1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper use, setup, operation, and maintenance of your TAMEIVISUA KP20 Police Body Camera. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **High-Definition Recording:** Captures clear 1296P HD video and audio.
- **Extended Recording Time:** Built-in 3600mAh rechargeable battery supports up to 14 hours of continuous recording at 1080P 30FPS.
- **Night Vision Capability:** Infrared LEDs enable clear video recording in low-light conditions.
- **Ample Storage:** Equipped with a non-removable 64GB memory card, storing up to 13.5 hours of 1080p video.
- **Convenient Display:** A 2-inch LCD screen for reviewing recordings and adjusting settings.
- **Wide Angle Lens:** 130° wide-angle lens for a broad field of view.
- **Durable Design:** IP65 waterproof and dustproof for reliable outdoor use.

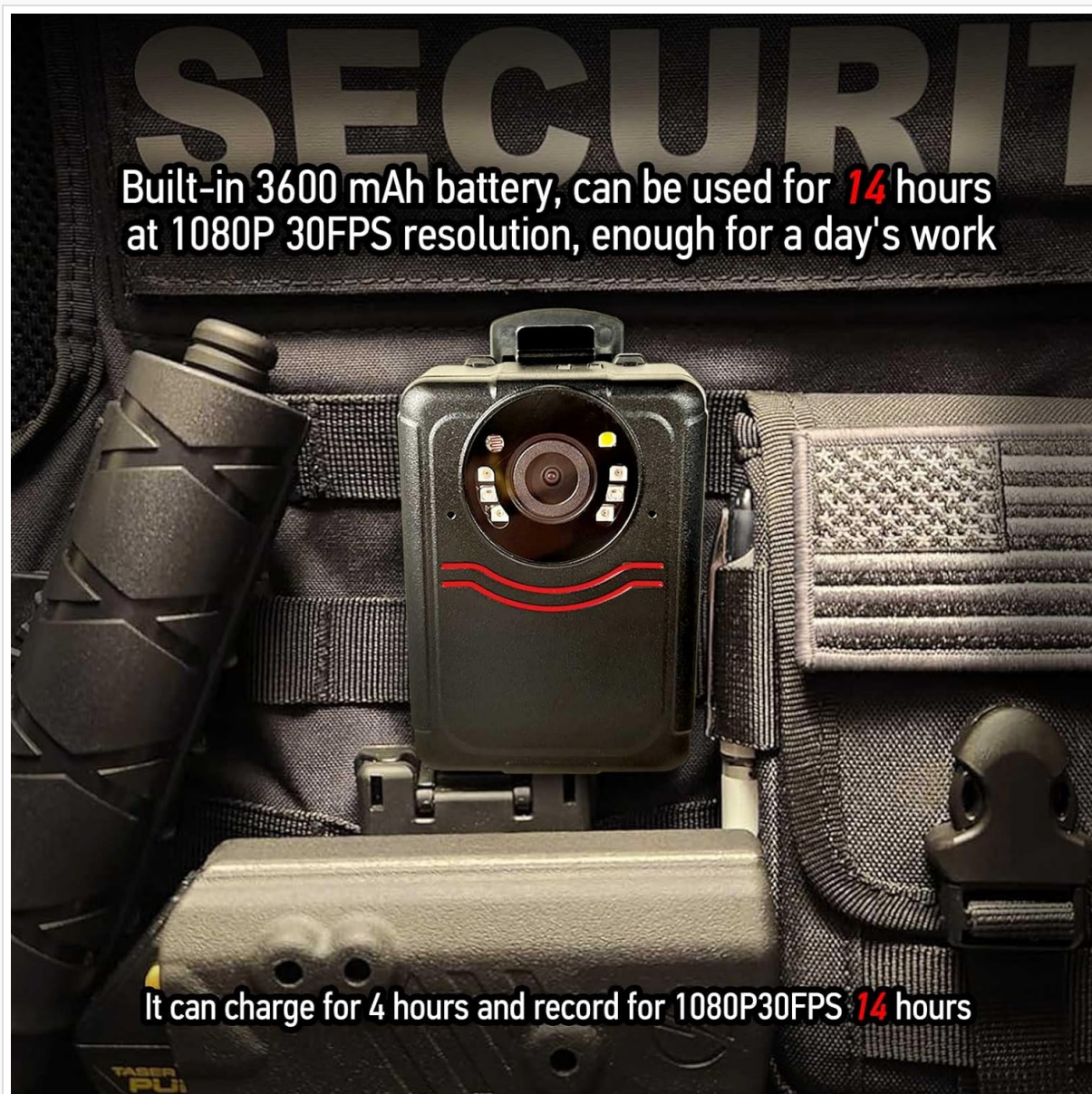


Figure 2: The body camera demonstrating its 14-hour recording capacity on a single charge, suitable for extended use.

The shell and all interfaces are treated with waterproof and dustproof, fearless of wind and rain, faithful guardian.

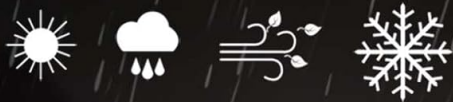


Figure 5: The body camera showcasing its IP65 waterproof design, indicating resistance to water and dust.

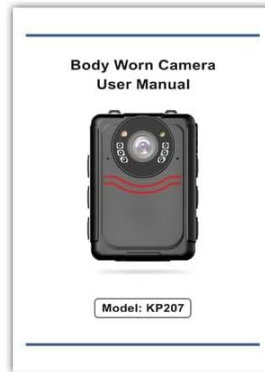

4. DEVICE LAYOUT AND CONTROLS

Familiarize yourself with the various parts and controls of your body camera:

- **Power On/Off Button:** Located on the side, used to power the device on or off.
- **Audio Recording Button:** Dedicated button for initiating audio-only recordings.
- **Video Recording / Tagging Button:** Starts and stops video recording, also used for tagging events.
- **Photo Button:** Captures still images.
- **FN (Function) Button:** Multi-purpose button for various settings and modes.
- **LCD Screen:** 2-inch display for live view, playback, and menu navigation.
- **Menu/Confirm Button:** Accesses the menu and confirms selections.
- **Scroll Up/Left Button:** Navigates menus upwards or left.
- **Scroll Down/Right Button:** Navigates menus downwards or right.
- **Exit Button:** Exits current menu or mode.
- **USB Port:** For charging and data transfer.
- **Lens:** Main camera lens.
- **IR LED / White LED Button:** Controls infrared and white light illumination.
- **MIC:** Microphone for audio recording.
- **Speaker:** For audio playback.
- **Charging Indicator:** LED light indicating charging status.
- **Status LED Indicator:** Shows device operational status.
- **Reset Button:** Recessed button for factory reset (use with caution).

5. SETUP

5.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the body camera. Connect the provided USB cable to the camera's USB port and the other end to the charger plug. Plug the charger into a standard wall outlet. The charging indicator light will show the charging status. A full charge typically takes approximately 4 hours.

5.2 Attaching the Clip

Attach the short 360° rotate back clip to the camera. This clip allows for secure attachment to uniforms, belts, or other gear, providing flexible positioning.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Powering On/Off

To power on the camera, press and hold the Power On/Off button until the screen illuminates. To power off, press and hold the same button until the device shuts down.

6.2 Video Recording

Press the Video Recording / Tagging Button once to start recording. The recording indicator will illuminate. Press the button again to stop recording. Videos are saved automatically to the internal 64GB memory.

6.3 Audio Recording

Press the Audio Recording Button once to begin audio-only recording. Press again to stop. Audio files are saved separately.

6.4 Taking Photos

In standby mode, press the Photo Button to capture a still image.

6.5 Night Vision Mode

The camera automatically activates infrared night vision in low-light conditions. You can also manually control the IR LEDs using the IR LED / White LED Button.

6.6 Playback and Review

Use the LCD screen and navigation buttons (Scroll Up/Left, Scroll Down/Right, Menu/Confirm, Exit) to browse and play back recorded videos and photos directly on the device.

6.7 Data Transfer

Connect the camera to a computer using the provided USB cable to transfer recorded files. The camera will appear as a removable storage device.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera body and lens. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the camera in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the camera regularly, even if not in use, to maintain battery health.
- **Firmware Updates:** Check the manufacturer's website periodically for any available firmware updates to ensure optimal performance and new features.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not power on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the camera fully.
Recording stops unexpectedly.	Memory full; low battery.	Transfer files to a computer to free up space; charge the camera.
Poor video quality at night.	IR LEDs not active; obstruction.	Ensure IR LEDs are enabled; clean the lens.
Camera is unresponsive.	Software glitch.	Press the reset button (refer to Device Layout).
Cannot transfer files to computer.	Faulty USB cable; driver issue.	Try a different USB cable; ensure computer drivers are up to date.
