 10 cm at the rear, and 5 cm on both sides. This is crucial for proper operation and to prevent overheating.
- Keep the oven away from heat and steam sources.
- Do not place the oven near a radio or TV, as microwave operation may cause interference.

#### 3.3 Electrical Connection

Plug the power cord into a standard grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage and frequency match the specifications on the appliance rating label.

# 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Cecotec Proclean 5010 features a user-friendly digital interface for various cooking needs.

# 4.1 Basic Microwave Cooking

- Place food in a microwave-safe dish directly onto the flatbed surface.
- · Close the oven door securely.
- Use the rotary knob to set the desired cooking time.
- Press the power level button to select one of the 5 adjustable power levels.
- Press the Start button to begin cooking. The LED display will show the remaining time.

#### 4.2 Grill Function

The 800W halogen grill allows for browning and crisping food, providing a golden finish.

- Place food on a heat-resistant dish suitable for grilling.
- Select the grill function using the dedicated button.
- Set the desired grilling time using the rotary knob.
- · Press Start.

# **4.3 Automatic Programs**

The oven includes 8 pre-set automatic programs for common dishes, simplifying cooking. Refer to the specific program list in your detailed manual for usage.

#### **4.4 Defrost Mode**

The quick defrost mode helps preserve the texture and flavor of food. This function allows you to defrost food by weight or time.

- Place the frozen food in a microwave-safe dish.
- Select the defrost function.
- Choose defrost by weight or time, and adjust accordingly.
- Press Start.

# 4.5 Timer and Clock

The 60-minute timer and LED display ensure precise cooking control and time monitoring. An audible alert will sound when cooking is complete.

# 5. Maintenance and Cleaning

Regular cleaning of your microwave oven will ensure its longevity and optimal performance. The flatbed design makes cleaning particularly easy.

- Interior Cleaning: After each use, wipe the interior with a damp cloth and mild detergent. For stubborn stains, place a bowl of water with lemon slices inside and microwave for 2-3 minutes to loosen residue, then wipe clean.
- Exterior Cleaning: Clean the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Door Seal: Regularly clean the door seal and adjacent parts to remove any food spills.

# 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your microwave, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Problem             | Possible Cause  | Solution  |
|---------------------|---|---|
| Oven does not start | Power cord not plugged in; Door not closed properly; Fuse blown or circuit breaker tripped. | Ensure plug is firmly in outlet; Close door securely; Check household fuse/circuit breaker. |
| Food not heating    | Cooking time/power level set too low; Improper dish used.                                   | Increase cooking time/power; Use microwave-safe cookware.                                   |
| Light not working   | Bulb needs replacement.   | Contact qualified service personnel for bulb replacement.                                   |

| Problem                  | Possible Cause                 | Solution   |
|--------------------------|--------------------------------|--|
| Condensation inside oven | High moisture content in food. | This is normal, wipe with a dry cloth after use. |
