1. INTRODUCTION AND PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your ZEBRONICS Juke BAR 4100 Soundbar. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your audio experience.

Key Features:

- **Dynamic Output:** 200W RMS total power (90W subwoofer, 110W soundbar).
- **Multi-connectivity:** Bluetooth v5.0, HDMI (ARC), Optical, USB, and AUX inputs.
- **Powerful Drivers:** Soundbar features 4 x 5.71 cm drivers; subwoofer features a single 16.51 cm driver for enhanced bass.
- **Virtual 5.1 Surround Sound:** Creates an immersive, multi-channel audio environment.
- **Wall-mountable:** Designed for flexible placement and space efficiency.
- **LED Display:** Provides clear status, volume, and connectivity mode information.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack all items and ensure you have received the following components:

- Sound Bar - 1 unit
- Subwoofer - 1 unit
- Remote Control - 1 unit
- Input Cable - 1 unit
- QR Code Guide - 1 unit

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Placement

For optimal audio performance, place the soundbar centrally below your television. The subwoofer can be placed on the floor near the soundbar, ideally in a corner for enhanced bass response.

3.2 Wall Mounting

The soundbar is designed to be wall-mountable. Use appropriate wall mounting hardware (not included) and follow the instructions provided in the QR Code Guide for secure installation. Ensure the wall can support the weight of the soundbar.

3.3 Connecting the Subwoofer

Connect the subwoofer to the soundbar using the provided input cable. Ensure the connection is secure.

3.4 Power Connection

Connect the power cables for both the soundbar and the subwoofer to a suitable power outlet. The LED display on the soundbar will illuminate.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Power On/Off

Press the **Power** button on the soundbar or the remote control to turn the unit on or off.

4.2 Mode Selection

Press the **Mode** button on the soundbar or the remote control to cycle through available input modes: Bluetooth (BT), HDMI (ARC), Optical (OPT), USB, and AUX. The selected mode will be indicated on the LED display.

4.3 Volume Control

Use the **Volume +** and **Volume -** buttons on the soundbar or remote control to adjust the volume level.

5. CONNECTIVITY

The ZEB-Juke Bar 4100 offers multiple connectivity options for various devices.

Multi-Connectivity

BT v5.0 | TV(ARC) | Optical IN | USB | AUX

5.1 Bluetooth (BT) Connection

1. Turn on the soundbar and select **BT** mode. The LED display will show "BT" and flash, indicating pairing mode.
2. Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device or computer and search for "ZEB-JUKE BAR 4100".
3. Select the soundbar from the list of available devices to pair. Once connected, the "BT" indicator will stop flashing.

5.2 HDMI (ARC) Connection

1. Connect an HDMI cable from the **HDMI ARC** port on the soundbar to the **HDMI ARC** port on your television.
2. Select **HDMI ARC** mode on the soundbar.
3. Ensure your TV's audio output is set to HDMI ARC or external speakers.

5.3 Optical (OPT) Connection

1. Connect an optical cable from the **Optical IN** port on the soundbar to the optical output port on your television

or audio source.

2. Select **OPT** mode on the soundbar.
3. Ensure your TV's audio output is set to Optical or external speakers.

5.4 USB Playback

1. Insert a USB flash drive containing audio files into the **USB** port on the soundbar.
2. Select **USB** mode. The soundbar will automatically begin playing audio files.
3. Use the remote control to navigate tracks (Play/Pause, Next/Previous).

5.5 AUX Connection

1. Connect a 3.5mm audio cable from the **AUX IN** port on the soundbar to the audio output of your device (e.g., smartphone, MP3 player).
2. Select **AUX** mode on the soundbar.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your soundbar, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the surfaces of the soundbar and subwoofer. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure proper ventilation around the units. Do not block any ventilation openings.
- **Environment:** Avoid exposing the soundbar to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight. Keep it away from water and other liquids.
- **Power:** Disconnect the power cable from the wall outlet if the unit will not be used for an extended period.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your ZEBRONICS Juke BAR 4100 Soundbar, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; power outlet not active.	Ensure power cables are securely connected and the power outlet is functioning.
No sound	Incorrect input mode selected; volume too low; audio cable not connected properly.	Select the correct input mode (BT, HDMI, OPT, USB, AUX). Increase volume. Check all audio cable connections. Ensure TV audio output is set correctly.
Bluetooth pairing failed	Soundbar not in pairing mode; device too far; interference.	Ensure soundbar is in BT mode and "BT" is flashing. Move device closer to the soundbar. Turn off other Bluetooth devices to reduce interference.
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted; obstruction between remote and soundbar.	Replace remote control batteries. Ensure no objects are blocking the remote's signal path to the soundbar's sensor.
