The RCA Wave-56 headphones feature intuitive on-ear controls for easy management of your audio and calls.

Button/Indicator	Function
------------------	----------

Button/Indicator	Function
Power Button / Play/Pause	Press and hold to Power ON/OFF. Single press to Play/Pause music. Single press to Answer/End calls. Double press to activate voice assistant.
Volume - / Previous Song	Single press to decrease volume. Press and hold to go to previous song.
Volume + / Next Song	Single press to increase volume. Press and hold to go to next song.
LED Indicator	Indicates power status, pairing mode, and charging status.
USB-C Port	For charging the headphones.
3.5mm Audio Jack	For wired listening (if applicable).

5. SETUP

5.1 Charging the Headphones

1. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the USB-C port on the headphones.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The LED indicator will show charging status (e.g., red while charging, off or blue when fully charged).
4. A full charge provides up to 40 hours of playtime.

5.2 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are turned off.
2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 3-5 seconds until the LED indicator flashes rapidly (e.g., blue and red alternately), indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, laptop, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "RCA Wave-56" from the list of found devices.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator will typically turn solid blue or flash slowly. You will also hear an audible confirmation.
6. If prompted for a password, enter "0000".

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds.

6.2 Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Single press the Power button.
- **Volume Up:** Single press the Volume + button.
- **Volume Down:** Single press the Volume - button.
- **Next Song:** Press and hold the Volume + button.
- **Previous Song:** Press and hold the Volume - button.

6.3 Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Single press the Power button.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds.
- **Activate Voice Assistant:** Double press the Power button.

6.4 Transparency Mode

The Transparency Mode allows you to hear your surroundings without removing your headphones. This is useful for staying aware of traffic, announcements, or conversations.

- **Activate/Deactivate Transparency Mode:** Refer to your specific model's button configuration. This function is often integrated with the power button or a dedicated mode button. (*Note: Specific button for Transparency Mode not detailed in provided data, common implementations include a dedicated button or a long press on a*

multi-function button.)

6.5 Wired Connection (if applicable)

If your headphones run out of battery or you prefer a wired connection, you can use the 3.5mm audio cable.

1. Plug one end of the 3.5mm audio cable into the headphone's 3.5mm audio jack.
2. Plug the other end into your audio source's 3.5mm output.
3. The headphones will automatically switch to wired mode. Note that on-ear controls may be limited in wired mode.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The retractable design allows for compact storage.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the headphones frequently. Charge them regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.
- **Water Resistance:** These headphones are not water resistant. Avoid exposure to liquids.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Ensure the headphones are charged. Connect to a power source and try again.
Cannot pair with device.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing LED). Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device. Move headphones closer to your device. Forget the device on your phone and re-pair.
No sound or low volume.	Check volume levels on both headphones and your device. Ensure headphones are properly connected. Try playing different audio.
Sound quality is poor.	Ensure there are no obstructions between the headphones and your device. Move away from sources of interference (e.g., Wi-Fi routers, other Bluetooth devices).
Transparency Mode not working.	Ensure the feature is activated. Check if any settings on your connected device are interfering.




