2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all the following items are included in your product packaging:

- Device (Microsoft Surface Pro 11)
- Power Supply Unit (PSU)
- Quick Start Guide (QSG)
- Safety and Warranty documents

3. INITIAL SETUP

3.1. Powering On and Initial Configuration

1. Connect the Power Supply Unit (PSU) to the Surface Pro 11 and a power outlet.
2. Press the power button located on the side of the device to turn it on.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 Pro setup, including language selection, network connection, and user account creation.

3.2. Attaching the Keyboard and Pen

The Surface Pro 11 supports an optional detachable keyboard and a Bluetooth pen for enhanced functionality.

- **Keyboard Attachment:** Align the magnetic connector on the keyboard with the bottom edge of the Surface Pro 11 until it snaps into place.
- **Pen Pairing:** To pair the Bluetooth pen, go to Windows Settings > Bluetooth & devices, and follow the instructions to add a new device.

4. OPERATING YOUR SURFACE PRO 11

4.1. Display and Touchscreen Interaction

The 13-inch PixelSense LCD display offers a sharp 2880 x 1920 resolution with a 3:2 aspect ratio and a dynamic refresh rate up to 120Hz. Interact with the device using multi-touch gestures or the optional Bluetooth pen.

4.2. Utilizing AI Features with Copilot+

The Surface Pro 11 is a Copilot+ PC, leveraging the 10-Core Snapdragon X Plus processor and its integrated AI NPU (45 TOPS) to enhance various tasks. Features include advanced image generation and editing, improved video calls with automatic eye gaze correction, and real-time language translation and transcription.

The device supports Wi-Fi 7 for high-speed wireless connectivity. It is equipped with two USB-C ports for connecting peripherals, external displays, and charging.

- **Cleaning the Device Body:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** For optimal battery health, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the device regularly.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

- **Screen Issues:** If the screen is flickering or unresponsive, try updating display drivers or restarting the device.
- **Connectivity Problems:** For Wi-Fi issues, try restarting your router and the Surface Pro 11. Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled in settings.
- **Performance Slowdown:** Close unnecessary applications, check for background processes, and ensure Windows is up to date.
