Introduction

Thank you for choosing the OMOTON Wireless Bluetooth Keyboard. This ultra-slim keyboard is designed for seamless compatibility with various Mac devices, offering a stable and efficient typing experience. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance of your device.

Compatible with MacOs

System requirement: Mac OS X 10.10 or above

Setup

1. Battery Installation

The OMOTON Wireless Bluetooth Keyboard requires two AAA batteries (not included). Follow these steps to install them:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the keyboard.
2. Slide open the battery cover.
3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery cover securely.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your keyboard to your Mac device, follow these steps:

1. Ensure the keyboard has fresh batteries installed.
2. Locate the power switch on the back of the keyboard and slide it to the "ON" position.
3. Press the "Connect" button on the back of the keyboard. The Bluetooth indicator light on the keyboard will begin to flash, indicating it is in pairing mode.
4. On your Mac device, go to **System Settings** (or **System Preferences**) > **Bluetooth**.
5. Ensure Bluetooth is turned on.
6. Look for "KB066 Mac Keyboard" (or similar) in the list of available devices and click "Connect" or "Pair".
7. Once connected, the Bluetooth indicator light on the keyboard will stop flashing.

The keyboard maintains a stable Bluetooth connection range of up to 33 feet (10 meters).


Operating Instructions

Basic Typing

The keyboard features a standard QWERTY layout. The keys are designed for a quick and responsive typing experience.

Quick Response

Provide a comfortable and noiseless typing experiences

Multimedia Keys

The top row of keys (F1-F12) provides dedicated multimedia and function controls for Mac devices. These include:

- **F1/F2:** Brightness adjustment
- **F3:** Mission Control
- **F4:** Search
- **F5:** Dictation
- **F6:** Screenshot
- **F7/F8/F9:** Previous Track, Play/Pause, Next Track
- **F10/F11/F12:** Mute, Volume Down, Volume Up
- **Eject Key:** Lock Screen

Multimedia Keys for Mac




Layout of the OMOTON Wireless Keyboard highlighting the dedicated multimedia function keys for Mac.

Ergonomic Design

The keyboard features an 8-degree tilt angle, designed to promote a comfortable typing posture and reduce strain during extended use. Four rubber feet on the bottom provide slip resistance for stability.

Maintenance

Cleaning

To maintain the keyboard's appearance and functionality:

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe the surface.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild cleaning solution. Avoid excessive moisture.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or aerosol sprays directly on the keyboard.

Battery Replacement

When the keyboard's performance degrades or it fails to connect, it may be time to replace the batteries. Refer to the "Battery Installation" section for instructions on replacing the two AAA batteries. The energy-saving design and auto-sleep mode allow for a battery replacement interval of up to 6 months under typical usage.

Troubleshooting

- **Keyboard not connecting or frequently disconnecting:**
 - Ensure the keyboard is powered on and has fresh batteries.
 - Verify that Bluetooth is enabled on your Mac device.
 - Move the keyboard closer to your Mac to ensure it's within the 33-foot (10-meter) range.
 - Try unpairing and re-pairing the keyboard through your Mac's Bluetooth settings.
- **Keys not responding:**
 - Check battery levels and replace if necessary.
 - Ensure the keyboard is properly connected via Bluetooth.
 - If the keyboard has been idle, it may be in auto-sleep mode. Press any key and wait 2-3 seconds for it to wake up.
- **Lag or delayed input:**
 - This could be due to interference. Try moving other wireless devices away from your keyboard and Mac.
 - Ensure your Mac's operating system is up to date.
