1. Introduction

The Tecno Spark 30C 5G is a powerful and versatile smartphone featuring a 48MP Ultra Clear Camera, 120Hz 6.67" HD+ Hole Screen, Dolby Atmos Speakers, a 5000mAh battery, and 18W Type-C fast charging. It runs on Android 14 and supports Dual SIM functionality for enhanced connectivity.

- **Medical Devices:** Maintain a minimum distance of 15 cm between the device and medical implants (e.g., pacemakers) to avoid potential interference.

4. SETUP

4.1 Inserting SIM Cards and microSD Card

Your Tecno Spark 30C 5G supports Dual SIM cards and a microSD card for expandable storage.

- 1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your device.
- 2. Insert the SIM ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray and push gently until the tray pops out.
- 3. Place your Nano-SIM cards and/or microSD card into the designated slots on the tray, ensuring the gold contacts face down.
- 4. Carefully push the tray back into the device until it clicks into place.

4.2 Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge the device battery.

- 1. Connect the USB Type-C cable to the charging port at the bottom of your phone.
- 2. Connect the other end of the cable to the 18W power adapter.
- 3. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.
- 4. The charging indicator will appear on the screen. Once fully charged, disconnect the charger.

4.3 Powering On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the Power button (located on the right side) until the Tecno logo appears.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the Power button until the power options menu appears, then tap "Power off".
- To Restart: Press and hold the Power button until the power options menu appears, then tap "Restart".

5. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

5.1 Basic Navigation

- Touch Screen Gestures: Tap, double-tap, long press, swipe, pinch-in/out.
- Home Screen: Swipe left or right to navigate between home screens.
- Notification Panel: Swipe down from the top of the screen to access notifications and quick settings.
- App Drawer: Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to view all installed applications.

5.2 Making Calls

- 1. Open the **Phone** app.
- 2. Enter the phone number using the dial pad, or select a contact from your contacts list.

3. Tap the Call icon to initiate the call.

5.3 Using the Camera

The Tecno Spark 30C 5G features a 48MP Ultra Clear Camera.

- 1. Open the Camera app.
- 2. Select your desired mode (Photo, Video, Portrait, etc.).
- 3. Tap the **Shutter** button to capture a photo or start/stop recording a video.

5.4 Internet and Connectivity

- Wi-Fi: Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi to connect to a Wi-Fi network.
- Mobile Data: Ensure mobile data is enabled in Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network
- Bluetooth: Pair with other Bluetooth devices viaSettings > Connected devices > Bluetooth.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning Your Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of your phone. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

6.2 Software Updates

Keep your device's software up to date to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to Settings > System > System update to check for and install updates.

6.3 Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not let the battery drain completely before recharging regularly.
- Use the original charger for optimal charging speed and battery health.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Device won't turn on	Ensure the battery is charged. Press and hold the Power button for at least 10 seconds to force restart.
Apps are crashing or freezing	Clear the app's cache and data in Settings > Apps. Restart the device. Update the app or device software.
Poor battery life	Reduce screen brightness, close unused apps, turn off Wi-Fi/Bluetooth when not in use. Check battery usage in Settings.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Restart your router and phone. Forget the network and reconnect. Check Wi-Fi settings on your device.
