## **Physical Installation**

It is recommended that a qualified HVAC technician perform the physical installation to ensure proper wiring and system compatibility. Refer to the detailed wiring diagrams provided with your unit for specific connections.

## **Initial Configuration and Connectivity**

After physical installation, power on the thermostat. The touchscreen will guide you through the initial setup process, including:

- Date and Time Settings: Configure the current date and time.
- HVAC System Type: Select your specific heating and cooling system configuration.
- Wi-Fi Connection: Connect the thermostat to your home Wi-Fi network. The XL850 supports both Wi-Fi and Ethernet connectivity for remote access.
- **Z-Wave Integration:** The built-in Z-Wave bridge allows integration with other Z-Wave compatible smart home devices. Follow the on-screen prompts to add the thermostat to your Z-Wave network or to pair other Z-Wave devices with the thermostat. The device is Z-Wave Certified (ID: ZC08-14090003).

#### **Touchscreen Interface**

The Trane ComfortLink II XL850 features a vibrant 4.3-inch color touchscreen. Navigate through menus and adjust settings by touching the corresponding icons or values on the screen.

## **Basic Temperature Control**

From the main screen, you can view the current indoor temperature, outdoor temperature, and indoor humidity. To adjust the desired temperature:

- 1. Touch the temperature display area.
- 2. Use the up and down arrows to increase or decrease the setpoint.
- 3. Select the desired operating mode (Heat, Cool, Auto, Off) if available.

The built-in Z-Wave bridge enhances home automation by allowing comprehensive control of lighting, security, and other smart devices from the thermostat interface or connected app.

The Trane ComfortLink II XL850 provides smart maintenance alerts directly on the thermostat screen and through the mobile app. These alerts include reminders for:

- · Filter changes for your HVAC system.
- · General system maintenance.
- Humidifier servicing (if applicable).

Adhering to these alerts helps ensure optimal system performance and longevity.

## **Cleaning the Thermostat**

To clean the touchscreen and exterior of the thermostat:

- Turn off the thermostat's display or set it to 'Off' mode to prevent accidental changes.
- Use a soft, damp cloth (water only) to gently wipe the screen and casing.
- · Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays, as these can damage the screen or finish.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

#### **Common Issues and Solutions**

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Thermostat not powering on	No power to the unit; wiring issue.	Check circuit breaker. Verify wiring connections (consult an HVAC technician if unsure).
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Incorrect Wi-Fi password; router issues; out of range.	Re-enter Wi-Fi password. Restart your router. Ensure thermostat is within Wi-Fi range.
Temperature not changing	System mode incorrect; schedule override; HVAC system malfunction.	Verify thermostat mode (Heat/Cool/Auto). Check for active holds or schedule overrides. If issue persists, contact an HVAC technician.
Z-Wave device not pairing	Device too far; device already paired; interference.	Ensure device is close to the thermostat. Exclude the device from its previous network if applicable. Refer to Z-Wave device manual for pairing instructions.

## **Trane Diagnostics**

The XL850 includes built-in Trane Diagnostics. If you opt-in, your HVAC dealer can monitor real-time system performance and receive alerts for potential issues. This allows for remote troubleshooting and proactive maintenance, helping to keep your system running smoothly.

For complex issues or system malfunctions, it is recommended to contact a certified Trane HVAC professional.




Image: A front view of the Trane ComfortLink II XL850 thermostat with dimensions indicated: 5 3/8 inches width and 3 3/8 inches height.


