INSTRUCTION MANUAL - MODEL ECB1001-UL

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Amazon Basics Handheld Garment Steamer. This manual provides important information regarding the safe operation, setup, use, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

Important Safety Instructions

- Always unplug the steamer from the electrical outlet before filling or emptying the water tank, or when not in use.
- Do not operate the steamer with a damaged cord or plug, or if the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- To avoid the risk of electric shock, do not immerse the steamer in water or other liquids.
- Use the steamer only for its intended purpose as described in this manual.
- Always ensure the water tank is securely attached before operating.
- Keep the steamer away from children and pets.
- Do not direct steam at people, animals, or electrical appliances. Steam is hot and can cause burns.
- Allow the steamer to cool completely before storing.

Product Overview

The Amazon Basics Handheld Garment Steamer is designed for efficient wrinkle removal from various fabrics. It features a powerful 1500-watt heating element and dual steam modes for versatile use.

Components:

- Main Steamer Unit
- Removable Water Tank (8.4 oz capacity)
- Fabric Brush Attachment
- Soft Cushion Attachment
- Power Cord

Setup

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Fill Water Tank:** Remove the water tank from the main unit. Open the rubber stopper and fill the tank with distilled water. Do not overfill. Close the stopper securely.
3. **Attach Water Tank:** Reinsert the filled water tank into the main unit until it clicks into place.
4. **Attach Accessory (Optional):** If desired, attach the fabric brush or soft cushion attachment to the steam nozzle.
5. **Plug In:** Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet.

Operating Instructions

1. **Power On:** Press the power button. The indicator light will illuminate, and the steamer will begin to heat up. It will be ready for use in approximately 40 seconds.
2. **Select Steam Mode:** The steamer offers dual steam settings: a low mode (20g/min) and a high mode (25g/min). Press the steam mode button to cycle between these settings.
3. **Steam Garment:** Hold the garment taut with one hand. With the other hand, hold the steamer upright and move it slowly over the fabric, allowing the steam to penetrate. For stubborn wrinkles, use the burst steam function by pressing the steam trigger.
4. **Vertical Steaming:** The vertical design allows for steaming clothes directly on a hanger, eliminating the need for an ironing board.
5. **Auto Shut-off:** For safety, the steamer will automatically shut off when the water runs low, if it overheats, or after 10 minutes of inactivity.
6. **Power Off:** When finished, press the power button to turn off the steamer and unplug it from the outlet.

Maintenance

Cleaning:

- Ensure the steamer is unplugged and completely cool before cleaning.
- Empty any remaining water from the tank.
- Wipe the exterior of the steamer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Clean the steam nozzle periodically to prevent mineral buildup.

Descaling:

If you notice reduced steam output or mineral residue, descaling may be necessary. Fill the water tank with a mixture of 50% white vinegar and 50% water. Run the steamer until half the solution is used, then turn it off and let it sit for 30 minutes. Repeat the process with the remaining solution. Rinse the tank thoroughly with fresh water afterward.

Storage:

Store the steamer in a cool, dry place. Ensure the water tank is empty and the steamer is completely dry before storing.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or low steam output	Water tank empty; mineral buildup; steamer not heated sufficiently	Refill water tank; descale the steamer; allow 40 seconds for heating
Water leaking from nozzle	Overfilled water tank; steamer not fully heated; mineral buildup	Do not overfill; wait for full heat-up; descale the steamer
Steamer not turning on	Not plugged in; power button not pressed; auto shut-off activated	Check power connection; press power button; check water level
