INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the safe and effective use of your Mornwell Cordless Water Dental Flosser, Model F42-F1-02. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

- · Do not immerse the charging base in water.
- Ensure the charging port cover is securely closed before using the device in wet environments.
- This device is intended for oral cleaning only. Do not use for any other purpose.
- · Keep out of reach of children.
- Consult a dental professional if you have any oral health concerns before using this device.
- Do not use if the device or power cord is damaged.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Mornwell Cordless Water Dental Flosser is designed for effective oral hygiene, featuring multiple modes and interchangeable tips to suit various needs.

SETUP

1. Charging the Device

- 1. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging port on the device.
- 2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a USB port.
- 3. The battery indicator lights will illuminate during charging. A full charge typically takes 3 hours and provides up to 40 days of use.

2. Attaching a Nozzle

- 1. Select the desired jet tip for your cleaning needs.
- 2. Insert the stem of the jet tip into the opening at the top of the flosser handle until it clicks into place.
- 3. To remove, press the release button on the side of the handle and pull the tip out.

3. Filling the Water Tank

- 1. Open the water tank cover located on the side of the device.
- 2. Fill the 300ml tank with lukewarm water. Distilled water is recommended to prevent mineral buildup.
- 3. Close the water tank cover securely to prevent leaks.
- 4. Alternatively, the entire bottom of the tank can be detached for easier filling and cleaning.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Powering On and Off

- 1. Press the power button to turn the device on.
- 2. Press the power button again to turn the device off.

2. Selecting a Mode

- 1. With the device on, press the mode button to cycle through the available cleaning modes:
 - **Soft:** For beginners and sensitive teeth.
 - Normal: For daily cleaning.
 - Shoot: For stubborn debris and deep cleaning.
 - Pulse: For gum massage.

- Custom: Allows for personalized water pressure adjustment.
- 2. The selected mode will be indicated by an illuminated light on the control panel.
- 3. The device features a memory function that saves your last used setting.

3. Using the Water Flosser

- 1. Lean over a sink and place the jet tip into your mouth, aiming it at the gumline at a 90-degree angle.
- 2. Turn on the device.
- 3. Guide the water stream along your gumline, pausing briefly between teeth.
- 4. Allow the water to flow into the sink.
- 5. Continue until all areas have been cleaned or the water tank is empty.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Water Tank

- 1. After each use, empty any remaining water from the tank.
- 2. Detach the bottom of the water tank and rinse it thoroughly with water.
- 3. Allow the tank to air dry before reassembling.

2. Cleaning the Jet Tips

- 1. Remove the jet tip from the device.
- 2. Rinse the tip under running water.
- 3. Replace jet tips every 3-6 months, or sooner if they become worn.

3. Cleaning the Main Unit

- 1. Wipe the exterior of the device with a soft, damp cloth.
- 2. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- 3. The device is IPX7 waterproof, allowing for safe rinsing under a faucet, but ensure the charging port cover is sealed.

4. Storage

- 1. Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- 2. Ensure the water tank is empty and dry before storing for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Low battery.	Charge the device for at least 3 hours.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Weak water pressure.	Water tank is low or empty. Jet tip is clogged. Incorrect mode selected.	Refill the water tank. Remove and clean the jet tip. Select a higher pressure mode.
Water leaks from the device.	Water tank not properly sealed. Jet tip not properly installed.	Ensure the water tank cover and bottom are securely closed. Reinsert the jet tip until it clicks.
Device stops working during use.	Battery is depleted.	Recharge the device.
