1. Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Ozeino Wireless Gaming Headset, model OW210. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and longevity.

The Ozeino OW210 is a versatile gaming headset offering multiple connectivity options including 2.4GHz USB wireless, Type-C wireless, Bluetooth, and a 3.5mm wired connection. It features 7.1 virtual surround sound, an ENC (Environmental Noise Cancelling) microphone, and long-lasting battery life, designed for an immersive gaming experience across various platforms.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Upon opening the package, verify that all the following items are present and in good condition:

- Ozeino Wireless Gaming Headset (OW210)
- USB Wireless Dongle
- Type-C Wireless Dongle
- 3.5mm Audio Cable
- USB Charging Cable
- User Manual (this document)
- Storage/Dust Bag

3. SETUP AND CONNECTIVITY

3.1 Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge the headset. Connect the USB charging cable to the headset's charging port and to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The LED indicator on the headset will show charging status and turn off when fully charged. A full charge provides up to 30 hours of use without RGB lights or 25 hours with RGB lights enabled.

Note: The headset cannot be used while charging.

3.2 Wireless Connection (2.4GHz USB/Type-C Dongle)

The headset supports 2.4GHz wireless connectivity via two dedicated dongles: a standard USB-A dongle and a Type-C dongle.

- USB-A Dongle: Compatible with PC, PS4, PS5, and Laptops.
- Type-C Dongle: Compatible with Nintendo Switch, Tablets (Pad), and Smartphones.
- 1. Insert the appropriate wireless dongle (USB-A or Type-C) into an available port on your device.
- 2. Power on the headset by pressing and holding the power button for 3 seconds.
- 3. The headset will automatically pair with the dongle. A stable indicator light on the headset signifies a successful connection.
- 4. Adjust audio output settings on your device to select the "Ozeino OW210" headset as the default audio device.

3.3 Bluetooth Connection

The headset is compatible with Bluetooth-enabled devices.

- 1. Ensure the headset is powered on.
- 2. Activate Bluetooth pairing mode on the headset (refer to the controls section for specific button presses, usually a long press on the Bluetooth button if available, or the power button).
- 3. On your device, go to Bluetooth settings and search for available devices.
- 4. Select "Ozeino OW210" from the list to pair.
- 5. Once paired, the headset's indicator light will stabilize.

3.4 3.5mm Jack Wired Connection

For devices with a 3.5mm audio jack, use the included 3.5mm audio cable.

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the headset's 3.5mm input port.
- 2. Connect the other end to the 3.5mm audio jack on your device (PC, PS4, PS5, Xbox, Nintendo Switch, etc.).
- 3. **Important:** The headset must be turned off when using wired mode. Wireless features, including RGB lighting and microphone ENC, will not function in wired mode.

Note: Wireless mode is not compatible with Xbox gaming devices.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Headset Controls Overview

The main controls are located on the left earcup for easy access during gameplay.

- Power On/Off: Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds.
- Volume Control: Use the scroll wheel to adjust the audio volume up or down.
- Microphone Mute: Single click the dedicated microphone mute button to toggle microphone on/off.
- RGB Lights On/Off: Double click the RGB light button to turn the vibrant RGB lighting on or off.
- 7.1 Surround Sound: Single click the 7.1 button to activate or deactivate 7.1 virtual surround sound.

4.2 7.1 Virtual Surround Sound

The 7.1 virtual surround sound feature provides precise audio direction, allowing you to accurately hear and identify sounds from different directions in games, enhancing your tactical advantage.

4.3 ENC Noise-Canceling Microphone

The headset features an Environmental Noise Cancelling (ENC) microphone with a built-in chip to enhance voice clarity and reduce background noise, ensuring your teammates hear you clearly.

- The microphone is flexible and can be adjusted to multiple angles for optimal positioning.
- To mute the microphone, single click the microphone mute button on the earcup.






Image: An internal view of the microphone, detailing the ENC chip and the flexible design for multi-angle adjustment.

4.4 Comfort and Design

The Ozeino OW210 headset is designed for extended comfort during long gaming sessions.

- **Dual Headband:** The top headband distributes the headset's weight, while the internal headband automatically adapts to your head shape and contains foam padding for extra comfort.
- Extra-large Earcups: Made of high-grade synthetic leather, the earcups are thick (1 inch) and provide excellent softness, comfort, and noise isolation, measuring approximately 3 inches in length and 2 inches in width.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the headset's surfaces.
- For earcups, gently wipe with a slightly damp cloth and allow to air dry completely before use. Avoid harsh

chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

• Do not immerse the headset in water or any liquids.

5.2 Storage

- When not in use, store the headset in the provided storage/dust bag to protect it from dust and scratches.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

5.3 Battery Care

- To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the headset frequently.
- If storing for an extended period, charge the headset to approximately 50% before storage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from headset	Headset not powered on. Low battery. Incorrect audio output selected on device. Dongle not properly connected or paired. Volume too low. Headset in wired mode but powered on.	Press and hold power button for 3 seconds. Charge the headset. Check device's sound settings and select "Ozeino OW210". Reconnect dongle; ensure headset is paired. Adjust volume wheel on headset. Turn off headset when using 3.5mm wired connection.
Microphone not working	Microphone muted. Incorrect input device selected. Microphone not properly connected (if detachable). Headset in wired mode.	Single click the microphone mute button. Check device's sound settings and select "Ozeino OW210" as input. Ensure microphone is securely plugged in. Microphone ENC only works in wireless mode.
Wireless connection unstable or disconnecting	Out of range. Interference from other devices. Low battery.	Move closer to the dongle/device. Move away from other wireless devices (e.g., Wi-Fi routers, cordless phones). Charge the headset.
RGB lights not working	Lights turned off. Low battery. Headset in wired mode.	Double click the RGB light button to turn them on. Charge the headset. RGB lights only function in wireless mode.
